Your Mission, with letter SD/201/1 of 28/2 last, notified us of the program of the disbandment of the USITL Units under command of PBS.

According to said program all units in the Leghorn area must presumably be released in the period 1-15 May next.

Florence Military Territorial Command has now informed us that:

- a) - the 7th and 23rd Military Police Coys were disbanded on 31st March;
- b) - remaining units are expected to be made available at the beginning of July next.

In relation to the foregoing Your Mission is requested to kindly notify us, where possible, of the actual release dates of all the USITL units of the PBS which still exist, bearing in mind that it would be preferable that no appreciable alterations were made to the disbandment program in question, at least in the case of the majority of the a/m Units.

2. There is a great shortage of specialist personnel in the Italian Interim Army which will be even more accentuated by the demobilisation of the 1921 class, which has recently been authorised.

3. It is therefore requested that addressees examine the lists of units under their comd, as shown in the Appendices to this letter, with a view to accelerating the programme of disbandment of units which are surplus to requirements; and make the necessary application to the competent authority for permission to disband the units.

4. It is considered that in some of the units involved there are specialist personnel who are not being employed in their appropriate trade, and it is therefore requested that addressees authorise the Ministry of War, through this HQ, to replace specialist personnel who are NOT being employed as such in units which cannot be disbanded by a non-specialist in order to make the maximum number of specially trained personnel available for the Italian Interim Army

1. For your information, in accordance with General Orders No. 38 Hq Naples Air Forces General Depot U.S. Army dated 18 March 1946 the 9th Air Service Company (GF) (Italian) is disbanded effective 2400 B hours, 31 March 1946 at Cercola Italy, and the 50th Air Service Co. (AF) (Italian) is disbanded effective 2400 B hours, 31 March 1946, at ACERRA, Italy.

2. Personnel rendered available by this action may be utilized by the Commanding General, 205th Division (Italian) as replacements in units of its command, or, if not required for that purpose, Air Force personnel will be returned by using command (US) to nearest Zona Aerea Territoriale (ZAT) (Italian) and Ground Force personnel will be returned by using command (US) to nearest Italian Territorial Headquarters.

DISBANDEMENT OF US-ITI UNITS

1. Pursuant to authority contained in message FX 52682, Headquarters MTOUSA, dated 10 November 1945, the 9th Air Service Company (GF) (Italian) is disbanded effective 2400 hours, 31 March 1946, at Corcola, Italy, and the 50th Air Service Company (AF) (Italian) is disbanded effective 2400 hours, 31 March 1946, at Acerra, Italy.

2. Personnel rendered available by this action may be utilized by the Commanding General, 205th Division (Italian) as replacements in units of its command, or, if not required for that purpose, Air Force personnel will be returned by using command (US) to nearest Zona Aerea Territoriale (ZAT) (Italian) and Ground Force personnel will be retained by using command (US) to nearest Italian Territorial Headquarters.

3. Parent US Units will repossess all US Organizational equipment issued to the US-ITI Units and will return all such equipment authorized in letter, file 091.771, Headquarters, Army Air Forces, Mediterranean Theater of Operations, 12 May 1945, subject: "Army Air Forces U.S.--ITI Equipment, Operational project U-47-44," to depot stocks through normal Air Force Supply channels. Items of equipment which are of Italian origin will be disposed of in accordance with Italian procedure.

4. US equipment damaged through improper use or lost by the US-ITI Units to whom issued will be charged to the Italian Government as outlined in Supply Directive No. 46, Hq MTOUSA, 29 April 1945.

5. Items of individual clothing and equipment listed in letter, file AG 4221132, QM-O, Headquarters, MTOUSA, 3 July 1945, subject: "Clothing for US-ITI" may be retained by the individual US-ITI when his service with the United States Army expires.

6. Records of the disbanded units will be disposed of in accordance with Italian procedures.

7. Confirmation of this action will be reported to this headquarters with the least practical delay, by the Commanding Officer of the unit exercising operational control, indicating the number of officers and enlisted men returned to the Zona Aerea Territoriale (ZAT) (Italian), the Italian Territorial Headquarters, or transferred as replacements to other units and further indicating designation of each unit.

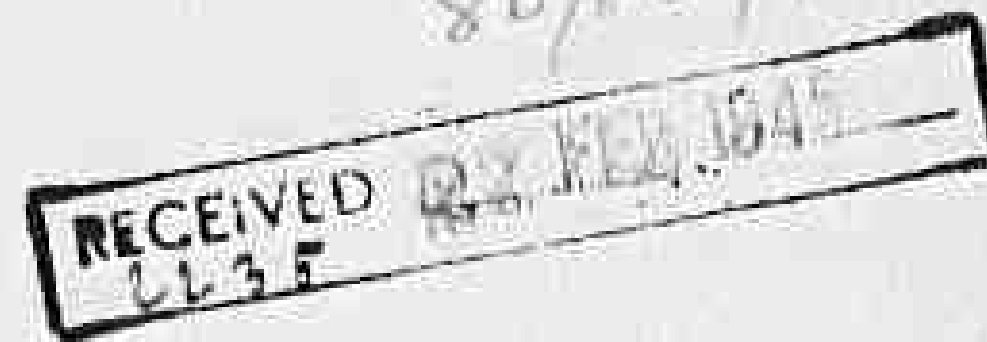

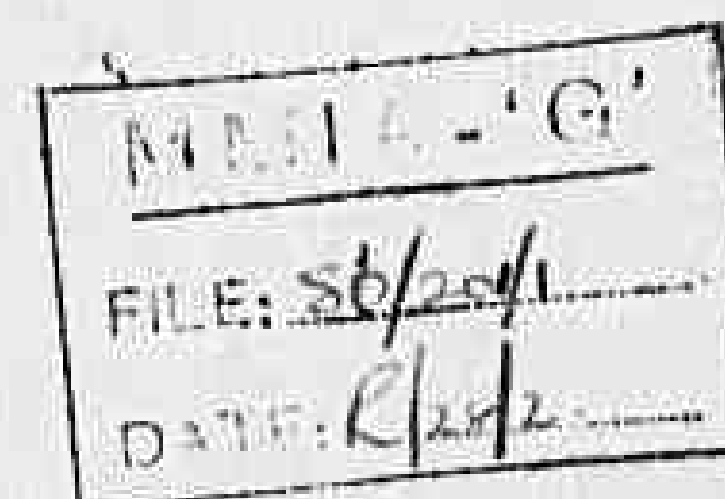

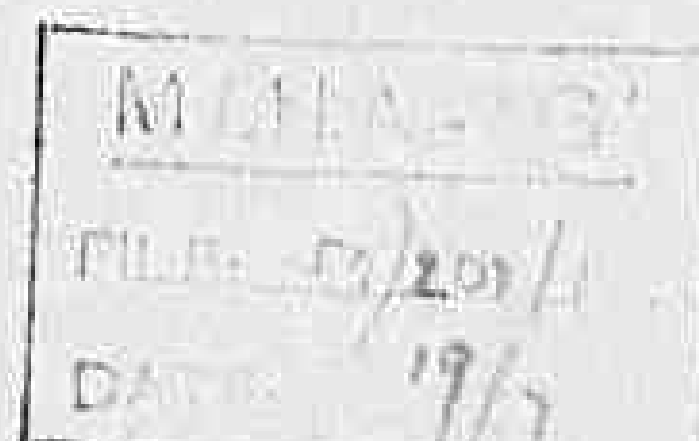

I OBJECT:

To determine disposal of

- (a) Italian Army US-ITIs displaced by German PW and Surrendered Personnel.
- (b) Italian PW displaced by German PW and Surrendered Personnel.

II DISCUSSION:

1. It has been decided that German PW and Surrendered Personnel will replace Italian Army units (US-ITIs) and Italian PW in American custody, except in the case of truck units and MP and Guard Units. The estimated proportion of units remaining on the Italian troop lists will be 40%, thus releasing over a six-week period approximately:

82,000 US-ITIs
12,000 PW.

2. US-ITIs. MIA estimate that 10,000 displaced US-ITIs can be absorbed in replacement of demobilized personnel in US-ITI truck and MP units and in BR-ITI units. They further estimate that 10,000 US-ITIs can be absorbed as reinforcements/replacements in US-ITI truck and MP units and in BR-ITI units to cover attrition over a six-week period. Other demands have been received for harvest workers, and for the creation of further Internal Security Divisions. As the British are now asked by CCS to support 10,000 carabinieri and have reluctantly agreed to do so, it is for consideration whether two Internal Security Divisions, total strength 10,000, can be formed within the US-ITI ceiling. The formation of Italian Internal Security Divs will facilitate redeployment of Allied Troops.

3. Italian PW. Application has been made to CCS for agreement to a proposal to release Italian PW in ITALY, SARDINIA & SICILY from PW status as from 1 July. No reply has been received. All personnel released were to be enlisted into the Italian Army by units. As far as personnel in US custody are concerned, this arrangement will now be applicable only to truck units.
