

4) Disbandment of 3rd Group Air Force HQ.

At present 14 officers - 49 Ors form the HQ. of 3rd Group Air Force. 4 Companies (3 at Naples and 1 at Pisa) are under the command of said HQ.

SME suggests that the above HQ be disbanded and the 3 Companies at Naples pass under the command of 2nd Group Bn. and 1 company at Pisa pass under the command of 6th Group Bn.

We have assured them that the proper clothing and rations will be ready for the new men. Please see that their request is complied with. It is pointed out that these units will exceed their authorized strengths during the time necessary for the intake of the men and the departure of the old.

4. Our records do not disclose that we have the authorized or the TO strength for the units in the 6th Provisional Group, we have their actual strength. Please send us the TO strength for each unit.



I have informed Lt. Col. Baglioni that you wish:

- 1) that the following priorities be observed in assigning the recruits:

1st priority	500 to 6th Bn Group
2nd " "	1200 to 2nd Bn Group
3rd "	300 to 4th Aviation Group;

- 2) to know when the units are likely to get the above recruits.

M. of W. (Lt. Col. Baglioni) reply is that:

- a) the units will get the recruits from 25th to 30th January.
- b) concerning the priority suggested by you, he points out that since the movement of personnel is already schemed and that 5 days will be required to send the ~~new~~ recruits to the units from the various Districts, in fact 6th Bn Group will get the recruits 1 or 2 days before the 2nd Bn Group and the latter 1 or 2 days before the 4th Aviation Group. Therefore Col. Baglioni thinks that ~~no~~ such a priority is useless.

6th Bn Group HQ Leghorn has also pointed out to M. of W. the difficulty of billeting the 500 recruits considering the lack of accommodation and of barrack stores. (These recruits when arrive at Leghorn must be trained 2 or 3 weeks in order to replace suitably the old soldiers who will be discharged as soon as these recruits are sufficiently trained).



1. Reference is made to your letter, subject as above, dated 5 September 1946, reference AG 383.6 BPATC, calling attention to the inferior type of replacements being received by the 6th Provisional Group for employment as US-ITI's.

2. I have made very strong representations to the Italian Ministry of War as to the urgent necessity of furnishing proper replacements for US-ITI units, representative of the Italian Army and not representative of an adverse selection to perform an unpalatable duty.

3. You will appreciate however that the continuance of US-ITI units after February 1946 was not envisaged, and in consequence no provision for replacements was made. Any replacements now required therefore must come from the strength of the Italian interim army which itself is far below its authorized ceiling, and which this Mission is making every effort to bring to a state of operational effectiveness.

4. Furthermore the morale position of US-ITI's is not good. These troops are engaged in performing service not for their own country but for the U.S. Their conditions of service are not satisfactory. They are in many instances poorly clothed, housed and poorly fed. Their ration scale is below that of the US Army and of the Italian Army. They are in fact lowest priority from both the Italian and American points of view. **1942**

5. My G-3 has recently completed an inspection of all of these units. His reports indicate that there is very considerable variation in their relative effectiveness.

-- --

in general wherever the US commanding officers of the using services have taken a personal interest in the condition of service of US-ITI's they are markedly more effective.

6. I understand that a large number of the US-ITI's can be dispensed with when surplus property has been turned over to AFAR, but that the remainder will probably be required as long as US troops are in this theater. I suggest therefore that:

- a. Undesirable or unsatisfactory elements be returned to the Italian Army as units are disbanded.
- b. Adequate winter clothing and in particular shoes be supplied at an early date and before the beginning of cold weather.
- c. Adequate winter billets be provided.
- d. Ration scale be increased to include fresh meats and to approximate the equivalent of US Army ration.
- e. Commanding officers of the using services be asked to interest themselves personally in the welfare of these troops. Some are already doing so with excellent results.

7. I am confident that if conditions of service are made attractive the US-ITI's will continue to be most useful and satisfactory. It must be borne in mind, however, that they in common with other elements of the Italian Army, are subject to organized subversive influences which will play upon their grievances and encourage absence, desertion and possibly open revolt.

2. G-3 Section AFHQ by phone this date (Col. Smith - Lt. Col. Albert) advised that it would be impossible to release US-ITI Units until the Italian Government had taken over the surplus U.S. property, which was proceeding slowly due to lack of guards.

3. Your attention is invited to our letter G/16 dated 18 May 1946 in regard to this matter and it is urgently requested you contact without delay the Italian receiving agencies (A.R.A.R.) and have them expedite the take over of surplus property.

4. It is imperative that the present US-ITI units be retained until the surplus property has been disposed of by the US Army or you replace them if you discharge them from the service prior to the time released by U.S. Army.


