1. This Office is being continually asked by individual Units for British pattern tents for sleeping troops. There is an acute shortage in British Tentage and this will tend to become even more acute now that hostilities have ceased.

2. Over 2000 Tents were demanded by this Office over two months ago but none have been issued. It is therefore necessary to supply all requirements for tentage from Italian sources.

3. In your 07/063/5/Comm of 24 April you informed DADQS that there were 3,001 Tents actually in possession of Units of RTC ICP. Of these only 200 are in use. It would seem therefore that there is a reserve of 3,711 which can be used to meet the requirements of any particular Unit.

4. It is recommended that all Tents in Tenda, not actually in use be withdrawn to the Central Storehouse and re-issued to Units as required, by RTC ICP, Headquarters.
