1. Orders have just been received for the immediate disbandment of this Unit.
2. G.O.C. have advised that no movement of personnel will take place before 10 Jan next, but only work in connection with winding up is now being undertaken.
3. Disposal instructions for personnel, MP and stores have been provided and are attached, but in the meanwhile there are several local and domestic matters, which G.O.C. directive may not cover and on which you may care to give a ruling. These are as follows: -
 - (a) To whom are the various requisitioned vehicles to be handed over?
 - (b) There are some German "Schnitz H" wives and families who are awaiting repatriation to UK and who have in the past drawn rations and MAWI supplies from this Unit. These ladies have also contacted this HQ. on such matters as Documentation, Family Allowance etc. What instructions should be given to them?
 - (c) A certain amount of Welfare Stores, received from 217 Area, are in possession of this Unit. To whom should they be handed over?
 - (d) Are you interested in the employment of any of the civilians at present employed by 7 B.L.U.? If so, the names and qualifications of those strongly recommended and willing to move to HICOGS would be forwarded.
 - (e) No. 1449075 Pte FRANKLIN J.B. RAIN, att'd to the USMI Room FROBBER, forwarded an application to get married under ref. Appx "A" to CGO 162/44, dated 30 Nov '46. As he will in all probability be moved from FROBBER in the near future, is there a possibility of the permission being expedited?

It will be appreciated that this Unit's transport is strictly 305³ and outside transport will have to be supplied for the conveyance of stores

SUBJECT: Sponsors for Military Missions and Liaison Headquarters.

1. At Appendix "A" is given a list of Military Missions and Liaison Headquarters showing in each case either a War Office branch or Command as a sponsor.
 2. Hitherto, Mr. War Office has accepted the responsibility for dealing with questions arising in connection with War Establishments and General Administration in respect of the majority of these units, and, in the early post-war period, when there was a larger intelligence aspect in the work of these units, this was to some extent justified. Now, however, the units are mainly concerned with other than intelligence activities, and it is considered that the War Office branch or Command mostly concerned with the work of a particular unit should act as sponsor and "parent" to that unit.
 3. Where possible Missions will deal direct with the War Office branch concerned with the point in question, but in cases of doubtful Missions will only deal with their sponsor branch. This applies particularly to small matters concerning the administration of the Mission itself.
- Missions shown as sponsored by a Command will always deal with that Command, not direct with the War Office.
4. The procedure for the presentation of War Establishments for those units to the War Establishments Committee will remain unaltered in that SD 3(a) will continue to carry out this function. Proposals for new War Establishments or amendments to existing ones will continue to be submitted to SD 3(b), War Office by (in the case of War Office sponsored units) the unit or, (in the case of Command sponsored units) the Command concerned. The proposals will be agreed between SD 3(b) and the War Office sponsor branch or sponsor Command before final presentation to the War Establishments Committee.
 5. It is requested that sponsor branches and Commands keep SD 2, War Office informed of any changes which may occur from time to time in respect of the units listed at Appendix "A".
