1. M.M.I.A. have requested further information on the proposed formation of a School of Artillery at SALENTINA.

2. The current situation is as follows :-

- (1) It has been decided to form a School of Artillery at SALENTINA. M.M.I.A. have given their approval.
- (2) Inspector of Artillery and a representative of the 'Servizi' have visited SALENTINA and have agreed on plans for repair and reconstruction.
- (3) M.M.I.A. are to-day writing to the Italian Cabinet to ask the Ministry Post-War to evacuate from SALENTINA the greater part of the personnel there.
- (4) The date of formation of the new School is not provisionally for Jan. 1947 subject to (5) above being carried out.
- (5) Training of new instructors to be carried out by British Air School SALERNO, subject to approval by I.A.A. M.C. Major Canali M.M.I.A. is dealing with this.
- (6) These proposals meet with the complete approval of Insp. in Charge 12 M.D. who would recommend that M.M.I.A. given its approval to this proposed formation of a new School and further more given its approval to the manner in which this formation is to take place.

3. Enclosed is a map of SALENTINA with those buildings marked in red which are required by the Artillery. The map should be studied in conjunction with the enclosed translated letter from Inspector of Artillery to M.M.I.A. No 12 M.D. dated 7 Aug. '46.
