2. It is desired to give the War Ministry the maximum possible assistance within the terms of the AMHQ instructions. Naturally arrangements can only be made through the competent authorities; that is to say 13 Corps and Allied Military Government. Anything you do must be done therefore as their agent.

2. It is desired to give the War Ministry the maximum possible assistance within the terms of the AMHQ instructions. These personnel are in the nature of displaced persons but as their problems are principally concerned with arrears of pay, and other military allowances it is felt that we should endeavour to arrange facilities for the necessary documentation etc. to take place.

3. Naturally arrangements can only be made through the competent authorities; that is to say 13 Corps and Allied Military Government. Anything you do must be done therefore as their agent.

4. Two possible plans suggest themselves to us.

- (a) A.M.G. to publish instructions for the personnel concerned to assemble at a point within V.G. to be moved in transport to be provided by 13 Corps to a suitable place outside the V.G. area where Udine territorial HQ can arrange the necessary documentation pay etc. The personnel should later return to the assembly point under similar arrangements.

- (a) the fact that our interest is in the personnel as such and not in the Italian Army aspects. (see 5 (c) below).
 - (b) what property formerly belonging to the Italian Army is of no interest to us at present.
 - (c) that the Italian Army itself can undertake no activities in V.G.

ANHQ has ruled that it is undesirable for the Italian Army to undertake any activities in VENEZIA GIULIA West of the Morgan line until the peace treaty is concluded, and that it is similarly undesirable at the present time to approach the Yugoslav government with a view to moving Italian Army Units from that part of VENEZIA GIULIA East of the MORGAN line.
2. It is regretted, therefore, that the request contained in your above mentioned letter cannot be granted.
3. However the MIA LO at UDINE has been fully informed of the position and has been instructed to give Territorial HQ the maximum possible assistance within the terms of AFHQ instructions above.



13. Italian Units in VENEZIA GIULIA : discussed contents of War Minister's letter of 13 July, 215406/II. The situation may be briefly summed up as follows:

- (a) At the time of the Armistice there were a number of Italian Army ests and installations EAST of the ISONZO River. These included, mil districts, depots, hosp., commissariat stores, V&R depots etc. All these installations were staffed by mil and civilian personnel.
- (b) It is not known now, either by the War Ministry or by Territorial HQ UDINE,
 - (i) whether above buildings are still standing or what they are being used for,
 - (ii) whether there are any Italian Army records, stores or materials still in the buildings,
 - (iii) what the situation is of the personnel, mil and civil, left behind at the time of the Armistice.
- (c) War Ministry request :
 - (i) authority to make reoce of above property to find out the present position;
 - (ii) decision as to future of the various ests and installations;
 - (iii) permission to regularise posn of personnel, i.e. pay arrears owing and transfer back to WEST of ISONZO personnel domiciled outside VENEZIA GIULIA.
- (d) Problem is in two parts, as affecting

SUBJECT: Italian Units in VENEZIA GIULIA

As is known, the Military Territorial Command of UDINE has been able to re-establish the Military Territorial organisation only within the boundaries of the Province of UDINE.

There are, however, existing to the east of the said Province, numerous Italian Military Units, containing Italian Military and civilian personnel, who, after making great sacrifices during the period of German occupation, have waited in vain for their liberation and a termination of their sufferings.

Communications received from the Directorate of Artillery at TRIESTE and the conscription office at FIUME, request the intervention of this Ministry in defining the situation of the existing units and for a settling of the disposal of their personnel.

Regarding as necessary, a speedy conclusion of the critical situation in which the said personnel find themselves, I beg the MMIA to consider the possibility of:-

As is known, the Military Territorial Command of UDINE has been able to re-establish the Military Territorial organisation only within the boundaries of the Province of UDINE.

There are, however, existing to the East of the said Province, numerous Italian Military Units containing Italian military and civilian personnel who, after making great sacrifices during the period of German occupation, have waited in vain for their liberation and a termination of their sufferings.

Communications received from the Directorate of Personnel at TRIESTE and the conscription office at FINE request the intervention of this Ministry in defining the situation of the existing units and for a settling of the disposal of their personnel.

Regarding as necessary a speedy conclusion of the critical situation in which the said personnel find themselves, I beg MIA to consider the possibility of:-

- Granting authority to the Military Territorial Command of UDINE, in accordance with the local Allied command of providing for (in the most convenient manner) the said units, in the zone which comes under Allied Military jurisdiction;
- Obtaining the consent of the Yugoslav authorities for the transfer (in accordance with orders to be laid down by the Military Territorial Command of UDINE) to the west of IDOMZO, of military and civilian personnel situated in territory at present under the jurisdiction of the Yugoslav Government.

I attach herewith a list of Italian Military Territorial Units existing prior to the Armistice, and situated to the East of the IDOMZO.

The first elements of this H. Q. found, upon their arrival in Turin on May 5th, that the Piedmont Territorial Organization was established in order to prevent complete disorganization. Because of the fact that the motor vehicles have not been reclaimed, and whilst awaiting the arrival of the M/T transport units to foreseen by the H.Q., this H.Q. can count on a few lorries, more or less in running order, which are insufficient only to fulfil the most important envisaged operations but also for the absolute necessities of dependent units (e.g. all other things, the rationing on units located outside Paris). It therefore appears necessary to obtain the help of the allied authorities for:

- decisive action if not present in Paris.
- temporary measures to this H.Q. at least 4 lorries and 6 passenger vehicles.

For the supply of motor vehicles it would be opportune that:

- the necessities of the Partisan Transport Cooperatives be abandoned.

1. The object of this letter is to restate and clarify the functions and responsibilities of Italian Army Territorial HQs and Division HQs with reference to MTOA Letter TS/C/12 of 26 Dec 44.

2. The layout of Territorial HQs is attached at Appx "A", Appx "B" shows the org and allotment of Adm Div HQs.

3. Adm Division HQs were formed in the first instance to maintain and administer on the Italian side, US-ITI, BR-ITI and ITI-ITI under command of British and American Armies, Base Sections and Districts to whom they were directly responsible and part of whose staff they may be said to be. When Combat Groups were formed and arrived in Army Areas Adm Div HQs allotted to Armies also administered them on the Italian side. The channel of command on the Italian side is normally - Unit - Adm Div HQ - Territorial HQ - War Ministry, ROME, but in actual fact since Territorial HQs did not function in Army areas before the cessation of hostilities, Adm Div HQs with Armies often dealt direct with ROME. For the above reason also they maintained and administered ITI-ITI Units in forward areas.

4. Territorial HQs were formed with the object of:-

- (a) Extending the authority of the Ministry of War over all Italy.
- (b) Enabling control of Army personnel, real estate and military stores to be reassumed as soon as possible.
- (c) Implementing the call-up or demobilization of classes as required.

- (d) Administering and maintaining ITI-ITI formations not under Allied Command in their area including all Districts and Depots.

Since the Commanding General of a Territorial HQ is the equivalent of a Corps Commander he is delegated certain powers (especially of command) by the Adjutant General.

5. Whilst APPX "E" and "F" which are attached for ease of reference to MILA letter TS/G/12 of 26 Dec 44 do in no way alter or affect by the cessation of operations it should be noted that Adm Div HQs with Armies are now for the first time located in areas where Territorial Div HQs are installed and have started into full function. SUBJECT: Situation state.

The III Military Territorial Command, which reached Milan about a month ago, has commenced functioning.

The H.Q.s of the Military Districts under command and the Depot H.Q.s have reached their locations and commenced their activities, mainly in respect of the operations of:-

- sending to concentration camps the regular army officers and NCOs who belonged to the republican army;
- screening of troops under arms at the time of the armistice, ascertaining their behaviour, and regularising their military position;
- reconstruction and bringing up to date of the rolls of all personnel of the various classes who have obligation to armed service;
- enlistment of partisans in the Army;
- payment of allowances to the families of servicemen who are P.O.W.s, missing, or deportees;
- tracing, recovering, guarding, and classifying, the enormous quantities of materials of all kinds and animals, belonging to the Military

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- enlistment of partisans in the Army;
- payment of allowances to the families of servicemen who are P.O.W.s, missing, or deportees;
- tracing, recovering, guarding, and classifying, the enormous quantities of materials of all kinds and animals, belonging to the Military Administration.

SITUATION OF THE DISTRICTS AND DEPOTS UNDER COMMAND:

Milan Military District: losses in horses, mules, stores, armouries, and part of the service record documents, the latter being looked after at Abbiategrasso and now taken back to the H.Q.s;

The District's premises are in good condition; the service personnel have been screened.

Pavia Military District: nothing to report.

Varese Military District: functioning in the part of the building not occupied by the English Red Cross Mission.

Monza Military District: a political prisoner camp is functioning at the old location (Pastrengo Barracks - Via Lecco) H.Q. and some of the offices are functioning in the Villa Redaelli (Via Azzone Visconti); the remainder in the "Ariolo Umberto 1st. Barracks" (Vicolo Corrobiolo).

Como Military District: files found in good order.

Sondrio Military District: functioning in other location, its former location, the "Gucciaridi" barracks, being used as a prison for internees.

Bergamo Military District: is in billeting difficulties as the "dei Mille Barracks" where it is at present functioning is largely used as a salvaged material park. The former H.Q. of the District, the "Colleoni" Barracks, is occupied by the "Legnano" Group H.Q. Materials have been stolen, all service records have been destroyed, files in a serious state of disorder.

Lodi Military District: nothing to report; is functioning in the "Melegnano" Barracks, its former location; the barracks is partly occupied by police agents whose evacuation is being negotiated.

Sondrio Military District: functioning in other location, its former location, the "Gucciardi" barracks, being used as a prison for internees.

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Materials have been stolen, all service records have been destroyed, files in a serious state of disorder.

Lodi Military District: nothing to report; is functioning in the "Melegnano" Barracks, its former location; the barracks is partly occupied by police agents whose evacuation is being negotiated.

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Treviglio Military District: building in disorder and without equipment, water or light. No files or documents exist.
The local authorities have advanced half a million for renovation of the premises.

Cremona Military District: documents and materials tampered with and partly destroyed. Two offices transferred to Casalbuttano in July 1944, are in working order and will return to H.Q.

Mantova Military District: functioning in "Randazzo" Barracks in good order.

Brescia Military District: returned in the early days of the current month from Sarezzo to Brescia ("Gioito" Barracks, its location).

Files and equipment in order. Part of the Barracks is occupied by a battalion of the 68th. Infantry which will be transferred to Bergamo.

67th. Infantry Regiment Depot - Como: (S.Chiare Barracks) (includes also 77th. and 78th. Infantry Depots). The files and materials formerly existent in said depot and that of Chiari (77th. Infantry) have been destroyed and taken away. At Bergamo (78th. Infantry) the files have been partly destroyed; 7000 weapons and barracks stores materials have been salvaged.

27th. Field Artillery Regiment Depot - Milan: the files and documents have been taken away and a small quantity recovered from inside Milan. (has absorbed the depots of: 30th. Field Arty., Brescia - 58th. Field Arty., Milan - 17th. Field Arty., Novara - and 59th. Field Arty., Vercelli, about which we are still not in possession of concrete data).

3rd (Light Cavalry Division) Artillery Regiment Depot - Milan: (includes the depots of 1st. and 2nd. (Light Cavalry Division) Arty., Regts., of Pordenone and Ferrara of which we are still not in possession of concrete information). Is functioning in part of the premises; the remainder has been used for the collection of various materials of the Piazza command, under control of the Allied Command.

Sezione Cavalleria Regiment Depot - Somma Lombardo: has been absorbed by the "Genova Cavalleria" Regiment Depot, Rome. We have recovered saddlery materials, documents, relics, "Officers Club" equipment, materials of the museum for the veterinary and farriery officers school, taken from Pinerolo by the fascists, are stored in the stores and guarded by patriot elements.

3rd Bersaglieri Regiment Depot - Lodi (Panfolla Barracks): the barracks has been ransacked at some time in the past; no furniture, water, or light, files and documents have been taken away. There is a very small quantity of artillery and barracks stores materials.

7th. Infantry Regiment Milan, Depot: building, furnishings, files, etc.,
destroyed by enemy action.

A battalion of the "Legnano" Group is still billeted in the barracks. The depot is being reformed in the premises of the 8th. Infantry (S.Ambrogio).

The practically total lack of means of transport is causing serious difficulties in the functioning of this Command and all the departments under command. The III Military Territorial Command should have on war establishment 10 cars, 60 medium and heavy trucks, and 30 motorcycles. Up to now, however, it has at disposal only 5 serviceable cars, 2 unserviceable cars, 7 trucks and 1 motorcycle.

In view of the really most important needs of transport, salvage, supplies, movements, surveys, inspections, enquiries, etc., of the numerous, widely spread out, and most distant depots, of materials which have been salvaged or are to be salvaged, explosives, etc., I have submitted to the Ministry the necessity of temporarily increasing the vehicle war establishment, bringing it up to at least 30 cars and 120 trucks, and consequently also increasing the Petrozzi allotment from 11,500 kilos to 75,000; the diesel allotment from 4,680 kilos to 30,000; and the oil allotment from 770 kilos to 5,250.

I shall also point out the great scarcity of CC.RR units assigned for the duties of guarding and surveillance, as a result of which the larger part of the existing materials depots cannot be garrisoned by said units, while the III Military Territorial Command, not having other troops at its disposal, is arranging, in part, to employ civilian personnel.

Another source of trouble is the smallness of the salary (averaging 1,500 - 2000 lire monthly) which is permitted for civilian personnel, which, as is known, form the larger part of the war establishment allowed for each unit by M.M.I.A. Much larger salaries, with less responsibilities and encumbrances, are offered in civilian life, thus rendering fruitless the search for the required civilian personnel.

In order to obviate the above I have proposed to the War Ministry the concession to such personnel of a cash ration allowance of about 66 lire net. daily as is done in Central and Southern Italy.

I would request the kind and urgent attention of M.M.I.A. to eliminate, or at least reduce, the above noted difficulties which obstruct the normal functioning of my command, and to put into effect, as soon as possible, the following measures in favour of this H.Q.: -

- issue of the vehicles and fuels to the extent which I have proposed to the Ministry of War;

In this connection we have again come across the Italian IV Territorial HQ which appears to have an AMGOT Charter by which they may collect Italian arms and ammunition in the area. The lastest development in this matter is that the VERCNA Section of the IV Territorial HQ has formed a Board of Artillery Officers to inspect ammunition in various dumps at present guarded by FRIULI ICG. This of course would be very useful but as they seem to be working without your authority it would assist FRIULI ICG if you could state exactly what function the IV Territorial HQ has, and what it is permitted to do. AMG FIFTH ARMY probably know some of the answers to this. Messages have been passed at various times to IV Territorial HQ instructing them to get their orders through AMGOT from FIFTH ARMY but up to date they appear not to have done so."

Will you please investigate the responsibilities of IV Territorial HQ.

(e) A Tribunale Militare in this area would go far to impose discipline upon all ranks. I have asked for one in my AM/112 para 8 dated 1 Mar 45 (Lisbon Log No.16); what is the status?

(f) What responsibility, if any, for dealing with Redristes has been delegated to 5 Territorial HQ from ROME? AMG here has the whole master in hand already.
