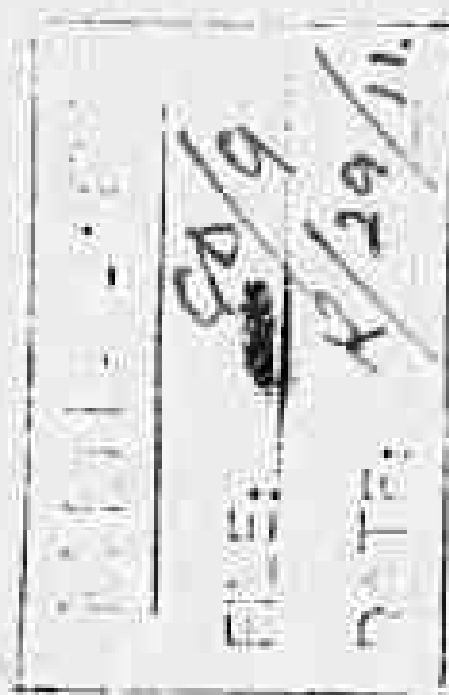

1. Reference your 431/346-3 (Mr) dated 6 Nov 45 forwarding disbandment orders (G.I., G.I. letter 107A/A.1 (Ser. 3/08) dated 4 Nov 45) for the a/n unit.
2. Copies of the order have been passed to the unit but application is made for the effective date to be amended to read 20 Dec 1945.
3. The Inspectorate is responsible for the fourteen other units listed in the disbandment order and must, therefore, be the last Italian Rly. Engineer unit to disband.
4. During the German occupation of N. Italy the Depot of the Italian Rly. Engineers was completely destroyed and consequently the Inspectorate had had to function not only as the H. of the Commander of Italian Rly. Engineer Units but also as their depot and record office. As a result of the administrative difficulties under which these units have worked, it is considered most probable that the Groups, B's and C's (now disbanding under H. 2 District) will be able to complete disbandment by 25 Nov. Certainly they will not if the Inspectorate is to be disbanded at the same time.
5. Therefore, in order that the Inspectorate may effect efficiently the disbandment of units under its command, and then satisfactorily wind up its own affairs will you please request G.I., G.I. to amend the effective date of its disbandment from 14 Nov to 20 Dec 1945.

SUBJECT: Railway Engineers Group

The Transport Ministry has pointed out the necessity of employing the Railway Engineers Group until the 30th. April 1946. The work of said Group is essential in the erection, dismantling, and guarding, of the sectional metal bridges (military type) which are at present replacing numerous permanent bridges which have been destroyed or damaged through enemy action and the maintenance of which cannot be carried out by the State Railways due to insufficiency of civilian personnel.

The date of 30th. April has been fixed in view of the need to get over the winter season during which, because of the rains, frequent breakdowns of the railway bridges are expected, thus necessitating the putting into effect of speedy and timely repairs. I enclose a letter in which, to the same end, Gen. Waghorn, Director of the Military Railway Service In Italy, requests that the work of the Railway Engineers Group continue to be carried out on behalf of the State Railways until the end of the winter season.

I beg of you, therefore, to kindly consider the great usefulness of the Railway Engineers Group in the framework of general transport needs in Italy, and to kindly agree that its existence will be maintained, formed, as at present, of an H.Q. and three battalions, until 30th. April 1946 at least.

I await information as to the decisions adopted by M.M.I.A. on the matter,

SUBJECT: Italian Railway Engineers.

We have been informed that on the 10th October you will be taking part in a meeting to discuss the retention in service of three battalions of Railway Engineers on the war establishment of the Italian Army.

If the question arises that these units be retained for a short period only, it is very important, in my opinion, that you point out that they should be retained until April 1946. I consider that said units should be available during next winter to be employed in the case of emergency to assist the State Railways to repair eventual damages caused by the winter season, and therefore the Railway Engineers units should not be discharged from the service until the winter rains season can be said to have been definitely overcome.

As a general rule, I think that in the new small Italian Army, there must not be any unit whose work correspond to civilian life occupations. Working on that principle, railway units exclusion from the army, is justified.

Nevertheless, in the present situation, the following circumstances should be born in mind:-

- the railway group is doing a large amount of ~~xxxxxx~~ reconstruction work on bridges and viaducts which were destroyed on account of the war.

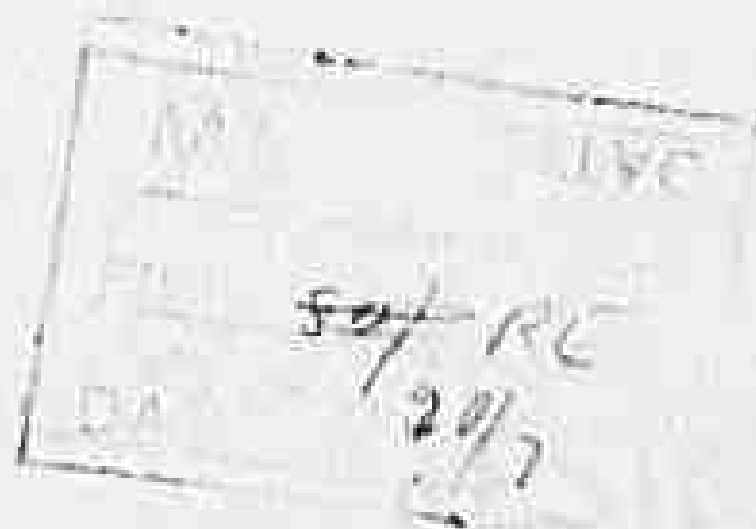

2. It is thought, however, that Italian Ministry of War would like to retain a small proportion of the above personnel within the Army, especially in view of the fact that before the War they employed an Operating Company on lines in the North and various other Rly establishments.

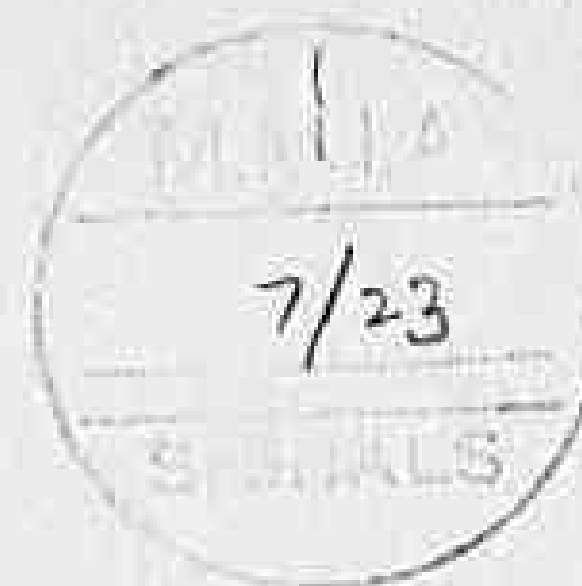

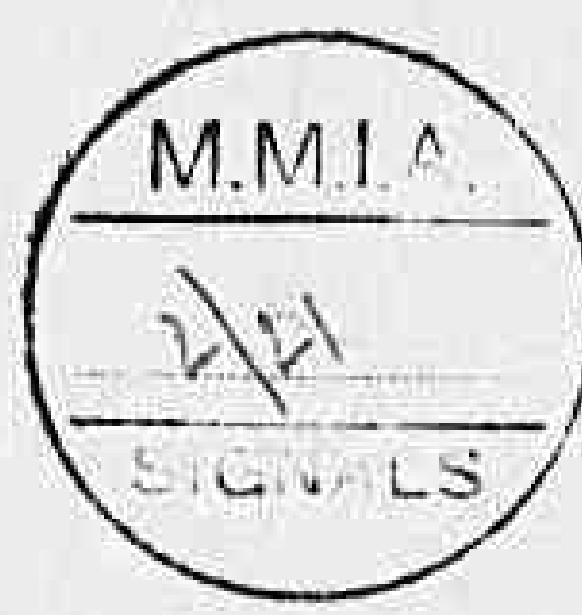

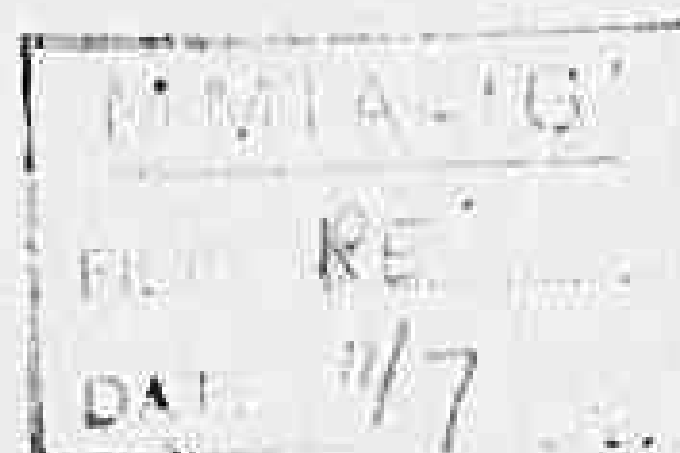
