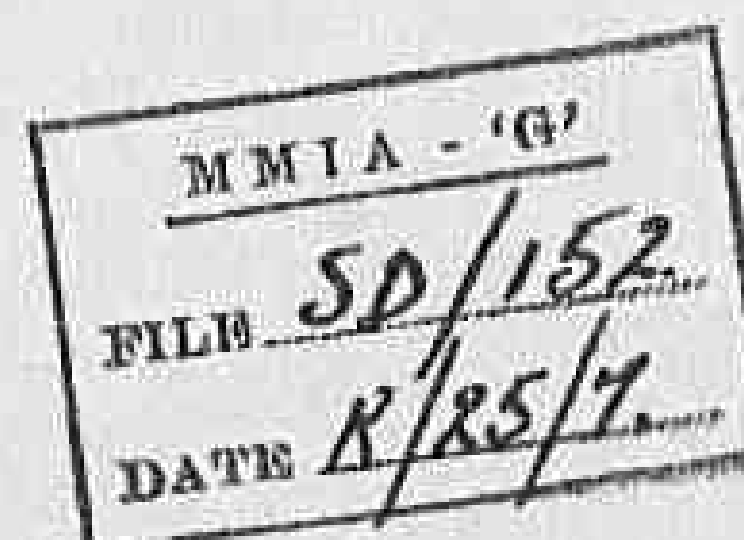
We forward herewith, as per list of distribution attached, the "List of trades of personnel of the Italian Army".
