To all MMIA LO's and RMJ's.

1. A report is required on the Italian army newspapers "La Patria" and "Italia", to reach this H.Q. by 7 April.
2. These newspapers are published by the army for the soldier, and it is desired to do everything possible to make them efficient and of high morale value. Information is required on the present distribution system, on the numbers actually reaching the soldiers, and on their attitude to the papers.

 4. General Suggestions.

Land Forces Sub. Comm. I.C.

1. A communication has been received from the Italian Ministry of War stating that as from 1st January 1945 an allowance of 20 (twenty) lire per man per day has been authorized to troops in the following areas:-

- (a) All troops forward of 45th and 46th Army Corps boundaries.
- (b) Fronts, Columns, Regiments, Brigades and Mountain Groups wherever located.
- (c) German Combat Group Rearrangement Centre.

2. This sum is available to all Commanders for the improvement of housing.
