1. While the notes below do not directly concern Infantry Training it is felt that hygiene in all regiments would be better if these points could be noted on.

- (a) It is apparent that the function of the Field Hygiene Section here is not fully understood. It is considered as a "Disinfection Squad" and its duties confined to spraying beds and other similar tasks.
- (b) The section is five men under strength (out of 27) and a further 3 men have venereal or other infectious disease.
- (c) The section has none of the tradesmen (bricklayers, carpenters etc) allowed in the establishment.
- (d) Some of its vehicles have been "borrowed" by other Units.
- (e) If this Squad made regular inspections of units and reported direct to the G.I. Division a big improvement would result.
- (f) It could also ensure that the sanitary men trained by 2 Lieut FURBER at his School are properly employed when they leave, and at the same time give great assistance to this School.
