1. At the time when the procedure for dealing with the release of officers and other ranks from the Army was received, it was the intention that Release Rolls should be despatched to all units by GFM 2nd Echelons overseas after hostilities with Germany had ceased. The effect of such a procedure would have been that release rolls would have been received by OSG at a time when their units would have been comparatively static. Units would not have been engaged in battle and the movement of personnel between units, hospitals, and depots would have been at a low ebb.
2. Information has now been received, however, that it is probable that release from the Army of early age and service groups will be speeded up, and accordingly it is now necessary that release rolls in respect of personnel in this theatre should be produced without delay. In order that the release plan may be implemented and that the machinery may work smoothly, it is essential that the instructions contained in the paragraphs which follow are complied with precisely. Your fullest co-operation in this connection is thus requested. It will be appreciated that the information to be supplied or initiated by you will assist materially in forming the basis of the structure of the machinery by means of which release will be effected.
3. Enclosed are four copies of Class "A" release rolls in respect of officers and other ranks held within the War Establishment and attached surplus to the War Establishment of the unit under your command.
4. These rolls have been prepared in accordance with para 312 of the publication "Regulations for Release from the Army 1945", and are compiled from the latest data held in this HQ. It is appreciated that these rolls will not necessarily represent a complete nominal roll of the officers and other ranks serving with the unit under your command at the time these rolls are received by you.

It is appreciated that these rolls will not necessarily represent a complete nominal roll of the officers and other ranks serving with the unit under your command at the time these rolls are received by you.

5. Will you now please take the following action without delay :-

(a) Verify the particulars in respect of each individual whose name appears on the rolls. In cases where all particulars shown are agreed by you the word "AGREED" will be entered against the individual's name in Column (7) "Remarks Column" of release roll. If item at variance is age and service group, the alleged correct age and service group will be shown in the "Remarks Column" only, together with a short statement to support the alleged correct age and service group. Age and service groups as shown in column (5) of release rolls will NOT be amended. An example of recording a challenge of this nature is set out in para 5(b) below. In cases where particulars shown on the release roll other than age and service group are NOT agreed, an appropriate remark will be made in the "Remarks Column", the incorrect particulars will be ruled through, and the correct particulars inserted as shown in the examples at para 5(b) below. In cases where personnel held on the strength of the unit are no longer with unit on account of LIAP, release rolls will be endorsed in the "Remarks Column" : "LIAP. NO CONFIRMATION OF PARTICULARS", but in the event of it being possible to confirm

ALL particulars from existing data within unit, confirmation will be notified by adding after the word "LIAP". "Particulars confirmed". In any event, LIAP personnel will be given the opportunity of querying age and service groups themselves on their return to their former unit and O&C will thus subsequently confirm by letter that age and service groups are agreed or not as the case may be.

Personnel who are held within unit VB but detached for duty, or training (ie, on courses), with a unit elsewhere will be dealt with in accordance with the provisions of para 5(a) below. The only exception to this provision is in cases where the unit to whom the individual is attached is in the immediate vicinity. In such a case action will be taken to contact the OC unit and confirm, in conjunction with the individual concerned, the particulars on the release roll.

(c) In cases where personnel are NOT desirous of being released from the Army (in accordance with the provisions of para 326 of Release Regulations) AND PROVIDING THAT the CO recommends that the individual should be allowed to be retained, the letters "DV" will be inserted in column (6) (Prefix letters) of the release roll against the relevant individual's name. The letters "DV" will also be inserted in the "Remarks Column" together with the words "SOLDIER'S

/STATEMENT

STATEMENT ATTACHED" in the case of ORs or "OFFICER'S STATEMENT TO AFHQ" in the case of officers. Two copies of the signed statement in respect of ORs will be prepared in accordance with para 328 of Release Regulations and AFHQ Release Instructions, Appx "C". Such statements will be endorsed "RECOMMENDED" and signed by CO unit and will then be pinned to one copy of the TWO completed release rolls which will be returned to this HQ at the earliest possible moment. (d) Where personnel shown on release rolls are for any reason no longer serving with the unit under your command, the names of such personnel will be extracted on to fresh rolls to be prepared as quintuplicate by you as release rolls (ie, in the same manner as those enclosed with this letter). Names of personnel so extracted will be ruled through on original release rolls and the word "EXTRACTED TO (unit)" inserted in the "Remarks Column". Separate rolls will be prepared for -

- (i) each arm or branch of the Service,
- (ii) officers,
- (iii) other ranks,
- (iv) each unit to whom all personnel shown on the appropriate roll have been despatched.

Three copies of the appropriate roll/rolls so prepared will be addressed ON THE ROLL and forwarded to the unit, including hospitals, depots, transit camps, etc, to which the individual/individuals were despatched. The remaining two copies will be despatched to this HQ. All copies of such rolls will show the date individuals were despatched from the unit under your command. Rolls will be clearly headed -

"PERSONNEL NO LONGER SERVING WITH (unit) as shown on Release Roll Serial No forwarded by G2E on (date)".

Units receiving such rolls from other units will take action on rolls in accordance with the provisions of para 5(a), (b), and (c) above, or, if the individual/individuals have meanwhile been re-despatched, take action in accordance with this sub-para.

In connection with the provisions of this sub-para, it is anticipated that in isolated cases O2C units will not be in a position to know to which units, hospitals, etc, certain personnel have been despatched. Felling within this category will be personnel who have been evacuated from forward areas as battle casualties or normal sickness casualties. In such cases nominal rolls of all this personnel will be prepared and forwarded to this HQ only, and release rolls will be endorsed in "Remarks Column" "LOCATION UNKNOWN - EXTRACT TO O2E" against each appropriate individual's name. It is emphasized that resort to this procedure should be made only in cases where it is not possible to ascertain the present whereabouts of the individual/individuals concerned. Abuse of the use of this procedure would result in delay, which, it will be appreciated, is highly undesirable at this stage of the war.

(e) Where personnel are serving with the unit under your command but whose names do not appear on the attached release rolls, action will be taken by you to prepare release rolls in respect of those personnel. Rolls will be produced in duplicate. Separate rolls will be prepared for -

1. War Office Release Regulations and LHM Release Instructions have been distributed with GRCs of 20 April 45.

2. Para 326 of Release Regulations provides that personnel who do not wish to be released when eligible may continue to serve provided their services can be utilised by the Army. Confirming authority for their retention will be LHM and O2E for Officers and Other Ranks respectively. Individuals volunteering to serve on will be required to sign a statement that he fully understands that if his retention is continued he will :-

(a) Be liable to serve until general demobilisation is ordered provided his services are so far required.

(b) Be subject to the normal rules regarding transfer, posting, promotion, pay etc.

3. Individuals in Groups 1 to 26 may now volunteer under para 326. Names of Officers and Other Ranks in Groups 1 to 26 eligible to volunteer should be forwarded to reach Staff Capt 121 LHM by 1200 hrs 25 April 45. Necessary application forms will then be forwarded together with detailed instructions.

4. LHM 112/45 provides that all personnel born 1905 or earlier are now placed in Group 1.

Individuals voluntarily to serve on will be required to sign a statement that he fully understands that if his retention is confirmed he will :-

- (a) Be liable to serve until general demobilization is ordered provided his services are so long required.
- (b) Be subject to the normal rules regarding transfer, posting, promotion, pay etc.

3. Individuals in Groups 1 to 26 may now volunteer under para 326. Names of Officers and Other Ranks in Groups 1 to 26 wishing to volunteer should be forwarded to reach Staff Capt M. H. H. by 1200 hrs 23rd April 45. Necessary application forms will then be forwarded to them with detailed instructions.

4. AGM 112/45 provides that all personnel born 1895 or earlier are now placed in Group 1.
