In view of the above and your requests for the transfer of the School in question from Cesano to Rome, we beg you to re-examine the possibility of agreeing to the request made by the S.M.E. in letter 2553/S/6 of the 19 ^{APRIL} May last, concerning only the derequisitioning of a part of the Foro Italico, for the purpose of accomodating at least, for the time being, the School of Physical Training.

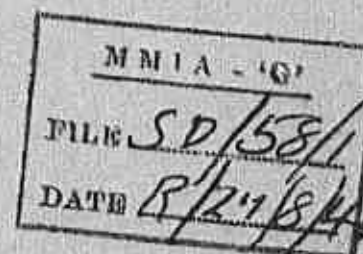

NO CHANGE FROM VERBAL ORDERS.

INFORMATION.

1. The Comando Scuole Centrali Militari have now requisitioned suitable accommodation for their Headquarters in ROME. This accommodation is located in the PALAZZO SALVIATI - LR 724671.

INTENTION.

2. 12 B.L.U. will move on TUESDAY 21 May '46 to this new location. The move will be completed by 22.00 hours the same day.

METHOD.

3. In order to obtain the necessary amount of transport for the move, Comando Scuole Centrali Militari have detailed 3 x 3-ton lorries to be made available as from 09.00 hours 21 MAY '46.

4. The move will be carried out in two FLIGHTS as follows.

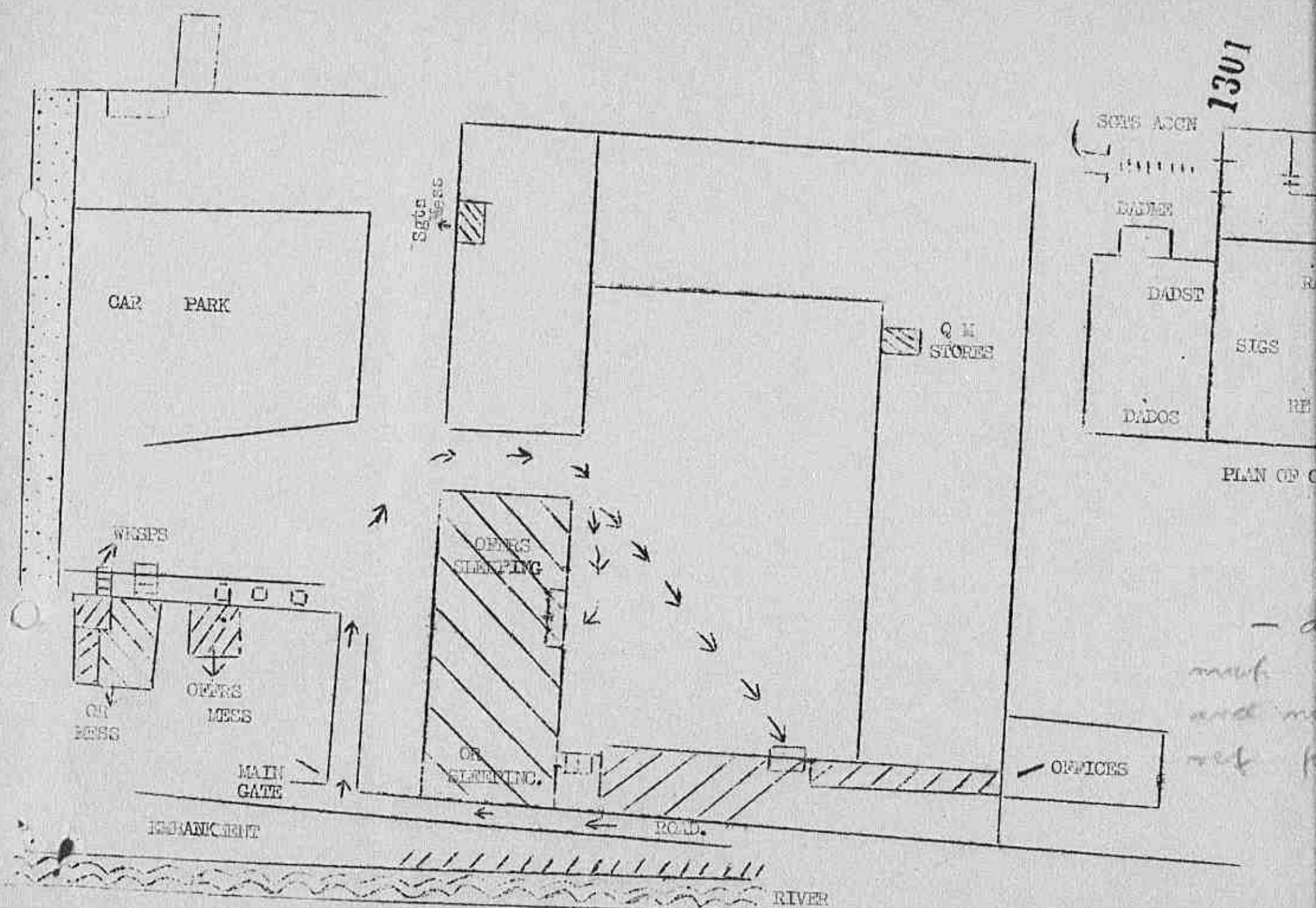

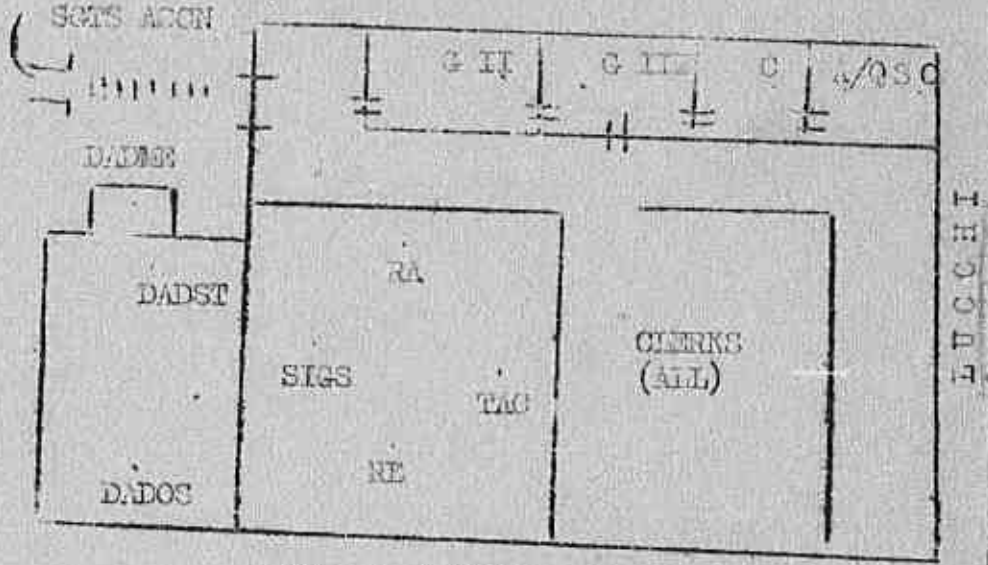
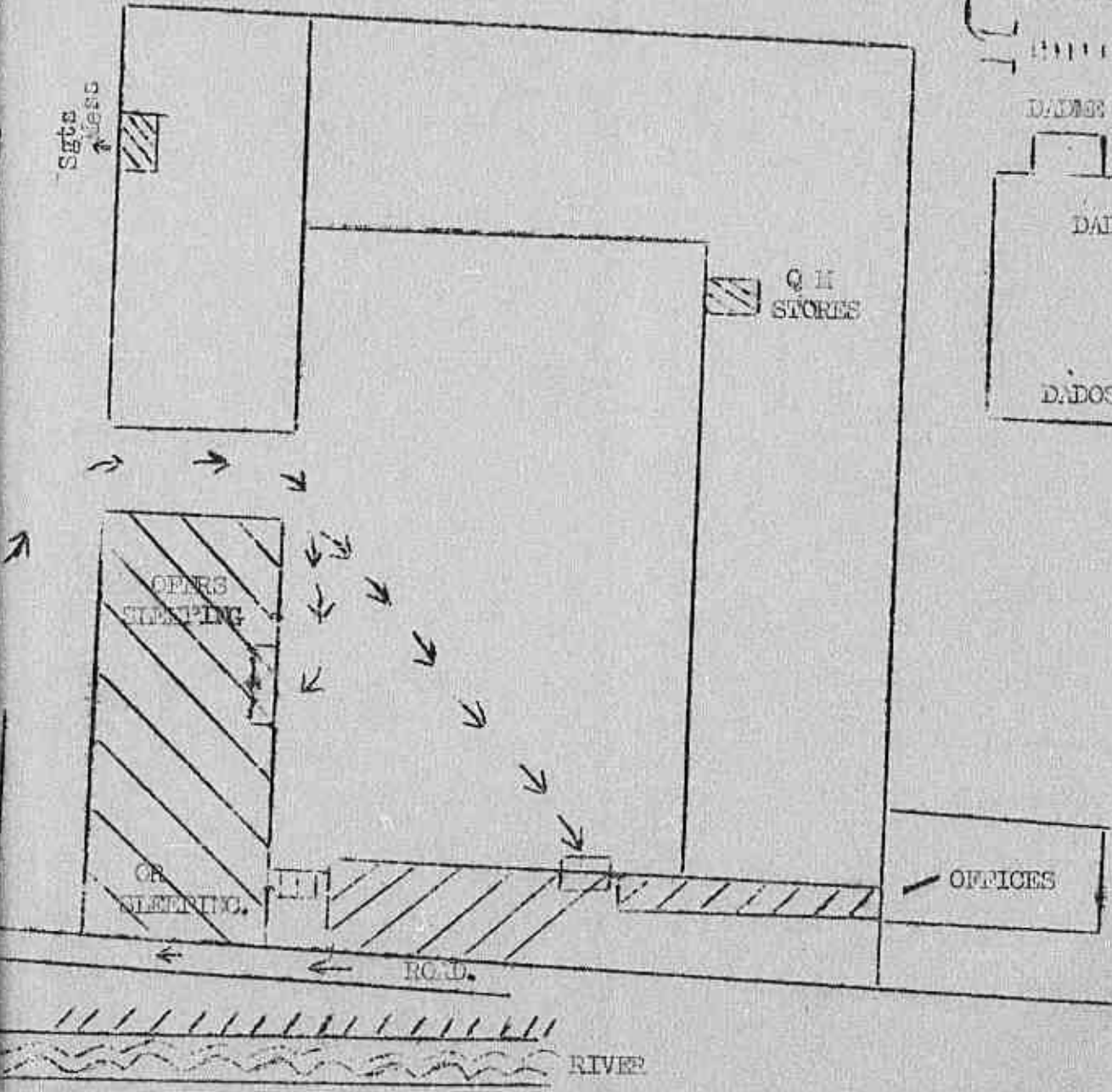
