SUBJECT: SCARCITY OF SUBSISTENCE

1. Requirements of foodstuffs for the Italian Interim Army have been met for the month of January, with the exception of 450 tons of flour.
2. As advised in my Directive No. 1 of 2 Nov, 45 subsistence for the Italian Interim Army is an Italian Government responsibility. Pro-curement of requirements is to be effected through Italian indigenous resources and from importation. The Allied Military Headquarters could not promise to take any subsistence available after 1 January 1946.
3. It is deduced during December that certain items i.e., flour, macaroni, meat/fish, sugar, coffee, pepper, and dried vegetables could not be procured from other indigenous resources or importation for requirements in January, February or March. Importation was made to April for release of these items from Allied Military stocks, either on repayment to kind or for dollar purchases. Only after 1 May any requisition were these items released.
4. A world food shortage has resulted in the cancellation of many shipments to this Theater for the Allied Military; consequently, there are negligible surpluses available.
5. Your requirement of flour for one month is 34,50 tons. The Allied Military has about 1000 tons available and stated that further quantities of flour can not be released without detriment to the Allied position and could not be considered without the fullest examination into Italian Government availability.
6. Logistical of the general world food situation is 4261 tons upon you to exercise every means of conservation and strict economy of stock existing at your disposition. A program of economy must

not possible to raise any subsistence available after 1 January 1946.

3. It developed during December that certain items, i.e., flour, macaroni, meat/fish, sugar, coffee, pepper, and other vegetables could not be produced from either Italian human resources or transportation for replacement in January, February or March. Representation was made to AFHQ for release of Italian items from Allied military stocks, either on repayment in kind or for dollar purchases. Only after 1 January consideration was given to these items released.

4. A world fuel shortage has resulted in the cancellation of some shipments to this theater for the Allied military; consequently, there are available supplies available.

5. Your requirement of flour for one month is 36,900 tons. The Allied military has made 3000 tons available and stated that further quantities of flour can not be released without detriment to the Allied position and could not be considered without the fullest consultation into Italian Government availability.

6. Recognizing of the general world food situation it is **4261** upon you to exercise every means of conservation and strict economy of stock exist at your disposition. A program of economy must extend from your Bulk Food Baskets down to the unit level. A strict observation of control should be exercised in the physical interest of transfer of stocks to avoid losses by thefts, etc., right control to avoid losses in unauthorized personnel, insistence on prompt attendance of units so money required, etc.

7. A. Your letter 33911/S/1 of 10 Dec. 45 requested that a double ration for Italian Army and Police be made for Christmas Day. This request was transmitted to AFHQ. Reply has been received that a double ration could not be authorized for US-101 & 38-111 Service Units, Air Force, and Navy for the same reasons stated in para. 4 above, and further that no additional issues were being made to Allied troops for Christmas.

B. A double issue to the Italian Interim Army for Christmas will obviously preclude future provision, particularly in regard to the basic issue of flour. Economy in December will assist in meeting the January deficit.

1. Instances are occurring in the proceedings of Analysis Commissions for the condemnation of deteriorated foodstuffs wherein certain food has been found unfit for human consumption; however the foodstuff may be put to industrial uses, or sold as animal feeding stuffs.

2. The normal procedure for disposition of foodstuffs found unfit for human consumption is destruction by fire or other means, the purpose of this method being to ensure that condemned foodstuffs do not become available for human consumption on the black-market.

3. Authority is delegated to the Allied Officer-in-Charge of the Analysis Commission to authorise that condemned foodstuffs be sold to civilian contractors, on credit will, however, be given for foodstuffs disposed of in this manner.

4. In the event of the Analysis Commission recommending disposal of bad foodstuffs for industrial purposes or animal feed the Commissariat Directorate concerned will make out a certificate which will be signed by the purchaser, such certificate will state that the items purchased will be used in the manner laid down by the Analysis Commission. Signed copies of this certificate will be attached to all Analysis Commissions reports forwarded to this HQ (Ministry of War letter 15712/S/1 dated 13 Aug 45 to all Commands refers).

1 You will probably be aware that it is an established procedure that periodically analysis operations are held for the purpose of considering supplies received in Italian Supply Depots from Allied sources and which have been found to be unfit for human consumption.

2 It is desired to continue the present procedure of having an Allied representative on these examinations at all times. It is necessary to decide whether credit shall be given to the Italian authorities for supplies so condemned and destroyed.

3 In cases where the Italian depots are unable to prove that the supplies were received unfit for human consumption or Allied depots, it is not normal to recommend credit and in no circumstances is credit recommended where it is possible to sell condemned supplies for animal consumption.

4 Attached is a copy of the current instructions dealing with this matter.

Subject: Procedure for dealing with Italian ration units unfit for consumption

These instructions are based on MILI Administrative Instruction No. 3 issued 4 June 44, but should there be any points of difference between these instructions and ADM Instruction No. 3 it is notified for the information of all concerned that these present instructions will constitute the governing document. Any necessary amendments to ADM Instruction No. 3 will be made and issued in due course.

When rations delivered to the Italian Armed Forces by the Allied Military Forces are suspected to be unfit for human consumption at the time of handing over, the Italian Port Detachment taking delivery will immediately report the fact to the Direzione Commissariato concerned. Officers commanding Italian Army Food Depots will similarly report any foodstuffs held by them in their depots which are suspected as unfit for consumption.

In all instances where food supplies are reported to the Direzione Commissariato as unfit for consumption, a short "Unfit Substances" report will immediately be forwarded to the MILI by the MILI Sector Liaison Officer. See Appendix 'A' for procedure to be used.

The Direzione Commissariato, on receipt of such reports from Port Detachments or C&S Depots will, by arrangement with the MILI Sector Liaison Officer concerned, convene an Analysis Commission to examine and adjudicate upon the supplies in question.

Analysis Commissions will comprise:-

- 1. An officer representative of ADM.
- 2. An Italian officer representing the Direzione Commissariato.
- 3. An Italian officer qualified as a chemist or food analyst.

Analysis Commission will comprise:-

- An officer representative of IMA.
- An Italian officer representing the Directorate Commissariat.
- An Italian officer qualified as a chemist or food analyst.

Where necessary an additional independent analyst's report may be obtained.

4. Analysis Commissions will record facts and record action taken, in accordance with the Analysis Report, proforma for which is attached at Appendix 'B'.

This report is required in extempore, copies disposed:-

- (one) 1 copy retained by IMA Sector Liaison Officer,
- (one) 1 copy retained by the concerned Directorate Commissariat,
- (four) 4 copies forwarded to HQ IMA.

5. Action recommended by Analysis Commissions, vide part II of the Analysis Report, may be put into effect forthwith without awaiting confirmation by HQ IMA.

In cases where immediate destruction is decided upon, the Directorate Commissariat forming part of Appendix 'B' will be completed before the Analysis Report is sent forward.

6. After endorsement of Analysis Reports by HQ IMA copies will be disposed as follows:-

- One (1) copy to the Italian Ministry of War,
- One (1) copy to the Directorate Commissariat,
- (Three IMA Sector Liaison will be used as a credit voucher to stock record if report concerned).

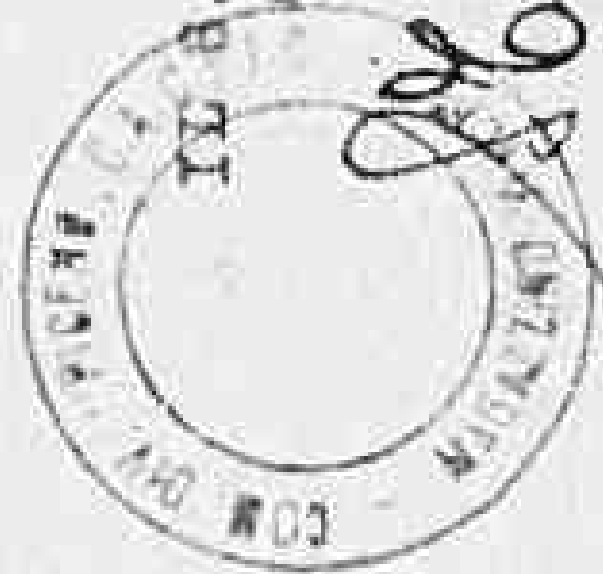
