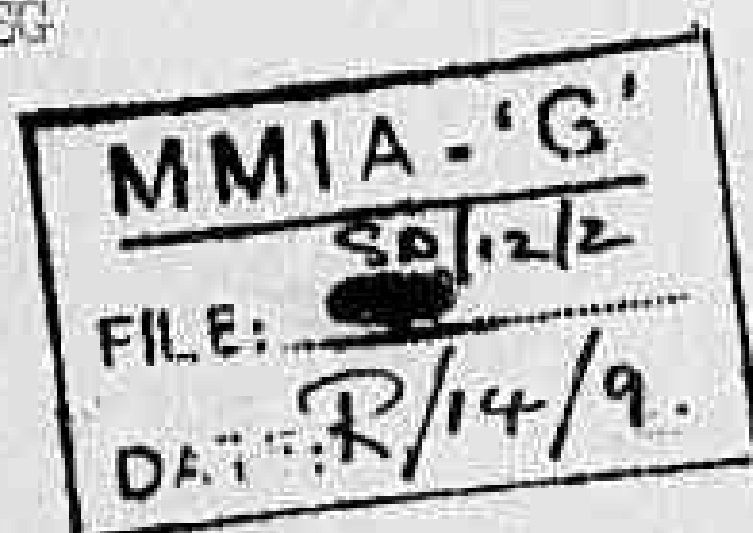

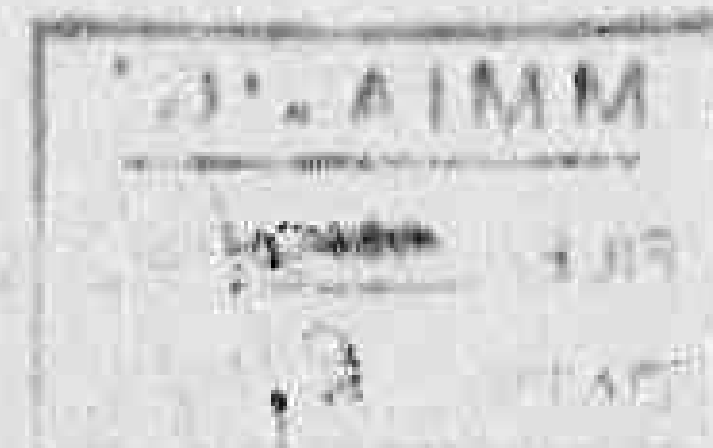

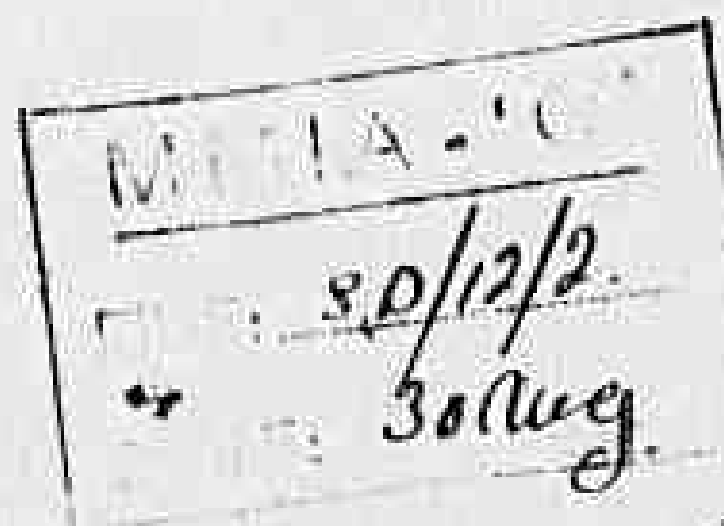

It is stressed that the major problem here is disposal of the vast quantities of British stores held by these units and that nothing can be done until definite orders, together with disposal instructions for stores, reach 211 Sub Area through staff channels.

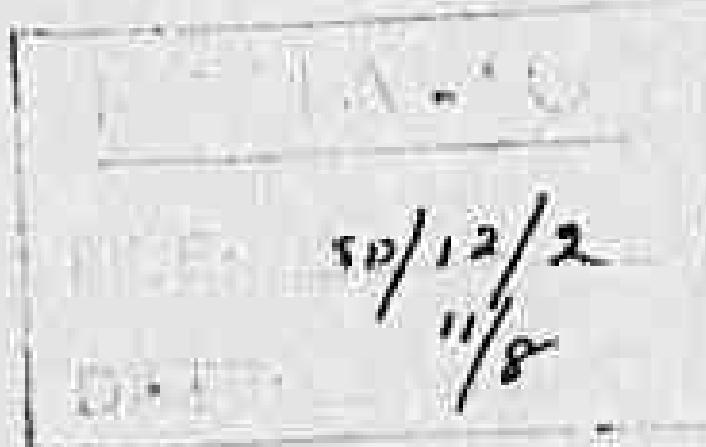

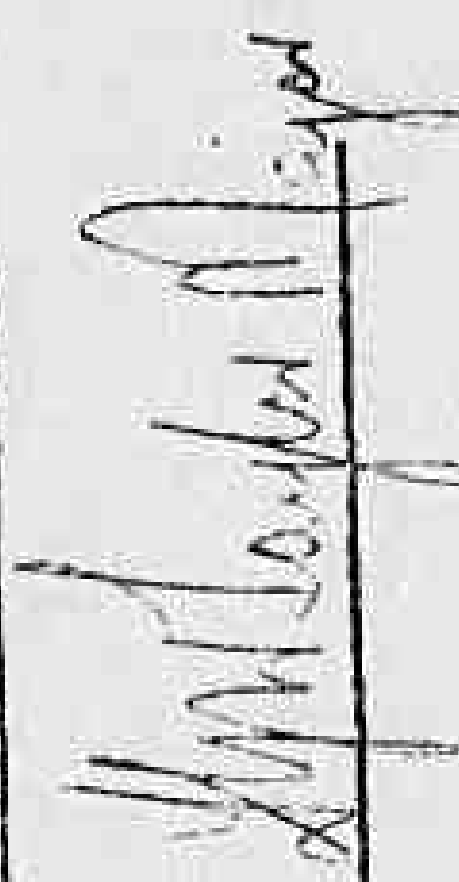

1. Since the territorial Med. organization is efficient in both Sicily and Sardinia, we propose to disband the u/m Med. units of the Internal Security Divisions:-

30 Med. Section of the "SABAUDA" I.S. Div.
50 " " " " "CALABRIA" I.S. Div.

For similar reasons, we also propose to reduce in strength or disband, Field Med. units of Administrative Divisions as the Divisions in question under which they depend, are gradually disbanded or reduced in strength.

2. The reasons which compelled to maintain Combat Group Auxiliary Med Units functioning as second evacuation centres, ceased to exist on account of the cessation of hostilities. 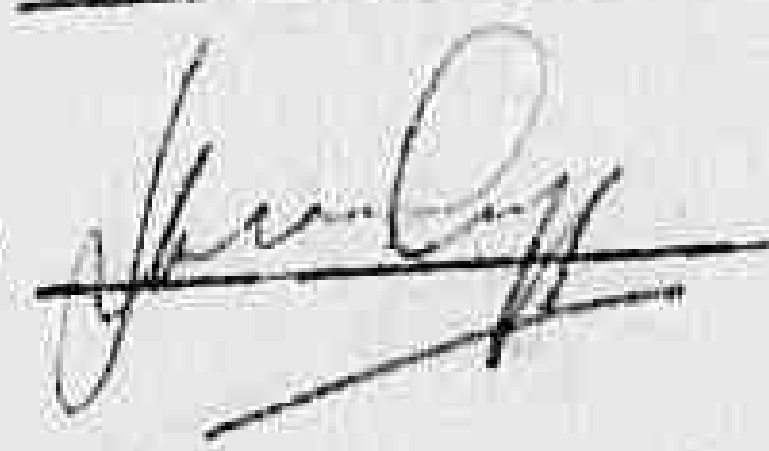

Among the auxiliary units laid down for the Combat groups there are, at present, only two mobile dental centres (113 and 114) which are alternately transferred from one group to another for the dental treatment of the personnel of those groups.

The difficulty of meeting the requirements of the 5 Combat Groups with the c/a two mobile centres, induces this SM to put forward to MIA the necessity of being able to place a mobile dental centre at the disposal of each combat group.

This would, in effect, mean forming another 3 mobile centres which, in accordance with the w/e, would require a slight increase in personnel, comprising, that is, 3 junior medical dental officers and 9 NCO's and OR's.

Since, however, the difficulties met with by this SM in the preparation of vehicles equipped for dental services are known, MIA, whenever it considers acceptable the above proposal, would have to be so kind as to assist in supplying the 3 vehicles and medical materials required. On the event of British resources not permitting it, the c/a vehicles could be drawn from the Italian ones recovered during the operations in North Africa and Sicily, or be provided for, within the limits of possibility, with materials eventually existent in the depots and on the market.

We remain in expectation of being informed of the decisions of MIA.

This would, in effect, mean forming another 3 mobile centres which, in accordance with the W/O, would require a slight increase in personnel, comprising, that is, 3 junior medical dental officers and 9 NCO's and OR's.

Since, however, the difficulties met with by this SM in the preparation of vehicles equipped for dental services are known, MHA, whenever it considers acceptable the above proposal, would have to be so kind as to assist in supplying the 3 vehicles and medical materials required. On the event of British resources not permitting it, the 3 vehicles could be drawn from the Italian ones recovered during the operations in North Africa and Sicily, or be provided for within the limits of possibility, with materials eventually existent in the depots and on the market.

We remain in expectation of being informed of the decisions of MHA.
