4. Bids for rail transport in the period 22-28 October have been made as shown above vide MMIA A 1333 of 11 October.
5. The detailed breakdown by Arms and trades of these drafts will be worked out on the basis of the bimonthly state received from the Infantry Division and the weekly signals from BLU's vide A 1238 of 15 Aug which are passed on to the Ministry of War. The Ministry of War will arrange the necessary coordination between CESANO and ORVIETO.
6. The Ministry of War will ensure that the above drafts include a proportionate number of officers. For this purpose officers surplus from BR-ITI disbanded units may be selected, apart from officers now at CESANO and ORVIETO.
7. "P" BTLU and British Cadre, Reorganisation Centre, ORVIETO will make every effort to ensure that all personnel are sent forward fully equipped to winter scale. Each man will be provided with a list of kit issued, and this will be checked on arrival at the Infantry Division.

Some three months ago AHEJ gave permission for the ORVIEFO Base Depot to be used temporarily as a Br-Iti Reorganisation Centre. In view of the fact that:-

- (a) No more Br-Iti units are being formed
- (b) Rfts are being posted from disbanded units direct to Adm Divs and Regtl Hqs
- (c) The reduced Br-Iti commitment generally
- (d) If ORVIEFO were closed a saving of 500 overheads would be affected, besides release of accommodation
- (e) If ORVIEFO were closed the whole of the Br Cadre could be dispensed with
- (f) Each Br-Iti Adm Div has its own transit camp
- (g) There is a tendency for ORVIEFO to become a dump like GESANO

I recommend the earliest possible closing of this joint.

Will you please say if you agree and recommend a date?

3. (1) Of the above only men against 2(a) have an unquestioned right to be accepted in IMTC under the present regulations.

(11) (b), (c) and (d) should only have been accepted if CESAMO was their unit at the time they went absent or sick. It is very probable however that most of them are absentees from other units, and should therefore have returned to their own formations (SMR signal 22480/Mob of 7 Sept to all Territorial H.Q.'s refers).

(iii) With regard to (e) and (f) the situation requires more precise definition from NWIA. SWE holds the view that once a call-up is authorized in a certain district the M.R.R. should, for the sake of equality of treatment, round up everyone of that class whom they find, even months after the call-up started (see (e)). This is taken by some districts to apply also to former members of the ITALIAN Army, still at serving age who have returned to their homes in Southern Italy when there has been a call-up of men of their age (see (2)). SWE has already issued an order (Sept 13) that men of this kind are not to be accepted in Southern Italy, but in districts where call-ups have been made the position has still to be defined. SWE suggests that they round up only those who were living in the district at the time of the call-up, but asks that authority should be given to ration such men pending posting.

(iv) Movements into CEBAS under (g), (h), and (i) are almost certainly unauthorized, and the result of Military Districts taking the line of least resistance. In the case of repatriated ex- (2) they are contrary to orders vide 1019 of 2 August which states that repatriated ex's may be re-enlisted into the Italian Army "provided they are posted immediately to vacancies in authorized units."

RECOMMENDATIONS

4. (a) Instruct Ministry of War that no more men will be sent to IRI-III from any source, except special drafts sent under by arrangement with IRI-III for training purposes. All other personnel must be absorbed locally or sent on indefinite leave.
- (b) Stop round-ups in call-up areas. There are objections to this - e.g. inequality of treatment, but given the present IRI-III, EX-III VS-III conditions, any other solution is impracticable.
- (c) Allow Terr. H.Q.'s to accept volunteers, repatriates, etc. only subject to immediate requirements in the territory.

5. The urgent need and only solution of all these difficulties is the authorisation of the increased IRI-III ceiling, which will allow Territorial Depots. Personnel for the new Italian Army are at present being maintained almost exclusively by the British. The British service requirement at present is only 55,000 men.

1. You are authorised to instruct Territorial Headquarters to draw on surplus personnel at the disposal of BR-ITI or US-ITI Adm. Divs. within their territory, following disbandment of units, etc., to make all ITI-ITI units under the Territorial H.Q.'s command up to W.E., and to keep them up to strength as and when demobilizable men are released.

2. BR-ITI and US-ITI personnel will only be transferred to the ITI-ITI category in this way when all BR-ITI units in the Area, whether Service units or Combat Divisions, are up to W.E. strength, and have sufficient personnel in addition to replace all men of the 1919 and older classes. Combat Divisions will normally receive reinforcements from C E S A N O, but Territorial H.Q.'s may allot reinforcements from Adm. Div. surpluses when this course is more convenient than drawing on C E S A N O.

3. Movements of personnel to O R V I E T O or C E S A N O and other formations vide M.M.I.A. A 1222 of 8 August and A 1264 of 28 August will therefore take place only in respect of personnel still surplus after local transfers required as above have been made.

4. In your instructions to Territorial H.Q.'s please clarify to what Territorial H.Q. each Administrative Division and each Combat Division is affiliated, and the arrangements to be made for affecting adjustments between one Territorial H.Q. and another.

1. Reinforcements for Mine Clearance Companies are not now available from 23 Engineer Combat Bn. as this unit has been assigned another task.
2. 561, 562, 563 and 564 Mine Clearance Companies will therefore be brought up to W.E. with reinforcements from IRTC, CESANO. Selected personnel from surpluses with Administrative Divisions may, if necessary, be sent to CESANO for this purpose.
3. Reinforcements selected for this task, if not already trained, will be given a ten-day course at CESANO before posting.
4. Rail movement of these reinforcements will be requested by MMIA for the period 17-24 September. You are requested to inform MMIA of numbers and destinations before 6 September.
5. It is realised that this means a considerable delay before personnel are effectively employed with the companies. 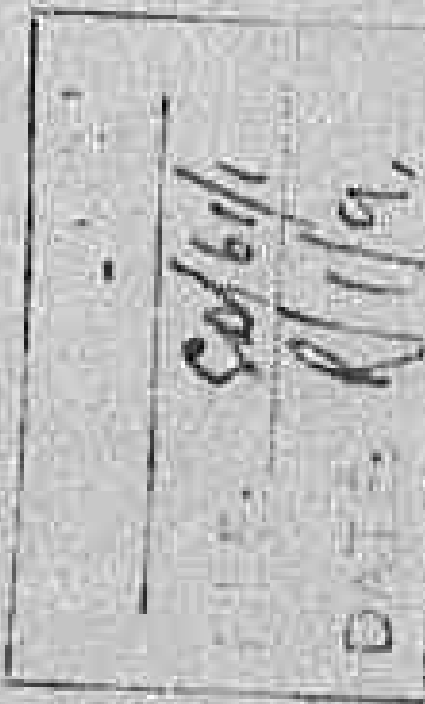

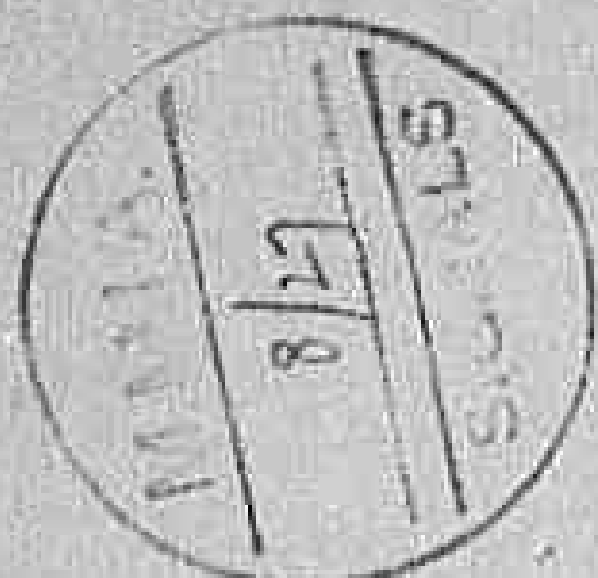

Territorial H.Q. GENOA, and BOLOGNA, will enlist 500 volunteers each, Territorial H.Q. MILAN, and TURIN will enlist 1,500 volunteers each. To be posted: by Territorial H.Q. BOLOGNA to FRIULI Combat Group and 228 Div; by Territorial H.Q. GENOA to MANTOVA Group and 230 Div; by Territorial H.Q. TURIN to the LEGNANO and FOLGORE Combat Groups. By Territorial H.Q. MILAN to CREMONA Combat Group and 231 Div, according to requirements. 1. The demand for Italian drivers has recently been very great, particularly as a result of the formation of six Tpt Cys for A.C.
2. Personnel are supplied by Rft Depots against demands according to availability. While a depot would not normally send untrained personnel against a demand for drivers, it might well send part trained men in the hope that they could complete their training with the unit, and that they would be better than none.
3. Where drivers are deficient and the reinforcements received are unsuitable for training, the deficiency should be shown on the fortnightly return and also the surplus of non-trademen. The deficiency will then be made up as soon as men of the right type are available.

1. On the Staff of R.T.C. I.C.F. CESANO there are a number of Italian officers surplus to W.E.

They will be dealt with immediately in one of the followings ways.

- (a) Classified as available for reinforcement and held on reinforcement strength.
- (b) Posted to other suitable employment.
- (c) Demobilized.

One of the above courses will be followed irrespective as to whether the officer is a Regular or on the Reserve.

2. It should be borne in mind that 63 Italian officers are being repatriated from M.E., who on arrival will be posted to the Staff at CESANO.
