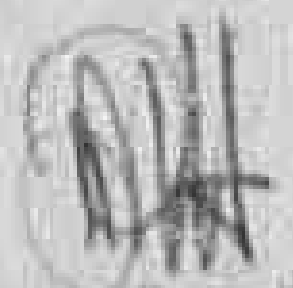

1. 12 British Liaison Unit has recently moved to BARI from ORSANO, which should make a considerable difference to the general morale of the Unit. The last location was some 30 miles from BARI and in the middle of the country; and consequently there were little facilities for entertainment. However, there were few complaints at ORSANO and the morale on the whole appeared to be good.

2. This Unit has always worked in very close contact with the Italian Army, and the relations between the British and Italian troops have always been cordial, although there is little inclination to mix off duty.

3. Naturally the question of release is the main pre-occupation of all units, and in fact many B.L.U.s have been sent to this Unit only a few weeks before their release, with the consequent adjustment to the conditions of the Unit. Very soon to appreciate that life is hard with nothing to do, to be harder than here in Italy in the Army, and some have applied for civil occupations in Italy and elsewhere abroad after release.

4. There have been few outstanding problems regarding mail, family affairs, pay, health etc. Books have been borrowed from Army Education Service, and some members of the Unit have profited greatly from educational courses.

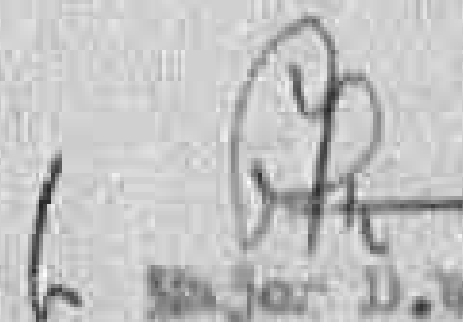
