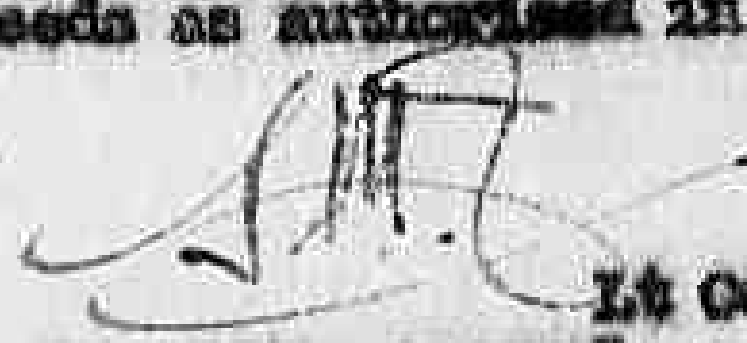

I am writing to you in continuation of the CAO's letter of 19 July on the subject of Italian Intelligence Units. We have referred the proposition that you make in para 3 of your letter of 2 July to G-2 and the gist of their reply is as follows.

The Italian Army Intelligence is fully employed in observing, under control of G-2, the domestic situation in Italy which they consider to be ripe for internal disorder of varying magnitude. The withdrawal of American and British personnel makes G-2 rely more and more on Italian CI personnel.

G-2 further state that they are making full use of the Italian Army Intelligence and in fact are searching for ways and means of reinforcing certain critical sectors in Italy with capable Italian Army Int personnel.

They regret that they cannot agree to the dissolution of Italian Army Intelligence until AFHQ has not further Intelligence or Counter-Intelligence responsibility in Italy.

I know that this runs counter to what you feel but I do not see that we can do any more than refer the matter to G-2 who are the experts and the employers of Italian Army Intelligence.

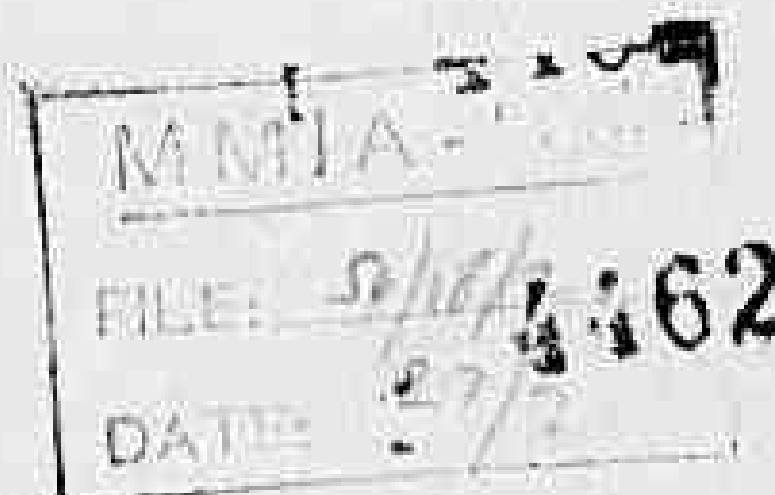

1. In accordance with your instructions I have exploited the various means of maintaining C.S. under the operational command of G-2, AFHQ, in view of the imminent constitution of an autonomous Italian Army.
 2. In the first place I believe, for several reasons, that it would be inadvisable to consider the transfer of C.S. to the Ministry of the Interior. The chief of these reasons are:
 - a) - the improbability of the ultimate reassumption of C.S. officers and NCO's into the Italian Army, and their consequent loss of status;
 - b) - difficulties attending administration and discipline;
 - c) - the extreme dislike with which the change-over would be received by Italian Authorities;
 - d) - the possibility of resolving the problem much more simply and efficaciously as shown below.
 3. In consultation with MMIA, it has been possible to arrive at the two following proposals which might be adopted without any notable change in the organization or functions of C.S. in relation to the Allies-
 - a) - that the 808 C.S. Bn be absorbed into the new autonomous Italian Army but that an augmented Liaison Staff be attached to it in order to take care of Allied Security interests;
 - b) - that C.S. remain under operational command of G-2, and for discipline and administration of the Italian Army through the MMIA.
- This will be rendered possible in view of the fact that approximately 30,000 Italian troops are to remain under control of MMIA for a period of about six months or possible more.
- At the end of this period, this number will be absorbed into the autonomous Italian Army.

Col. INGLEDEW of MMIA has suggested that the 808 C.S. Bn might be included within this category.

4. Of these two proposals, I am of the opinion that the latter is much more practicable, more advantageous to us, and infinitely more simple in its implementation. In other words it would mean, if you agree to this proposal, that virtually there would be no change in the present status of C.S.
5. The first suggestion (a) has the serious disadvantage that Allied Security would only be able to request, through the Liaison Staff, that certain directives be carried out and that effective control would depend entirely on the good-will of the Italian 'Stato Maggiore'.
6. I have talked the matter over with Major DOTTI and Col. AGRIFOGGIO and I am convinced that solution (b) has every advantage in securing the continuation of the present valuable contribution to Allied Security which C.S. has given over a period of a year and a half.
7. I trust that the above suggestions will be of use to you in making an appropriate decision as to the future organization of C.S.

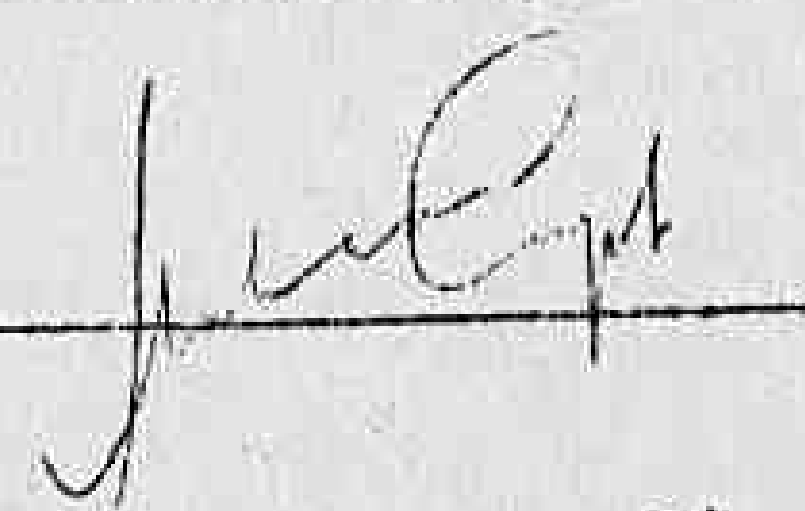

The following are LMMIA comments on the Ministry of War letter SARE 55591/S of 23 June translation of which was forwarded to you with our letter under reference.

1. ZURETTI Section.

In connection with the preannounced demobilization of the 809 Incr to 1 Special Force, we wish to point out the following:

- the unit in question included, as is known, several hundred soldiers who carried out special missions in enemy-occupied territory. Upon termination of the mission each soldier must go through various operations (review of work done, review of his administrative antecedents and service records, preparation of recommendations for rewards, etc.) requiring a certain amount of time, since matters are involved which should be handled with a great deal of care.
- as of this date a large portion of the personnel used for missions has been processed. A substantial part, however, is still being processed, while, on the other hand, many men are still to be recovered and have not been heard from so far.

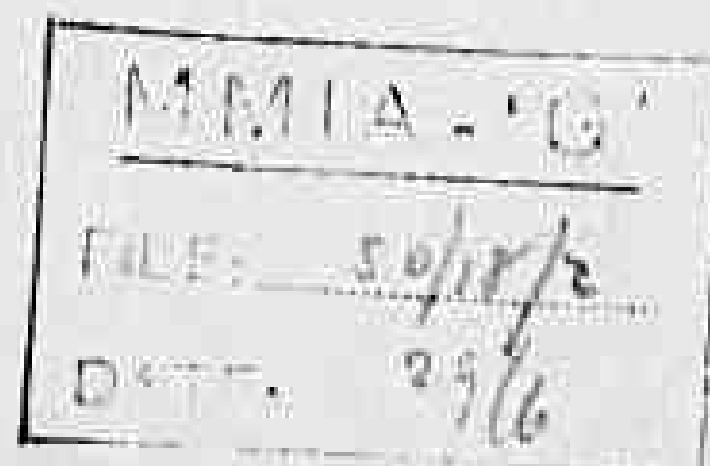
In view of the foregoing it is estimated that in order to settle all pending matters there will be required for a few months the services of a small group of personnel of the 809 Incr to 1 Special Force of a total strength of 30 men (officers, senior NCO's and EM) and it is therefore requested that from the date of disbandment of the above mentioned unit until August 31 next there be authorized an increase of 30 men in the strength of I.A.L. units category I in order that a rear party of the 809 Incr to 1 Special Force may be organized.

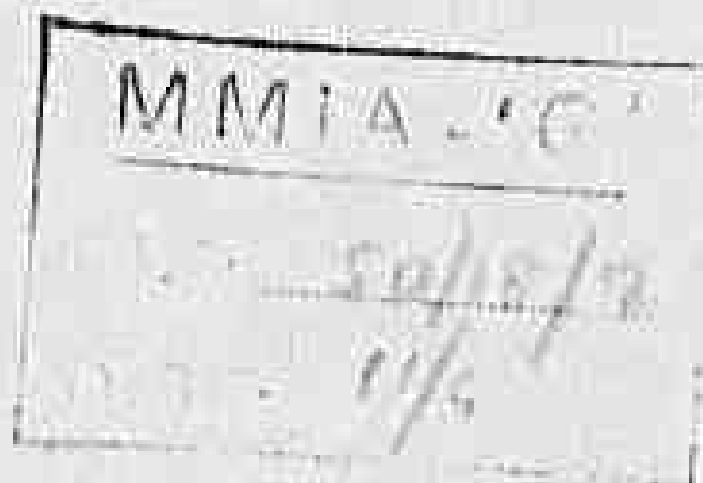

1. The Italian Army intelligence units (formerly SIM) were organized and maintained for the specific purpose of assisting the Allied War effort. Now that this purpose has been served, it is suggested that there is no further reason for maintaining these units, which are in fact secret police. Moreover, while the personnel has rendered valuable service to the Allies, the elimination of this agency from the Italian scene should tend to improve Allied-Italian relations, as the average Italian has only a hatred for the secret police units, which have been simply an outgrowth of the necessity of the previous regime to perpetuate itself by spying, intimidation and force.
2. The elimination of these units would reduce the ITI-ITI ceiling by 1890 and the BR-ITI commitment by 1233, thereby effecting a saving of rations in equal numbers.
3. It is believed that no further proper use is available for the 1890 ITI-ITI personnel, and the ITI-ITI ceiling should be reduced by this number.
4. The units affected are shown in detail in Appx "A" attached.

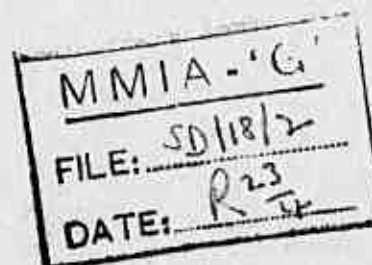
