1) The Mil.Terr.Command at Rome approached by this S.M.concerning the possibilities of making use of barracks at present in Tarquinta (former parachutists school) for the carrying out of a course for the preparation of carrier instructor units, has reported that;

- a) the greater part of the barracks appear to be completely demolished;
- b) The outer walls of two 50 x 111 barrack building without roof, flooring or main wall could be made use of;
- c) In order to put these two barracks into service again, including partitions, water and electric plants, painting, an expence of 6 million lire and time necessary not less than 30 days from the start of the work is estimated.

2) Bearing in mind that it is the intention of M.M.I.A. to have the a/m course carried out at Tarquinia, we ask you to kindly examine the possibility of authorising the immediate start of the work necessary also bearing in mind that buildings for the Carrier and Armoured School will have to be at Tarquinia.

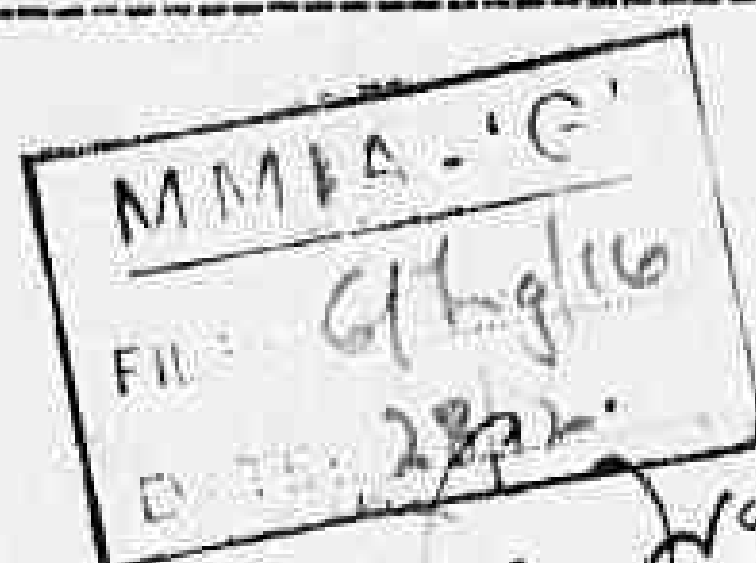

1. Comando Scuole Centrale should now advise Ministry of War of dates, numbers to attend and scope of the courses arranged in your paras (a), (b) and (c). Ministry of War will then be responsible for issuing joining instructions.

2. With regard to WT Ops courses Comando Scuole should approach the Ministry of War to obtain from them all details as to the standard of training already achieved by prospective students.

3. It is assumed that S.M.C.A. is the E & M School. This HQ has had no official notice that it is intended or desired to move this School. It is not clear what connection there is between the E & M School and a course for Ops WT.

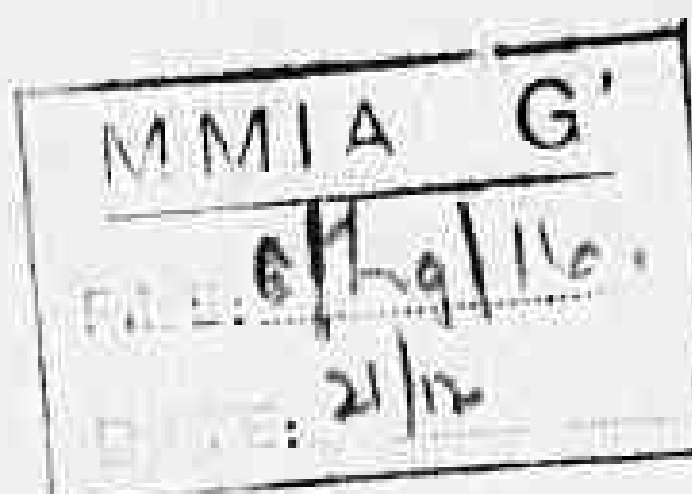
