6. The materials required should be readily obtainable and the work could be undertaken either by one of the Contractors or by R.T.O., I.C.F. personnel. Please inform D.A. & J.E. P. D.H.U., if any difficulty is experienced in this matter.

7. Each Unit should be allotted sufficient time per week to enable all its vehicles to be serviced once a fortnight. Each vehicle should be allotted one hour at the "Service Station" for a wash and grease and fortnight. The Service Station can deal with 6 vehicles at a time.

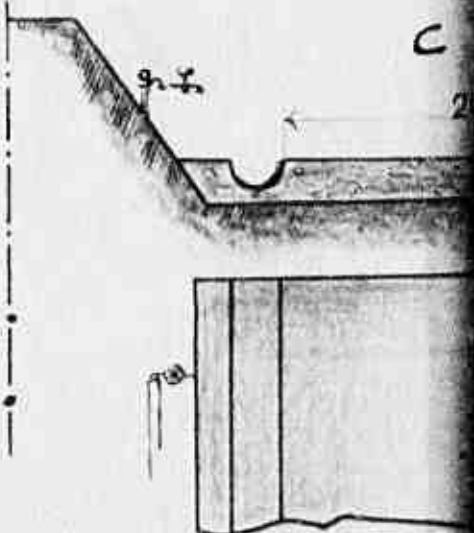
Suggested plan for Service Station

3 ramps



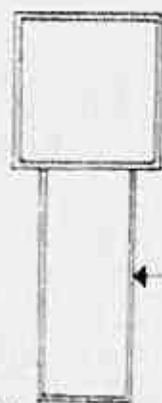
