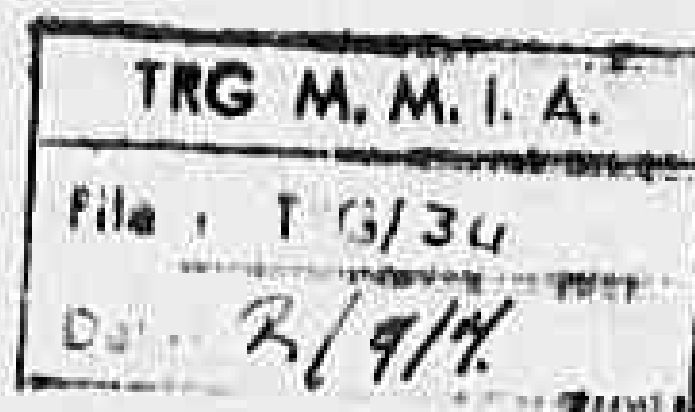

So far as the Junior Officers MT Course is concerned this will cover all the aspects of MT Training to be given to the recruits details of which are already in your possession. 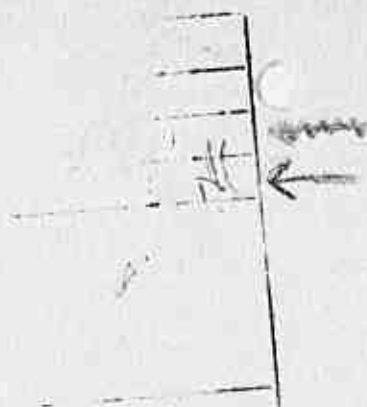

Below is a draft for the Motorisation Repair Training Centre.

The Policy of this Centre is to provide personnel for the M.T. repair units, the majority of its students being drawn from the short service personnel who serve only twelve months.

Such students will complete one month military training at a C.A.R. before coming to the Centre, where this technical training will commence, and the War Ministry have agreed to "screen" recruits at C.A.R.'s so that those with previous workshop experience are allocated for this training.

The time spent at this Centre by recruits will vary according to their trade from four months to six months, a portion of the time being set aside for continuance of primary military training. Though the Centre will be run on military lines many of the trade instructors will be civilians.

At the conclusion of their training satisfactory students are posted to Repair Units etc to gain experience in their trade.

A high standard of trade skill is not expected until an adequate time is allowed for teaching a man his trade, and the syllabi are accordingly based on British Class II standards generally, though many of the students will only reach Class III standards.
