1. Ref your signal 07/03 of 15 Feb 47 copy of which is enclosed. The Italian Army is now in a position to state its exact requirements.
2. At appendix 'A' is shown the list of films the Italians desire to be converted to Italian sound tracks. The number of copies they desire to purchase is also shown.
3. Could the War Office be asked to quote prices for these films under the following headings:
 - (a) Cost to the Italians of complete production of these films with Italian sound tracks taking into consideration that translations have already been prepared here in Italy.
 - (b) Reduction in cost of (a) should Italian technical personnel be sent to England at Italian expense to act as Italian commentators.
 - (c) Cost of the loan to Italian Army of the original English speaking negatives to permit re-production here in Italy.
 - (d) Costs of (1) the loan or (2) the sale of an English speaking "lavender" positive for each of these films.
4. The question of security control does not exist, as copies of all the films in Appendix 'A' have already been issued to the Italian Army.
5. It will be noted that the situation has changed considerably since Feb 47 and that the Italians are now in a better position to assist in re-production of these films.

1. The question of production of training films with Italian sound tracks was re-opened in conversation between Major Alexander - Magg, Chiarizia at S.M.E. on 22nd. and 25 APR.
2. The following decisions were made.
 - (a) S.M.E. to produce the list of films required to be dubbed with Italian sound tracks.
 - (b) S.M.E. to give assurance in writing that they are prepared to pay for these films should the cost be suitable.
 - (c) I.L.P.B. to ask C.H.C. to obtain the precise cost of production in England taking into account that translations have already been made here in Italy.
 - (d) To ascertain what reduction in cost there would be if competent Italian officers or civilians from the Italian Cinematographic Section were sent to London at Italian expense to act as Italian commentators.
 - (e) I.L.P.B. to explore the possibility
 - (1) of the loan of the original negatives to the Italian Army.
 - (2) or the loan or sale of a 'lavender' positive for each of these films.
 Reproduction of positives with Italian sound tracks would thus be made here in Italy.
 - (f) In the event of (e) being acceptable to ascertain the cost such a loan or sale.

Further to letter 255/G/8/Add of 24 January last.

1. Photo-Cinematographic Section sometime ago completed the translation of these 40 training films which, in accordance with your proposal in letter TRG/32 of 12 December 1946, we would like to be dubbed in England.
2. Translation of these films has not yet been forwarded to you as, according to agreements reached on 16 January 1947 between Maj CRISTIE - Maj CHIARIZIA of this S.M.E. and Dott. OTTOLENGHI of General Directorate of Commissariat and Admin. Services, it would have been necessary to wait for the decision of the British officers concerned, as regards the payment.
3. On 17 March 1947 Maj Cristie, reopened the matter, and verbally informed us that he had not received instructions from the officers concerned.
4. Considering:
 - the importance of these films for training purposes;
 - that the schools, CARS and numerous regiments are equipped with projectors,

we beg you to examine the possibility:

- a) of obtaining a ruling on the payment for films to be dubbed in England,
- b) to accept the requests referred to in para V of a/m letter (loan of other British training films - authority to purchase in England the material required for the production of the Italian training films in programme).

Training Films.

1. The following is the position regarding training films in the Italian Army.

(a) At Appendix 'A' is a list showing all training films held by the Central Military Schools and units. This list has been sent to the Ministry of War with the suggestion that a film library should be started so that Territorial Commands would be able to have the films on short loan. It is suggested that Territorial Commands might be able to borrow these films now on application to the Ministry of War.

(b) These films are all English speaking films and are on long loan to the Italian Army from the AKC. On the closing down of this theatre it is likely that these films will have to be returned to UK.

2. It is understood that some films are being made by the Italian Army but the scope of this project is not yet known.

3. The Ministry of War have been informed that it is possible to buy Italian speaking training films from UK. These are the normal British training films re-edited with Italian diagraphes etc. and a new sound track in Italian. The films would cost the Italian War Ministry about £9 per film if bought in bulk. It is not known if the Ministry are going to buy these films or whether the scheme mentioned in para 2 will be considered sufficient.

Confirming verbal communications.

1. - M.M.I.A. has informed this S.M. of the possibility of dubbing and manufacturing in England the films shown in the attached list, at a varying expense, in accordance with the size of the order, from 9 to 10 pounds per 330 metres of film.
2. - The Infantry Inspectorate:
 - a) has already begun some time ago - with the personnel of the instructional method squad and officers specially detailed by the Inspectorates concerned - the recognizance of the films in question and the splitting of them into three distinct sections:
 - those for the use of the C.A.R.s, Schools and Units;
 - those for the use of the Schools and Units;
 - those particularly for only the Schools.
 - b) has proposed the formation of a cinema section at each Military Territorial Command.
3. - This S.M., in accordance with:
 - above paragraphs 1 and 2;
 - the availability of funds;has decided:
 - to dub 40 films (25 of the first section and 15 of the second);
 - to have manufactured 16 examples of each, in order to extend the distribution to the Military Territorial Commands for the training requirements of the C.A.R.s and Units.
4. - Executive procedure:
 - a) speedily complete the recognizance mentioned in para 2-a) above classifying the films, within each section, with a progressive number indicating degree of use and therefore the order of priority to be followed in dubbing and manufacture;

- b) send all films, as they are classified and upon approval of this S.M., to the Cinematographic Section, which will arrange for their translation into Italian (or revision if already translated) employing technical personnel, two officer translators (Capt Bifferali and 2/Lt Collini) and a representative of the Inspectorate concerned. Translation will be limited at first:
- to the first 25 films of the first section;
 - to the first 15 films of the second section;
- and will require presumably about three months;
- c) address to the Mission (this S.M. will make arrangements) successive requests for dubbing and manufacture of films, as the translation proceeds, sending copy of same translation. The consignment of the films will presumably be ~~about~~ within four months from the request.
5. - This S.M. has further requested from M.M.I.A.:
- the loan of other examples of the films shown in attached list, in order to extend distribution - should the requests mentioned in preceding para 4-c) be met with - to the C.A.R.s;
 - permission to buy in England the material required for the manufacture of the Italian films in question (5000 metres negative, 10000 m. normal positive, 4000 m. sound track - S.A.V. - and 2000 m. countertype).
6. - The Infantry Inspectorate is requested to submit proposals, after direct agreements with the Inspectorates concerned, regarding the use and distribution of the films at present available.
7. - Further information will be given regarding the formation of cinema sections at Military Territorial Commands.

1. The position regarding training films is as follows:-

At Appendix "A" is a list of British training films which are on long loan to the Italian Army. They are English speaking films and were last heard of as being on charge of the Central Military Schools.

2. These or other British Training films could be produced in England in an Italian speaking version at a cost of about £ 10 per film of 1000 feet. If a bulk order is placed the films would cost about £ 9 each.

3. Pending the production of Italian speaking films it is suggested that some value could be obtained by the use of English films at the training establishments provided that an Officer was present who could explain the film. If this is agreed it is suggested that a lending library should be formed so that training units could borrow films for short periods to assist in their training.

4. If you wish to buy Italian speaking films this Mission will forward your requirements to the War Office London. A Catalogue showing all British Training Films is held at this Headquarters and could be seen here should you wish to make a selection of suitable films.

5. It is understood that there is a shortage in this country of negative for films and it might be cheaper to buy the films from England.

6. May this Mission please be informed of your views.


