Subject: Disbandment of the temporary garrison MI Room of Orvieto.

1. Following the requirements that will be determined by the imminent reduction of the cadres, it is necessary to arrange the gradual disbandments of temporary units. Therefore we order, w.e.f. 20th January 1947, the disbandment of the temporary garrison M.I. Room of Orvieto.
 (W/E SS/29/I - pamphlet 13/S).
2. To meet the medical requirements of the 8th CAR, a Corps M.I. Room will be formed, as carried out by other similar units, which will function with the personnel on the W/E strength of said CAR.
3. Personnel:
Officers: the names of these, after having filled up eventual deficiencies of the CAR's W/E, will be reported to the Officer Personnel General Directorate.
NCOs and men: these will be placed at the disposal of the Rome Military Territorial Command in order to fill up deficiencies in the W/E's of the units under its command.
Civilians: the instructions already issued or that will be issued by the Cabinet and by the Civilian Personnel and General Affairs General Directorate, prevail.
4. Equipment.
 These will be used in order to render the Corps M.I. Room efficient. The equipment in excess will be handed in to the nearest directional stores.
5. Eventual particular instructions for the movement of patients (who cannot be cured by the Corps M.I. Room) to the nearest medical establishments, will be issued by the Medical General Directorate.
6. Please inform us on completion of disbandment.

3. The formation of the Commissions in question ³⁴⁷⁹ intended to give a more rapid and easy settlement of the many war pensions of the present moment. As they are of a temporary nature the Commissions cannot be included in the M/E and the military personnel assigned to them will not receive the food ration in kind.

The policy of increased strictness in physical sorting of yearly recruits will further improve health conditions at CARs.

On account of this fact, it doesn't appear necessary for the moment to increase the strength of such service, bearing also in mind that Territorial Military Hqs and CAR Hqs never laid forth any special needs as regards this service.

In the case of exceptional needs CAR Hqs will have certainly taken measures strengthening the Service's personnel with some other elements belonging to dependent units.

It will nevertheless be this Hq's care to scrutinize the problem and do away with the trouble complained about improving the training standard of personnel allotted to the service (MOs and hospital orderlies).
