Subject:- Denominations of the Infantry Regiments not included in a Division.

1. In the reorganisation of the denominations of Army Units, it has been considered convenient for the Infantry Regiments to retain a denomination and a number.

For the Regiments not included in a division or in Infantry Brigades - considering also the wishes of the HQs concerned - the denomination has been chosen from those of one of the glorious corps of divisions and brigades, the name of which reminds of and honour the region under the jurisdiction of the Military Territorial Command to which the Regiment is now assigned.

Therefore, w.e.f. 1st April 1947, the following denominations will be adopted:

- 157th "Liguria" Infantry Regiment  
for the present 2nd Infantry Regiment of the Genoa Military Territorial Command;
- 40th "Bologna" Infantry Regiment  
for the present 6th Infantry Regiment of the Bologna Military Territorial Command;
- 70th "Toscana" Infantry Regiment  
for the present 7th Infantry Regiment of the Florence Military Territorial Command;
- 9th "Bari" Infantry Regiment  
for the present 9th Infantry Regiment of the Bari Military Territorial Command;
- 75th "Naples" Infantry Regiment  
for the present 10th Infantry Regiment of the Naples Military Territorial Command.

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2. As the denomination given to the Infantry Regiment of the Naples Military Territorial Command is the same as the 76th "Naples" Regiment of the "Bontova" Division, the latter will modify its denomination adding to its number the name of the Division and assuming the relative badges.

The denomination will therefore be: 76th "Bontova" Infantry Regiment.

3. The Military Territorial Commanders will point out the important significance of the above instructions.

The 76th "Naples" Infantry Regiment, which during the war of liberation has become a part of the "Bontova" Division will be proud to assume its colours, knowing the glorious traditions of the "Naples" Division will be entrusted to the reformed 75th Infantry Regiment.



Further to letter 3850/Ord.II dated 1/8/46. -

1. - In order to commence the carrying out of the re-organisation programme of the depots, indicated in the above referred to letter, we order that the CAR depots take on the denominations shown in the enclosure n° 1, and all the functions given to regimental depots in the pre-war W/E, i.e. admin. and material management.

2. - Consequently, w.e.f. the 1st February 1947 the CAR depots will be transferred entirely under the command of the respective CAR Commanders. The depot Commander will be the "Audit Officer" who will have the rank of Lt.Col. -

X 3. - In order to carry out what has been laid down in the preceding paragraph, it is necessary that the respective depots exist in the same station as the CARs.

It is therefore necessary to arrange the setting up of the following depots w.e.f. the 1st February 1947:

The setting up will be respectively carried out using, generally, the personnel and the equipment of the following depots which will be disbanded on the 31st January 1947:

- 11th Infantry Depot - Forli - for the 6 CAR depot - Pesaro

The Military Territorial Commands concerned will adopt all the provisions in order to facilitate the location, in the station of each CAR, of the respective personnel of the a/m disbanded depots. For the civilian personnel wishing to be transferred to the new stations, eventual particular instructions will be given by the General Directorate of Civilian Personnel and General Affairs.

For the transfer to Avellino of the 10th CAR depot (temporarily at Salerno) the Military Territorial Command of Naples will forward concrete proposals bearing in mind the necessity of carrying out the provisions as soon as possible; the instructions contained in the previous paras 1 and 2 prevail also for said depot.

4. - For the depots which in compliance with the present instructions change their arm of service and trade, the replacement of the military personnel need not be made immediately as the duties they carry out are on the whole identical for the depots of the various arms.

Therefore the Military Territorial Commands can gradually arrange the replacements in accordance with the exigencies of the service and, as far as possible, of the personnel in the particular present situation.

5. - For the completion of the a/m instructions, eventual particular rules will be given by the central units concerned.

6. - Upon completion of the transformation and transfer of the units in question, please inform the central units concerned. -



SUBJECT:- Reorganisation of regimental depots and C.A.R. depots.

1. - We forward a programme of reorganisation of regimental depots and C.A.R. depots.

As is known almost all regimental depots existing at present have no connection with the regiments of which they have the denomination as those regiments have been disbanded in the past. The new organisation of the Army and the reduction of problems renders the reorganisation of the depots within the frame of the new structure of the Army necessary, assigning to each regiment in being a depot with the denomination corresponding to that of the unit to which it is assigned.

In the future the double reduction of the number of depots may be considered attributing only one to two inf regts of each division and one to the arty of same division.

Similarly for the brigades (already in practice for two brigades "Aosta" and "Reggio").

2. - For the C.A.R.s - which can be considered as static - it is considered advisable to place the command of the depot - for all purposes - under the commandant of the C.A.R. The commandant of the depot will therefore be a lt col and the location will be the same as that of the C.A.R.

For those C.A.R.s (from 6<sup>o</sup> to 10<sup>o</sup> see attached list) for which said coexistence has not yet been reached, the military territorial commands will forward proposals regarding the advisability of disbanding them and reforming them or transferring them to the location of the C.A.R. (question of transfer or dismissal of civilians).

The C.A.R. depot at Como will continue to deal with the questions of mobilisation of the 67<sup>o</sup> "Legnano" Inf Regt until instructions are issued assigning one depot to two inf regts of the division.

11<sup>o</sup> C.A.R. depot Palermo is also the depot of the arty and engineer units of Sicily.

3. - Regarding the registration and handling of material, the question can be considered solved for the C.A.R.s, inf bdes and inf regts not in divisions as the corresponding term regiment - depot permits the application of the instructions in the regulations for the administration and accounting of corps, military institutes and establishments - 1945 edition.  
 It yet remains to decide the question of the handling of material at regiments of divisions; it is being studied and the conclusions will be forwarded.
4. - The substitution of personnel as a result of change of arm or trade of the depots should be effected gradually, according to the opinion of the military territorial commands concerned, taking into account the requirements of the service and as far as possible the needs at the particular moment of the personnel.
5. - Before carrying out this programme, we beg the commands addressed above to inform of their opinions and eventual proposals before the 31 August next. (u)



The assignment, as a purely temporary measure, of a Brigadier Infantry Commander has been counselled by the necessity of avoiding too much work for the General 2nd.i/c who, at this particular moment, is fully occupied by the intensified activities of the districts and depots.

On the situation returning to normal, the duties of Infantry Commander will have to be assumed by the General 2nd.i/c, so that, thus, each Military Territorial Command will return to having at its disposal three General officers in addition to the Commander: the Infantry Commander (General 2nd.i/c), The Artillery Commander, and the Engineer Commander.

In the meanwhile, the Infantry Commanders posted in excess of establishment with the letter which this follows, will carry out Inspectorate and consultive duties exclusively. They must therefore depend, for the execution of their duties, on the Military Territorial Commands of which they form part, using the essential minimum of personnel ~~affixing~~ on the war establishment of said H.Q. and without the formation of their own offices.

SUBJECT: Organisation of military districts and regimental depots.

In reply to your SD/34/B of 3rd January 1946

1) - MILITARY DISTRICTS

SD: 343/34/3

TE: R/29/1

The present classification of the military districts under five categories is in line with that laid down in the past on the basis of the actual working requirements of each individual unit, checked over a long period of experience.

This classification is, without doubt, to be considered too minute and therefore, as already stated, we are in full agreement with M.M.I.A. on the advisability of reducing the classes of the districts to two, or three at the most.

It is essential, however, that this modification is carried out in strict relation to the strength of population looked after by each district, a strength which is at present being revised in order that, generally speaking, the boundary of each military district is the same as that of one or more provinces, or in such a way as to include, in particular cases, the entire boundaries of two or more districts within the territory of one very large and densely populated province.

In view of such complex work of revision which cannot be completed in a short period and which cannot in any event be

put into effect before the beginning of next year in order not to cause harm to the conscription operations, we consider it advisable to refrain, until the above mentioned period, from the projected modification of the present classification of the districts and of the war establishments laid down for them in very recent orders.

2) - REGIMENTAL DEPOTS

With the reestablishing of the peace time administrative regulations, it is necessary that all the regiments and corresponding units go back to making use of their respective depots not only for documentary matters but also for the administration and management of stores.

It is moreover necessary for the depots to still provide for the rear party activities of the numerous units formed by them (and by others formerly existent) in the past, and now disbanded.

In relation to these requirements, each regiment or R.T.C. will be assigned its own regimental depot at the same H.Q. or in another nearby.

The rear party duties in respect of the disbanded infantry units can be carried out by the same depots intended to remain functioning, but in respect of the artillery units it will be necessary, however, to transfer them not only to the depots of the few existent artillery regiments but also to at least one other artillery depot for each comiliter.

The programme for the reorganisation of the regimental depots is shown on the attached return. There will be, generally speaking :

Firstly : change of name of the Infantry and Artillery depots

in order that they will coincide with the existing regiments and to bring them as close as possible to the latter in respect of location.

Changing on the spot of depots which are no longer necessary (artillery, railway and bridging engineers, light infantry, etc.) into depots planned for in the programme.

Secondly: Gradual disbandment of the excess depots (mainly in Central-Southern Italy and Sardinia) and the formation in Northern Italy of those depots which are still short in the actuation of the programme.

At present some of the measures of the first phase are being put into effect; the remainder and those planned for phase 2 will be ordered as soon as possible.

1) In order to equalise the present internal organisation of the districts with the existing functional requirements it is considered advisable to submit some light modifications to the classifications now in force, a modification which would not, however, mean any increase in the total strength laid down.

2) The proposed modifications are as follows:-

a) districts of the 1st.class:are sub-divided into:-

Class 1/A:Milan - Rome (12 units each as at present)  
these are the districts most burdened as they are the result of the combining of the former districts of Milan I, Milan II, and Rome I, and Rome II, respectively;

Class 1/B:Turin and Naples(9 units each);thus,a reduction of 3 units is made to Turin(which has 12 at present) and an increase of 3 to Naples which is therefore changed from the 2nd.Class to 1.B.

b) the forming of a 5th.class(formerly existent in the old organisation): war establishments as for the 4th. class (4 units) with the exception of some modification in civilian personnel;8 districts will change over to the new class,which at present belong to the 4th.class.

With the exception of some modification to civilian personnel,no change is made in the others.

3) As a consequence of the above,the splitting up of the strength laid down for the districts in heading 15 of M.M.I.A.letter SD/94 of 7.2.1945.,will be modified as shown in column 2 of the enclosed list,while,as stated,the total remains unaltered.


