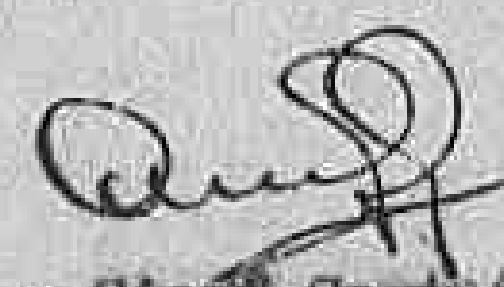

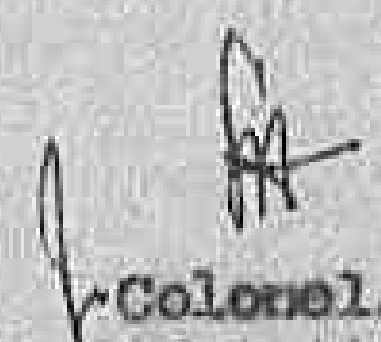

1. Although the original A.F. B.122 is not at present held by this Unit, it is understood from the soldier that he was A.W.O.L. for one week, and subsequently was awarded and served 196 days imprisonment on conviction of desertion. Period of imprisonment was 10 March 43 - 21 September 43.
2. Deducting the period of imprisonment from term of service, the hypothetical date of enlistment is 18 March 1944 and Age/Service Group is 28.
3. According to the attached Class 'A' Release Roll the reckonable service commences from date of release from prison, i.e. September 1943, giving the Release Group as 49, and it would appear that previous service is not counted. 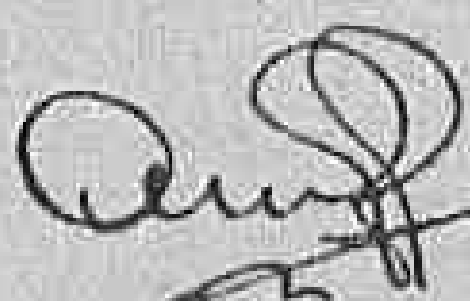

Para 308 (c) of Regulations for Release from the Army 1945 states that a soldier who was released from the army for employment with the N.F.S. may count that period of release when assessing service for A & S Group. As neither of the above mentioned soldiers were called up for Army Service until 14 Nov 40 and 19 Nov 42 respectively the date on which their service has been assessed from they do not qualify for service under Para 308 (c). 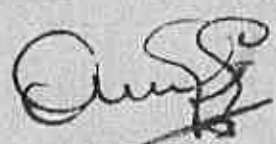
