SUBJECT: Intelligence Groups to Operate in North Italy.

TO: Italian Army Intelligence,
Palazzo Barachini, Rome.

1. Reference is made to your letter of 19 April 1945, file: N.50521/S, same subject, which has been discussed with Assistant Chiefs of Staff, G-2 and G-4 of this Headquarters.
2. While it is true that 15th Army Group is responsible for military operations in North Italy, it is not responsible for the activities of I.A.I. in general. Your proposed operations in North Italy, such as the establishment and maintenance of centers, is a long-range project and should properly be the concern of AFHQ which will eventually coordinate the various military Headquarters in the areas to the North. The fact that you propose to establish the centers early in an effort to assist 15th Army Group does not alter the principle.
3. It is desirable, from the point of view of this Headquarters, that it have the assistance which your proposed centers can render. It cannot do more, however, than recommend to G-2, AFHQ, that your requests for additional personnel and equipment be granted.
4. It is understood that the industrial and counter-intelligence personnel are not part of this discussion.

1. Reference is made to your letter of 14 April 1945, file: 55425/3 in reply to letter of this Headquarters of 9 April 1945, file: SF/NWI/2, same subject.

2. Paragraph 2 of your letter indicated that 808 Bn CS has not been considered in preparing the lists as it is already formed and approved. The question of formation and approval is not in point. It is desired to put together a consolidated list of all intelligence personnel who will be physically present in North Italy so that some administrative basis can be reached, such as for drawing rations. It is requested, therefore, that you forward some indication of the strength by area of CS which will operate in North Italy.

3. This Headquarters cannot take any action on the request embodied in paragraph 3 of your letter for additional personnel. It is believed this matter should be referred to MMIA and AFHQ.

4. MMIA (Colonel Kerr) has verbally stated that, within the available facilities, every effort will be made to facilitate the acquisition of adequate transportation.

1. Attached are copies of correspondence on the same subject between I.A.I. and G-2 of this Headquarters.

2. It is believed that the general activities of I.A.I. must be coordinated between districts, etc., by AFHQ and are not the responsibility of this Headquarters, although its early establishment in North Italy will be of great assistance to 15th Army Group.

3. It is requested, therefore, that their needs for the adequate coverage of the North be met as appropriate to permit the proposed centers to function at an early date.

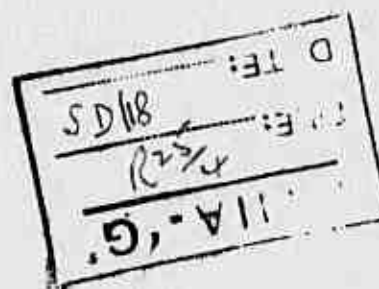
