The above-named officer submitted a request to this Branch whilst serving with 203 Fixed Defences BA for information concerning his eligibility to receive graded pay.

The following information has been received in this connection from

A. S. CHQ :

"1. Capt Twine apparently comes within the terms of ACI, 1884/43 Part C para (i) and may claim pay under Royal Warrant 1940 Art 28A subject to a satisfactory interview with a REME colonel. This concession is effective from 1 Oct 43. It is for War Office, who authorize all gradings, to decide the effective date of each application.

"2. It is not necessary, therefore, for Capt Twine to change his commission to REME in order to benefit under this ACI.

"3. Letter 36/1/215 of 11 Jan 46 from Cdr 203 Fixed Defences to Dep Mil Sec states that Capt Twine is an AMI Heeb E. As such he might be considered eligible for grading under ACI 1884/43. Care should be taken, however, to differentiate between Associate Member of the Institution and an Associate of the Institution. The former is a corporate member and is senior to a Graduate Member; the Associate is not a corporate member - as explained in the Institution's letter 2/23 of 31 Dec 45, and would not be eligible for grading under Part A of the ACI.

"4. It is recommended that Capt Twine apply through Service channels for grading under Part C para (i) of ACI 1884/43, requesting an interview by a REME colonel. Subject to a successful interview, the application will be forwarded eventually by this section to War Office (AG21) for consideration.
