Reply to letter SD/112 dated 18/11/46.

1. - The new denomination of Engineer Coys given to the Engr. Services Coys of the Military Territorial Commands has been discussed and agreed with your representative during the meeting of the W/E Committee. Admitting that said companies have been unable to carry out, for various reasons, the Engr duties, it is intention of this S.M. to detail these units for duties similar to those laid down for the Engr Coys not included in divisions. Said duties will be carried out on behalf of the troops and services under the command of the respective Military Territorial Commands.

In view of the above, a reorganisation programme of the Engrs is being studied together with the Engrs Inspectorate. Said programme will be submitted to you for your approval as soon as completed.

2. - Regarding the points stressed in paras 4 and 5 of the letter referred to above - as the Engr Coys are included in the Engr Battalions and come under the command of said battalions for all purposes and with which they have direct contact for services and employment, it does not seem possible that they may be confused with the Territorial Engineer Companies, which are independent units. However your point of view will be borne in mind during the reorganisation of the Engr units in order to eliminate any possibility of confusion. -

SIMILARITY OF RANKSubject: Relegation - Major Units

Def Order of Battle and Location statement dated 1 Oct 66.

1. It is noticed that the designation of the Major Cos of the Peninsular Commands has been altered on their new all force Service Cos to Major Cos (Corporal rank).
2. It is considered that confusion may arise if no distinction is made in the titles between these two Major Cos and the Major Cos with Inf Divs.
3. The establishment of the Div Field Major Cos is seven Officers and 230 Cos and the role is the same as the Field Cos in an Div. The establishment of the new styled Major Cos of the Pen Commands is 4 Officers and 130 Cos and the role is certainly very different from that of the Div Rd Cos at present.
4. Further more it is seen that the 132000 Div has a No 3 Rd Major Cos and there is also a No 3 Rd Major Cos at the Milan Zerr. Command. Similarly there are one Nos 4, 5 and 10 Field Major Cos.
5. It is suggested that these units are redesignated in such a way as to avoid this confusion.

Ref. order of Battle and Location Statement 1st October 1946.

With the new War Establishment for the Engr Coy of the Territorial Commands, I notice that the name of the Coy has been changed from Service Coy to Field Engr Coy (Compagnia Artieri)

I think there will be confusion if no distinction is made in the title of 31 between these Coys and the Field Engr Coys with Divs.

The Establishment of the Div. Field Engr Coy is seven Officers and 230 ORs and its role is the same as the Field Coy in Br Divs. The Establishment of the new styled Fd Engr Coy of the Terr Commands is 4 Officers and 130 ORs and its Role is certainly very different from that of the Div Fd Coy at present.

~~Further more~~ <sup>it is known</sup> ~~you will find~~ that the LEGNANO Div has a No 3 Ml Engr Coy and there is also a No 3 Fd Engr Coy at the Milan Terr. Command. Similarly there are two Nos 4 5 and 10 Field Engr Coys.

In English it might be an easy remedy to drop the "Field" from the designation of the Terr Coy to make the necessary distinction but I regret I cannot make a suggestion for the respective Italian titles unless to have "Div" and "Terr" in brackets after Compagnia Artieri.


