1. I would like to draw your attention to the dangers of looting in the event of the B.L.U., IIC Central Military Schools and the Police School leaving Cesano.
2. At present the strength of the Infantry School is barely adequate to guard efficiently the main area they at present cover, and carry on normal activity of administration and training.
3. An incident occurred on the night 1/2 May, of an attempted theft of the Cash Box of the P.T. School by soldiers and civilians. Moreover, cases of theft of tyres etc have occurred from 155 Workshops area.
4. The situation is aggravated by the fact that many soldiers of the permanent staff here at CESANO are remnants of the days of completely, as opposed to partly, indisciplined soldiers.
5. The difficulties of guarding CESANO are obvious. The civilians here are mainly undesirable and unreliable.
6. I would suggest:
 - (a) The personnel of permanent staff of Infantry School be brought up to strength as far as possible and the old permanent staff changed gradually for new blood from C.A.Rs.
 - (b) Hawkers and Vendors to be barred from the Camp.
 - (c) Civilians at present living in the Camp should be moved, or at least screened as to desirability.
