1. Verbal information has been received that H.O. Central Schools is being disbanded on 4 Nov. Thereafter the Schools will be the responsibility of the following :-

3. It is recommended that contact between officers of 12 B.L.D. and S.M.S. should be restricted to the following :-

(a) Liaison only should be permitted; official correspondence will continue as at present.

At Appendix 'B' are the proposed channels for the future.

3. It is recommended that contact between officers of 12 B.I.U. and S.I.E. should be restricted to the following :-

- (a) Liaison only should be permitted; official correspondence will continue as at present.
- (b) Liaison should deal with "schools" questions only.
- (c) Liaison should be with nominated officers only : e.g.

School of Artillery

The School's Liaison - Arty Instructor 12 B.I.U.  
G.S.C. I (School of Arty) - Arty Inspectorate S.I.E.

4. It is thought :-

- (a) That there is an urgent need to appoint a D.I.E. with a charter to coordinate the training policy of the Army, and to control the schools which have no present Inspectorate.
- (b) It is thought to be illogical that the P.S., 7281 and Administration Schools should be controlled by the Inspectorate of Infantry.

5. The Italian increment to 12 B.I.U. is at present accommodated and to some extent administered by H.C. Central Schools. It is ~~administered~~ *administered*

that a suitable arrangement may be made for this increment in the future.

6. It is thought that the above proposals should be regarded as an interim arrangement. At a later date, after review it might be found to be right to merge 12 D.I.V. in H.C. R.M.I.A..
