1. What definite orders have been given for the manufacture of training stores in the shape of wooden classroom-aids of artillery equipment, recoil systems, breech and firing mechanisms, etc.
2. What action has been taken to secure examples of recoil systems, breech and firing mechanisms, sights, miscellaneous carriage parts, etc., for the demonstration rooms of S.M.O.A.
3. Whether the matter of supplying suitable lifting tackles for the dismantling and re-assembling of equipments has been given consideration.
4. Whether the acquisition of a 16mm. film projector with suitable training films has been considered for the a/m school.
5. Whether sufficient lecture room furniture (i.e. blackboards, tables and benches for students, etc.) has been acquired or is being manufactured.
