1. This HQ and Ministry of War are experiencing considerable difficulty in the provision of interpreter personnel for BR-ITN units. Although there is in the Italian Army a reasonable number of officers and ORs suitable for employment as liaison officers and interpreters, very few can now be made available to meet new commitments. This is largely due to:

- (a) lack of adequate records of the present whereabouts of these linguists;
- (b) unauthorised use of liaison officers and interpreters by formations and units.

It is therefore considered essential to regularise the entitlement of these interpreters so that unauthorised attachments may be terminated and personnel collected and trained to meet authorised commitments.

2. It is recommended, therefore, that the following steps be taken to provide WE cover for the interpreter personnel which are required by British formations and units.

It is felt that requirements can best be considered under the following headings:-

- (a) Armies
- (b) Static HQs
- (c) Individual units

3. ARMIES

The requirements of British Troops in Fifth and Eighth Armies are covered by CM/782/1 - Italian Intelligence Liaison Unit.

4. STATIC HQs

It is recommended that 861 Intelligence Liaison Pool be deleted from the Overall Order of Battle - Italian Army (ASD/922.5 of 6 May), and an establishment be approved for a new unit to be called "Pool of Italian Liaison Officers", strength 165 Offrs (of which up to 50% may be ORs, if suitable ORs are available), i.e. an increase of 65 over the present allocation under 861 Intelligence Liaison Pool.

It is felt that the word "Intelligence" should be omitted from the title of the est as the duties, which will be performed by the personnel, will be on the liaison rather than on the intelligence side.

It is recommended that 861 Intelligence Liaison Pool be deleted from the Overall Order of Battle - Italian Army (LSD/922.5 of 6 May), and an establishment be approved for a new unit to be called "Pool of Italian Liaison Officers", strength 165 OFrs (of which up to 50% may be ORs, if suitable ORs are available), i.e. an increase of 65 over the present allocation under 861 Intelligence Liaison Pool.

It is felt that the word "Intelligence" should be omitted from the title of the post as the duties, which will be performed by the personnel, will be on the liaison rather than on the intelligence side.

A proposed WE is attached at appendix "A". This WE is composed of two parts as follows:-

(a) District Pool

As all Districts command a varying number of static HQs an approximate requirement has been calculated. This is based on an average of present District commitments. It is considered that only a nucleus of Italian Army personnel should be employed by Static HQs and that the maximum use should be made of civilians. The allocation

This Pool would be under control Districts, rather than of Italian Adm Divs, as Districts will be more conversant with Br Static HQ requirements and will have full control of the interpreter personnel through the senior MAIA LO and the senior Italian LO at District HQ.

(b) Central Pool

As the requirements of all Districts are never likely to be the same and as the District Pool has been kept to a minimum of key personnel, it is considered that there will always be a demand from Districts for temporary allocation of additional liaison personnel. A central pool is, therefore, essential, from which allocation to Districts can be made and to provide an ost against which liaison officers and interpreters can be held. The allocation is based on a rough average requirement of 15 per District. The pool would remain under control of Land Forces Sub Ccm, AC (MAIA).

(c) Only officers are included in the est, as it is practically impossible to find suitable Italian NCO interpreters, but a note has been added stating that up to 50% of the vacancies may be filled, when possible, by NCOs for interpreter duties.

5. UNITS.

1. Reference is made to RAAC/117/01 (Rev) dated 2 February 1945.
2. It is desired that all Liaison Sections of the Italian Army attached to Allied Headquarters should be organized on WE/TDs.
3. Request information as to whether the Liaison section referred to in your letter is engaged (a) as a mission acting on behalf of the Italian Authorities, or in the service of either (b) the British Staff of RAAC (c) the US Staff of RAAC or (d) equally in the service of both British and US Staffs.
