Subj.: - Disbandment of the 312 Bakers Squad.

For information.....

1. - The disbandment of the 312 Bakers Squad was ordered by the S.M.R.E.-Ord & Mob. Office, with letter 1838/Ord. N of the 6 running.
2. - The personnel belonging to the Subsistenza (RCCs & CRs) will be transferred to Territoriale Milit, Comando of Genoa for the Stores under command of same. All the remaining personnel (RCCs & CRs) will be returned to their original Units.
3. - The Weils oven (6) as well as all other technical materials will be handed over:
 - n.5 to the Mill Bakery of Rome.
 - n.1 will be taken in charge by the Service & Assistance School of Rieti for training purposes.
4. - The Ufficio Servizio of the Centr. Milit. School will forward instructions about the handing over of the remaining materials and in accordance with the Comando Territoriale di Roma will decide from which bakery (Milit. or civilian) the Units u.com. will draw the necessary rations of bread.
5. - The disbandment will be finished within the 15 next.
6. - On completion of requested action the attached form must be returned duly completed to be forwarded to S.M.R.E.

1. The Lt C. Central Military Schools have advised this Lt C. that they have suggested to Ministry of War that the 219 Field Bakery be disbanded and that the units served by this bakery should collect their bread ration from Rome.

2. This decision is agreed for the following reasons:-

(a) the Bakery is not supplying all the schools, only the following:-

- (i) Lt C. Central Military Schools.
- (ii) Infantry School.
- (iii) P. A. School.
- (iv) Police school.
- (v) Commandant.

with a total daily ration strength of from 3,200 - 3,800 (1 heavy load).

(b) The bakery is in a very bad location, with very poor accommodation, to which a vehicle cannot approach better than 150 yards. The machine oven is very old fashioned and the 'mixing' and 'moulding' all have to be done by hand. The water supply too is precarious. All work throughout the 24 hours has to be done by artificial light, and there is no ventilation in the bakery whatsoever.

(c) The bakery could never be used for training purposes since although technical side of bread production is up to standard, the whole general appearance would give students the wrong impression of food. Also there is very little for students in addition to normal shift work.

- (i) Central Military Schools.
- (ii) Infantry School.
- (iii) P.T. School.

(b) The bakery is in a very bad location, with very poor accommodation, to which a vehicle cannot approach nearer than 100 yds. The entrance even is very old fashioned and the "baking" and "cooling" all have to be done by hand. The water supply too is precarious. All work throughout the 24 hours has to be done by artificial light, and there is no ventilation in the bakery whatsoever.

(c) The bakery could never be used for training purposes since although technical side of bread production is up to standard, the whole general appearance would give evidence the wrong impression as usual. Also there is very little extra room for students in addition to normal canteen personnel.

3. In view of the above no report will be submitted for the ^{by 26/4} on of this unit on 27 March 46. The following points are however forwarded for information:-

(a) The bakery is at present using 70 national flour (for Italian sources) and 30 white flour and the yield is 124%. The CIA Gough process is used. The amount of salt used was checked and found to be correct.

(b) A constant complaint of the men is that they still receive no trade pay.

(c) It appears that previously bakers used to be issued with bread or coffee which helped them, especially in the hot season and they want this issue restarted.

(d) The following accounts are kept:-

- (i) Commodity account showing commodities received and commodities struck off charge as bread.
 - (ii) Account +270 showing commodities issued to crews and % bread yield.
 - (iii) Register of trade incidents.
 - (iv) Register of unit drawings showing signature of representatives.
- This book also contains a "Remarks column" where units can make complaints.

1. Further to this office letter ST/302 dated 10 Jan 46, a report has now been received showing action taken in accordance with the recommendations embodied in the above letter.
 - (a) The civilian oven (requisitioned) has been overhauled and is now being used alone for the total production figure.
 - (b) Infested flour has been cleaned by sieving.
 - (c) Fire points have been established and fire extinguishers are on demand.
 - (d) Further accommodation has been found and a hut is being built resulting in improved sleeping accommodation and in due course, in the provision of a recreation room.
 - (e) Action has been taken to improve the condition of boots and clothing and an additional soap issue has been obtained.

2. This branch is most favourably impressed by the manner in which the suggestions in the above letter have been received and moreover by the prompt and vigorous action which has been taken to rectify the deficiencies noted.
