Information has been received that it has been decided to grant 28 days' re-engagement leave under the conditions set out in the following paragraphs.

The code word for this leave will be "RENLEAVE".

Eligibility

The following personnel are eligible for RENLEAVE.

- (a) Soldiers still serving on normal regular engagements who on or after 1 December 1945:-

- (i) Extend their service to complete 12 years with the colours provided they have at least 12 months to serve from the effective date of their extension.

Under this clause soldiers serving on the prolongation of the period of colour service for which they originally engaged may be considered for eligibility.

- (ii) Re-engage to complete 21 or 22 years' service. 6940

- (b) Non-Regular soldiers who on or after 1 December 1945 re-enlist on a normal regular engagement, provided that:-

- (i) They have served with the colours for at least 12 months before 1 December 1945.

- (ii) They are still serving with the colours on the date of such re-enlistment, and have not been granted release leave.

3. RENLEAVE is additional to any other leave for which the soldier may be eligible (including SEMI-GR) except that soldiers who receive RENLEAVE will NOT be eligible for the 56 days' release leave. They will, however, if released during the release period, be eligible for the overseas leave element.

- 4. (a) RENLEAVE will be taken at the earliest convenient opportunity, and will normally be added to SEMI-GR if the soldier is also qualified for that leave or to other form of admissible leave.
