SUBJECT: War Establishments

LARGE WORKERS SUB COM AC (MILA) (SD Branch, 'C', 'A' & 'B')
HQ RTC ICF

1. The holding of reinforcements has been increased to a ceiling of 13,550.
2. All War Establishments will be considered and a number will be revised generally in accordance with the basis laid down in HQ AQ/62/405 of 24 April 45.
3. The object of the revision will be to ensure that the total Permanent and Training Staff in the RTC ICF inclusive of SIVA and other Schools, does not exceed 3,000.
4. Any figures in excess of 3,000 will be subject to ruthless scrutiny by both MILA and JMWG and a very full explanation will be needed to justify them and it is probable that such excesses will pass without drastic curtailment. Such curtailment is better carried out by personnel of the RTC ICF and BDU than by Officers at MILA and JMWG who are less fully in the picture.
5. A BDU War Establishment Committee comprising the following will be convened with effect from MONDAY April 30th:-
