4. US equipment damaged through improper use or lost by the US-III Unit to whom issued will be charged to the Italian Government as outlined in Memorandum Number 35-9, Headquarters, Army Air Forces, Mediterranean Theater of Operations, 5 June 1945.

5. Items of individual clothing and equipment listed in letter, File AG 422/152, ST-0, Headquarters, AGOS, 3 July 1945, subject: "Clothing for US-III", may be retained by the individual US-III when his service with United States Army expires.

6. Records of the disbanded unit will be disposed of in accordance with Italian procedures.

7. Confirmation of this action will be reported to this Headquarters with the least practicable delay, by the Commanding Officer, Air Force General Depot #5, indicating the number of Officers and enlisted men returned to 4th A.C.T. (Italian) as transferred as replacements to other units and further indicating designation of each unit.
