1. In your publication entitled "Review of Allied Military Government and of the Allied Commission in Italy", it is stated on page 77 in the chapter on 'Work of the Sub-Commission' that:-

"Owing to the lack of equipment, only the FRIULI Combat Group had not been completely activated as the Italian Campaign ended".

2. I feel that that sentence will cause some ill feeling amongst many readers, as the FRIULI Gruppo was, with the CREMONA, the first to be formed. It was the second in the line following the CREMONA by about a month. It took over a sector of the line on the River SENIO, from a POLISH formation in January 1945, remained there until the Spring offensive started, and took part, as front line troops, on the advance to, and occupation of, BOLOGNA. Men of the FRIULI Combat Group were the first Italian soldiers to enter into BLOCHNA.

3. The statement "Owing to the lack of equipment" - is not understood, as the FRIULI Gruppo was certainly equipped as well as any of the other Combat Groups.

Dear General,

For my last report before leaving 50 BLU to join your own staff in ROME there is I think little of special note.

1. Locations.

All unchanged.

2. Employment.

Unchanged.

(a) Guard commitments on dumps are being gradually reduced as Number 1 and 2 CEM Gps close down or clear the Dumps.

(b) We have had noticeably less success in searches for hidden arms. not, I fear, because the arms are not there to find but because information is falling off and material is better hidden.

We did however collect 115 inhabitants of the ORA area who were all ex-members of the GERMAN army, and had no discharge papers from ALLIED PW Cages and no documents.

The operation involved the use of a whole bn and was excellently organised.

(c) Training continues to be at a very low pressure.

3. Efficiency.

Satisfactory, but must decline as older classes are released, and young or untrained men replace them.

4. Discipline

Slight improvement.

5. Turn Out

Temporarily improved by going into winter clothing.

6. Morale.

Satisfactory, but all ranks are most depressed at becoming 'FRUIT INF DIV' and their distinctive title of 'COMBAT GROUP'.

7. Politics

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Temporarily improved by going into winter clothing.

Satisfactory, but all ranks are most depressed at becoming 'FRUIT THE DIV' and their distinctive title of 'COMBAT GROUP'.

7. Politics

Nothing noteworthy. Senior Officers still feel that the Government is deliberately letting down the Army, and that no real improvement in efficiency and devotion to duty can be expected until they know where they stand.

8. General.

- (a) Relations between General SCATTINI and General NEGROMI are uneasy, though General SCATTINI assures me that they are excellent between other TERRITORIAL DISTRICT and DIV Comds. Much of the fault lies with General SCATTINI who resents the loss of his comparative autonomy under the ALLIES. General NEGROMI does, however, appear to insist on his measure of authority full and running over, particularly in his insistence that e.g. in BELLUNO where a Lt Col belonging to DISTRICT is located, this Lt Col should over-rule and give orders to the MAJOR Comd the PRINLI Bn, also stationed there, in all matters of discipline and administration. I cannot judge how much this is the recognised ITALIAN system, but it is undoubtedly a bad one.
- (b) General SCATTINI is most anxious to move his Div, as soon as possible, to the area of a large town and there establish himself apparently 'in perpetuo', as was the ITALIAN pre-war custom. He backs this by saying the economic circumstances of his Officers, which are now appalling, would be thereby greatly eased, in that they would take houses etc., in the knowledge that they would not have to move on at a moment's notice. Pay of Officers is so bad that Officers are applying for posting to cheaper and more 'secure' areas, and replacements do all they can to avoid coming to the Div.
- (c) General SCATTINI's health is very bad and he is having a most damaging effect on all his Officers. I do feel that we should be justified in pressing for him to be sent on sick leave, otherwise, good Officers, such as his new and excellent Chief of Staff, will be driven crazy or will apply for posting.
