- 1 - The new W/E of the two Coys addressed, (ref. to in this Office letter 837/38/RIS of 28/3 last)-at present being approved by Allied Supreme H.Q. of the Mediterranean Sector- was previously worked out by the competent Section of H.Q. A.C. on the basis of strict employment requirements and not with that wide margin of surplus which was necessary in previous years because of the considerable size and complexity of the duties to be carried out, the majority of them split up in numerous regional detachments.
 - 2 - Until ~~the~~ last month, however, everybody expected a drop in the volume of the duties to be performed and consequently the new W/E was kept within the figures already known to you (138 men for the MI Services and 43 for the General Services. Total 181), considered adequate for the working requirements and the strict needs of the Services of the Unit.
 - 3 - The fact of being under Allied Command and the delicacy of the duty to be carried out, however, impose the necessity of having available a certain number of personnel to meet any eventual unexpected requirements, such as for example, temporary intensification of present duties, special guard of escort duties, replacement of personnel rendered unavailable due to causes beyond control (sickness, road accidents, ecc.)
- This Office therefore considers it necessary to point out such requirements to the competent Section of the Allied H.Q. (GI-B), with the intention of obtaining approval for a margin of at least 10% being allowed on the new W/E, particularly in view of the fact that the Directorate of the A.C. MI Park (Supergarage) shortly intends to hand over to the Italian Military Personnel under Command, the guard and check duties (day and night) on the Supergarage, for a period

of about 5 weeks because the P.S. agents who are on duty there are going to be temporarily withdrawn on higher authority's orders.

For this duty only, even though temporarily, sixty men will be necessary.

- 5 - Following an explanation to this effect from this Office, the competent Section of H.Q. A.C., considering that for the moment new alteration proposals cannot be forwarded to Allied Supreme H.Q., authorises the temporary surplus of 10% of the W/E, as has likewise being permitted recently to other Units, even to a great extent (20%).
- 6 - In informing you of the above, we request that you kindly give the necessary instructions to the Units concerned in order that they may take timely action to meet the new requirements of the service.

Reference the attached copy of this HQ letter SM/90 dated 28 May.

1. For your information SMH have, in conjunction with HQ 15 Corps and HQ 3 District, ordered the disbandment of all DMI-ITI Units shown in Appx 'A' of the attached letter, with the exception of serials 20-25 incl and 30-34 incl, to be completed by 31 July. Units as shown at serials 20-24 are required indefinitely for the guarding of the perimeter boundary of the S.E.P. Command at MIMOL, replacement by either civilians or German S.E.P. being impracticable. The future of units at serials 30-34 is still under discussion, and it is probable that the units will be disbanded.

2. With regard to serial 25 of Appx 'A' i.e. 266 Italian Service and M.E. Coy A.C. G(80) AFM have directed that the question of disbanding this unit be discussed direct between this Mission and your H.Q.

3. As explained in para 4 of the attached letter it will be difficult for the Ministry of War to provide replacement for the personnel due to be demobilized in July. It is therefore requested that you examine the possibility of releasing 266 Italian Service and M.E. Coy for disbandment v.e.f. 15 July 46, by replacing the Italian military personnel by either civilians or German S.E.P. as necessary, as is being done to release other DMI-ITI units in the theatre.
