

(b) - Serves for the instruction of junior officers in the care of the

soldier (courses for 30 officers - duration 4 weeks).

(c) - Serves for training in the regulations for the welfare of the soldier (courses for 30 junior officers - duration 4 weeks).

(e) - trains 180 office specialist trainees (stenographers, typists, filing clerks, accounts clerks, etc. - duration 4 weeks).

(f) - Possibly with Staff College certificate.

(g) - A captain with duties of adjutant and a subaltern as officer i/c

(h) - And also i/c accounts.




