II. Many W/T trucks are being used by Schools and Units of the Italian Army, for general purposes.

Trucks 8 or 15 cwt. are required for the field training of linemen, Despatch Riders and Dvr./Operators.

Battalion Commanders have no means of getting out in the field to supervise training.

The two jeeps on charge to the Signal School are B.L.P.

It will become increasingly difficult to carry out adequate instruction with the present allocation of M.T.

The Italian Commercial types of dry batteries now being supplied for the 38 sets (W/T) are too large to fit in the set and are in short supply.

1. This HQ recently recommended to Ministry of War that the limited number of No 22 sets in possession of the ITALIAN Army should be redistributed among 13 Army Regts.

2. It is often necessary to manhandle 11 sets to QPs which cannot be approached by vehicle and for this purpose the No 22 set is more easily portable than the No 19 set.

For this reason, in APRIL 1946 Army Regts a proportion of No 22 sets is included with No 19 sets.

3. Ministry of War has now issued instruction to Directorate of Genio to redistribute and issue 11 sets to Army Units as follows:-

(a) To each 13 Army Regt :-

(1) nine No 22 sets :-

13 Army Regt - one
Each tp - one

(11) twelve No 19 sets :-

13 Army Regt - two
Each tp - one

(b) To each Mixed Army Bty in Inf Regs :-

(1) two No 22 sets :-

25 pr tp - one

4. The advantages of the No 22 set should be explained to the ITALIANS if any question arises over the issue.

2. It is often necessary to manhandle WT sets to CPs which cannot be approached by vehicle and for this purpose the No 22 set is more easily portable than the No 19 set.

For this reason, in BRIT PA Arty Regts a proportion of No 22 sets is included with No 19 sets.

3. Ministry of War has now issued instruction to Directorate of Genio to redistribute and issue WT sets to Arty Units as follows :-

2. In view of the fact that these sets are very much more portable than the No 19, it is strongly recommended that each Artillery Field Regiment, the establishment of wireless sets of which has been laid down as 24 No 19 sets, be issued instead with 12 No 19 sets and 9 No 22 sets. These nine sets will be invaluable to the Field Regiment for O.F. work. This is in keeping with British practice.

3. The implementation of the above recommendations will absorb $9 \times 40 = 360$ sets. It is suggested that a further 30 be allotted to the Italian School of Signals, CREMONA, and that the balance of 74 be held in stock by the Direzione Generale del Genio as an Army reserve.
