Ref your G-5: 384-51, our 6/29 of 30 June 45.

From telephone conversation W.D. HANSON - HOWARD 3 July 45 it is understood that the Italian Ministry of War will be charged with Board Disposal by A.E.F. and that definite arrangements will be made for allotment of personnel for this task. A letter confirming this understanding is requested.

B. Appendix "A" attached hereto is Ministry of War's proposed A.R. for Land Disposal Unit as submitted by them 30 June.

C. Present organisational structure provided consists of a small number of trained civilians supervised by artillery personnel in the various territorial commands. Only emergency disposal has been attempted to date, for, because of civilian nature and lack of equipment and transport, organisation is considered inadequate by the War Ministry.

D. MIA feels that Ministry of War's A.R. is larger than necessary and contrary to present policy of reducing combat troops. It is therefore proposed that War Ministry be authorised only to:

- (a) Increase supervisory personnel, 1.0, trained artillery personnel, as necessary.
- (b) Employ civilians.
- (c) Be furnished information, technical help and special equipment by the Allies.
- (d) Use transport assigned or to be assigned to territorial Commands.
