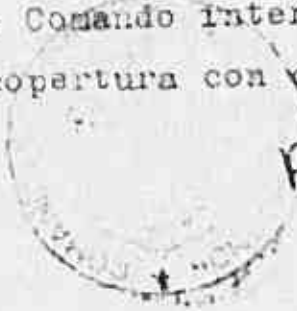

Reference the attached instant memo.

1. The D & M Course at the R.V. JCV has been ordered to start on 5 Mar. 45, and it is imperative that it should do so.
2. The 75 vehicles at the present time allotted to this school are absolutely devoid of any tools or lights at all, and thus it will be almost impossible to teach maintenance on this Course.
3. Other possible sources of tools have been tried and no success has been reached. It has NOT been possible to even borrow some spanners etc. temporarily.
4. It is appreciated that the move at present being made is highly irregular, but the urgency of this situation demands prompt action. Therefore I would be very grateful indeed if you could release to the Italian Officer, who handles this letter, at least a part of the tools and spare parts mentioned in the attached notes from ADMS Area Allied Command.
5. ADMS AREA Allied Command was consulted by me, before this copy was taken, and it was suggested by his Office that a British ³⁶officer and or Senior NCO be sent. That, however is impossible, only to the ³⁶shortage of British staff at this headquarters. Therefore I hope that this letter will explain the situation.
6. The irregularity of this action is again regretted, but I hope you will be able to help.

- 3. Other possible sources of tools have been tried and no success has been revealed. It has NOT been possible to even borrow pens, spatula etc. inadvertently.
- 4. It is appreciated that the news at present being made is highly irregular, but the urgency of the situation demands prompt action. Therefore I would be very grateful indeed if you could release to the Italian Consul, who heads your this letter, at least a part of the tools and spare parts mentioned in the attached notes from APOG with Area Allied Council.
- 5. APOG with Area Allied Council was consulted by me, before this step was taken, and it was suggested by his office that a British officer and or Senior NCO be sent. This, however is impossible, owing to the shortage of British staff at this Headquarters. Therefore I hope that this letter will explain the situation.
- 6. The irregularity of this action is again regretted, but I hope you will be able to help.
