III REASONS FOR THE PROPOSAL

- (a) Additional 3 Officers

The existing establishment allows for a Commanding Officer, an Adjutant and a Subaltern on the Headquarters, and for one Captain or Lieutenant in charge of each of the three wings. An additional subaltern officer is required for each wing. It is considered that the efficient running of a wing of this camp, which may at any one time be administering up to 1,000 transit personnel, is beyond the capacity of one officer, particularly at this time and in the near future when 007 Transit Camp will be working continuously at capacity.

The existing 12 allows for three 15 cwt and four three-tonners. The 15 cwt are employed continuously within the camp on camp fatigue duties within the wings and for miscellaneous local runs. The following commitments remain:-

TO : Italian Liaison G-4 Fifth Army

The increasing number of Italian personnel in transit through Bologna, and belonging to HQ's and agencies under direct Italian Command has made it necessary for this HQ to establish a Transit Camp in Bologna, owing to the fact that personnel of this category has no assistance whatever.

It has not been possible, as it seemed at first sight, to back this outfit to one of the Transit Camps of the Supply units (n. 805) and Combat Groups (n. 58) located near Bologna (5 Km East), previous agreement of the concerned Allied HQ's.

In fact, both the above said Transit Camps are organized and located in such a way that they can only billet and feed personnel organized in squads, furnished with transportation and going to their units, and can not assist casual EM in transit for whom the Transit Camp should be located in the city. This HQ is therefore organizing and equipping the necessary billets in Bologna, where Italian personnel in transit could be billeted and fed, disregarding their category and therefore including those attached to Combat Groups and service units under Allied direct command.

In order to meet the requirements of rations of the above personnel, a daily allotment of rations from Allied sources is necessary.

The objection that, in theory, each man should be issued 2 days travel rations when leaving his unit, does not stand. In fact, scores of EM report daily to this HQs (sometimes even 100), requesting rations because they already eaten their travel rations, owing to the difficulty of finding transportation and to the length of their travel.

In front of this situation, it is necessary to find a remedy, both to assist our soldiers and protect them against the speculation of civilians.

This HQs in trusting that the Allied HQs will kindly consider this matter.

The average number of daily rations presumed to be needed is 50; this could be established more exactly after one month of working of the transit camp.

Said rations would be regularly controlled by the Transit Camp Command, and the administration would be documented daily. Proper remarks would be written on the EMs travel documents, so that it would prevent any EM to draw two rations for the same day, that is one from the transit camp, and one from his unit.

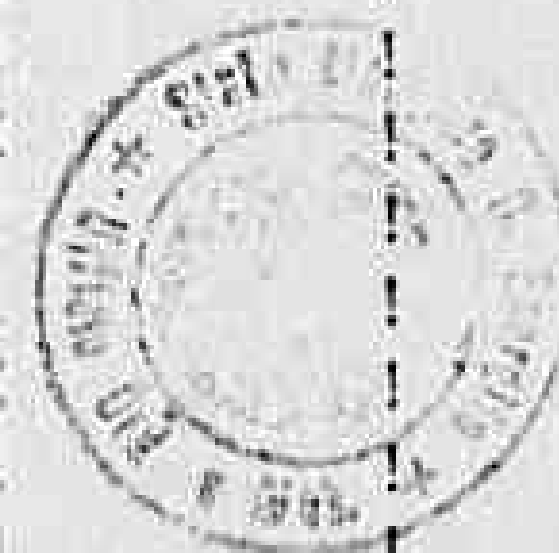

To : Italian Liaison G-4 Fifth Army

The increasing number of Italian personnel in transit through Bologna, and belonging to HQs and agencies under direct Italian Command has made it necessary for this HQ to establish a Transit Camp in Bologna, owing to the fact that personnel of this category has no assistance whatever.

It has not been possible, as it seemed at first sight, to back this outfit to one of the Transit Camps of the Supply units (n. 805) and Combat Groups (n. 58) located near Bologna (5 Km East), previous agreement of the concerned Allied HQs.

In fact, both the above said Transit Camps are organized and located in such a way that they can only billet and feed personnel organized in squads, furnished with transportation and going to their units, and can not assist casual EM in transit for whom the Transit Camp should be located in the city. This HQs is therefore organizing and equipping the necessary billets in Bologna, where Italian personnel in transit could be billeted and fed, disregarding their category and therefore including those attached to Combat Groups and service units under Allied direct Command.

In order to meet the requirements of rations of the above personnel, a daily allotment of rations from Allied sources is necessary.

The objection that, in theory, each man should be issued 2 days travel rations when leaving his unit, does not stand. In fact, scores of EM report daily to this HQs (sometimes even 100), requesting rations because they have already eaten their travel rations, owing to the difficulty of finding transportation and to the length of their travel.

In front of this situation, it is necessary to find a remedy, both to assist our soldiers and to protect them against the speculation of civilians.

This HQs in trusting that the Allied HQs will kindly consider this matter.

The average number of daily rations presumed to be needed is 50; this could be established more exactly after one month of working of the transit camp.

Said rations would be regularly controlled by the Transit Camp Command, and the administration would be documented daily. Proper remarks would be written on the EMs travel documents, so that it would prevent any EM to draw two rations for the same day, that is one from the transit camp, and one from his unit.

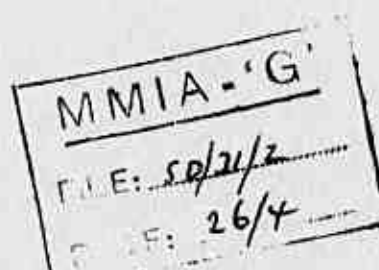
