1. It is noted that the 2nd Office of the Infantry Inspectorate does not include a section for CAR.
2. Since all Infantry non specialists are trained at the CAR it would appear that Inspection and Control of CAR is in fact one of the most important responsibilities of the Inspector of Infantry.
3. It is suggested therefore that the 2nd Office of the Inspectorate should include a 3rd section (CAR) consisting like the others of at least a Lt-Col and 2 Majors.
4. Your views on this matter are requested.

My Dear General,

You have informed me of your decision to establish an Inspectorate of Infantry in the SUP and at the same time to abolish the Headquarters Central Military Schools and to bring the various schools under the direct control of the appropriate Inspectorates.

The proposal was discussed by your SUP with members of my Staff and I am in full agreement with it and believe that it will lead to increased efficiency.

There is however one matter connected with the new organization which I should like to bring to your notice. Apart from the increase in the responsibilities of the various Inspectorates, when the Schools are entrusted to them, there will also be a considerable increase in the responsibilities of the Ufficio Organismi e Addestramento firstly because the School of Cooperation between various arms will come directly under this office and secondly because the work of coordination of the activities of the various Schools, hitherto carried out by Military Central School HQ will also devolve on this office which must, at the same time, be responsible for the general direction of the training in the Army as a whole.

Up to the present time, owing to the presence of ALLIED Troops in ITALY and the fact that the ALLIES have virtually assumed temporary responsibility for the defence of ITALY, the duties of the Operations Section of your SUP have not been very heavy and it has proved effective to have an Operations Section and a Training Section grouped in one office with a single "Cape Ufficio" in charge of the two sections.

Now, however, I feel that the responsibilities of these two sections will be increasing considerably; the Training Section for the reasons that I have already given and the Operations Section through the necessity for developing in the coming months the plans and preparations for the assumption by the ITALIAN Army of the Military Defence of the Country. I would like, therefore, to suggest to you for consideration that the time has come for the formation of a separate office to deal with training matters only under a "Capo Ufficio" of sufficient experience and standing to be able to deal on level terms with the various Inspectorates in the coordination of Army Training generally.

Should you decide on adopting this course of action I feel that, in view of the fact that the training and tactical methods of the new IRAKIAN Army are based largely on the methods practised in action by the Combat Divisions, it would be most advantageous if the Officer you appoint as head of your Training Office should be one who has had combat experience in one of these Divisions.

I am aware that consideration and discussions have taken place at the War Ministry in regard to reorganization generally and it may well be that the proposals for the reorganization of the Ministry may include the idea of separate offices for training on the lines of the Directorate of Training in the BRITISH War Office.

As however the proposal I have made above is one that falls entirely within the jurisdiction of the GEM and in view of the long delays that may occur before the major reorganization of the Ministry may take place, I would like to ask you to consider my proposal on the merits as an interim measure without waiting for the possible eventual reorganization of the Ministry.

(e) The increase in Motor Cycles is due to the fact that telephone communication is always bad and can be said to be almost impossible on most occasions, even for Rome.

5. It would be very much appreciated if this matter could be investigated with a view to increasing the War Establishment with troop carrying vehicles and an addition of at least one Motor Ambulance.


