SUBJECT: Travel Control - Entry into ITALY other than territory under Allied Military Government.

TO : Addressees listed below:

1. Letter this Headquarters, file AG 322/19 GHI-O, dated 27 November 1945 is rescinded effective 25 March 1946.

2. The Allied Force Permit system for control of entry into ITALY will cease to be operated after 25 March 1946 from all countries except Germany and Austria and responsibility for exercising this control will return to the Italian Government.

3. United States and British Service personnel do not require visas and may enter ITALY on production of valid travel orders.
