(d) In any instance where Allied or Italian troops are employed to quell civil disturbances, tear gas and/or smoke grenades may be employed subject to the following restrictions:

(i) Every security precaution will be employed to ensure that stocks of these grenades do not fall into unauthorised hands.

(ii) All major commands will issue instructions to lower echelons concerning the use of these grenades, subject to the restriction that no grenades will normally be issued to troops or used by troops except on the order of an officer; in exceptional cases the responsibility for issuing such order may be delegated to a WO. As a guide to major commands it is desired that these grenades be employed only when it is considered that use of force is necessary, and that the object will be achieved with fewer casualties by the use of tear gas and/or smoke than opening fire."

SECRET

CIVIL

1. With the exception of the Commune of NAPLES, which is still under AMZ control, all 3 Dist territory in Southern Italy and Sicily has been turned back to the Italian Government.

CIVIL DEFENCE

2. Within 3 Dist territory ground dep will consist of

- (a) Def against sabotage and theft.

- (b) Preservation of law and order.

Except as qualified by paras 3/5 below, ground defence, as so defined, is the responsibility of the Italian Government authorities. In the Commune of NAPLES the responsibility is that of AMZ.

3. The recent explosion at BARI indicates the need to maintain in existence at ports an organization capable of dealing with such an emergency.

MILITARY RESPONSIBILITY

4. Area, Sub-area and unit comds are responsible for guarding localities occupied by their respective comds. Area/Sub-area comds are also responsible for guarding naval installations within their comds where sufficient naval personnel are not available. (APP QP Memorandum Number 75).

AID TO THE CIVIL POWER

- Procedure under which assistance may be given to the civil power is given in App 11 att.

CIVIL INSTALLATIONS AND UTILITIES

Responsibilities are defined in para 11 below.

INFORMATION

1. MILITARY ZONES

The right is reserved by the Supreme Allied Commander, Mediterranean Theatre, to declare specific areas of Italian Government territory to be Military Zones. By the issue of such a declaration, the exercise of the powers of Military Government in the zone in question is assumed by the Supreme Allied Commander, Mediterranean Theatre. Should the situation in any area become such as to convince the Area/Sub-area Commander that the establishment of zones is necessary, he shall, after consulting Allied Commission Officers where possible, report accordingly to this head-quarters, giving full reasons to justify his views.

2. USE OF TROOPS IN AID OF CIVIL POWER

- (a) Within areas which have been turned back to the Italian Government, the Italian Government is responsible for the maintenance of law and order. To accomplish this, the local Italian civil authorities have under their control the Local Carabinieri. If, in the opinion of the local Italian authorities, the Carabinieri are unable to deal with the situation, they should appeal to the nearest Italian military headquarters for the assistance of such Italian troops as the latter has under its control. If no such Italian troops are available, or if there is still need for additional troops, the Italian civil authorities should request the nearest Area/Sub-area commander or his local representative, for assistance. Should additional assistance be required, the local Allied Military Government officer will appeal to the nearest Area or Sub-area commander. (It is essential that close liaison exists between the Local Allied Military Government officer and the nearest District/Bureau Section, Area or Sub-area commander.)
- (e) The above responsibilities as outlined apply to civil disturbances. A disturbance in which military personnel are involved is a military responsibility and will be dealt with by the appropriate military authority.
- (f) Immediate reports will be made through normal channels in all cases of riots or civil disturbances, whether or not it has been necessary to employ allied troops.

3. PRECAUTIONS IN USE OF MILITARY FORCES

In any case where Allied or Italian troops are employed to quell civil disturbances, the following instructions will apply:-

III. POSSIBLE STEPS TO QUELL THE DISTURBANCE WITHOUT RECOURSE TO FIRE OR TILL BE TAKEN

- (a) Troops will be moved to the scene of the disturbance with weapons unloaded.
- (b) Weapons will be loaded only on command of an officer.
- (c) Only small arms will be borne by troops. Specifically prohibited are automatic weapons and grenades.

- (d) No smoke, tear gas, or chemicals of any kind will be employed. See *below*.
- (e) No troops will open fire upon rioters except on the express order of an officer.
- (f) Shots will not be fired over the heads of the crowd and blank rounds will not be used.
- (g) If it is considered necessary for troops to fire, the minimum number of soldiers will be used and they will concentrate their aim on ringleaders or apparent ringleaders. No indiscriminate fire will take place. All fire will be strictly controlled by an officer. The number of rounds will be limited and firing will cease immediately it becomes effective.
- (h) Women and children will not be fired upon.

USE OF ITALIAN TROOPS

- (a) Italian troops NOT under command of Areas/Sub-areas are at disposal of the necessary areas. These troops under command of Areas/Sub-areas, but NOT actually under command commitments, may also be made available at discretion of Areas/Sub-areas Comis.
- (b) It is emphasized, however, that Italian troops under command of Areas/Sub-areas, and actually under command of Allied interests, the disposal of Italian Territorial Forces by Adm Div HQ concerned without the specific authority of Areas/Sub-areas Comis concerned.
- (c) The guiding principle must be to ensure that, when necessary, and consistent with the full and proper safeguarding of Allied interests, the maximum number of Italian troops possible be made available to Italian Territorial Forces, throughout Italy, in order that any civil disturbances necessitating Italian military intervention may be dealt with efficiently and quickly. The closest liaison is necessary to ensure that this principle is carried into effect.

✓ (d) In any instance where Allied or Italian troops are employed to quell civil disturbances, tear gas and/or smoke grenades may be employed subject to the following restrictions;

(i) Every security precaution will be employed to ensure that stocks of these grenades do not fall into unauthorised hands.

(ii) All major commands will issue instructions to lower echelons concerning the use of these grenades, subject to the restrictions that no grenades will normally be issued to troops or used by troops except on order of a officer; in exceptional cases the responsibility for issuing such orders may be delegated to a ~~higher~~ NCO. 



1. Instances of civil disturbances have indicated that fresh instructions are necessary to define responsibilities and to specify certain precautions in the employment of armed forces to quell civil disturbances.
This instruction will cancel Operation Instruction No 10 of 16 Aug 44 and Letter 69/G of 17 Oct 44 (NOT to all).

2. Disturbances may occur in the following two types of areas and procedure varies accordingly:-

- (a) Italian Government Territory (IGT) - those areas including SICILY and SARDINIA which have been turned back to the Italian Government.
- (b) AMG Territory - territory still under AMG control. At present, within 3 District, only Commune of NAPLES is under AMG control.

RESPONSIBILITIES

3. Italian Government Territory. Within areas which have been turned back to the Italian Government, the Italian Government is responsible for the maintenance of law and order. To accomplish this, the Italian local civil authorities have under their control the local Carabinieri. If in the opinion of the local Italian authorities the Carabinieri are unable to deal with the situation, they should apply to the nearest Italian Military Headquarters for the assistance of such Italian troops as the latter has under its control. If no such Italian troops are available, or if there is still need for additional troops, the Italian civil authorities should request the local Area or Sub Area commander for assistance. It is essential that close liaison be maintained between Area and Sub Area headquarters with the local Italian civil authorities and with the Local Italian military authorities. In case of emergency, Italian troops will NOT be used without prior consultation and agreement of Area/Sub Area commander.

Should the situation in any area become such as to convince the Local Commander that a specific area in Italian Government territory should be made a Military Zone he will report to the District Commander.

Should the situation in any area become such as to cause the Area commander that a specific area in Italian Government Territory should be made a Military Zone he will report to the District Commander.

5. AMG Territory. Within areas which are still under AMG control, the local AMG authority is responsible for the maintenance of law and order. The local Carabinieri are under the control of AMG for this purpose. Should additional assistance be required, the local AMG authority will appeal to the Local Area or Sub Area commander.

6. The above responsibilities as outlined apply to civil disturbances. If there is a possibility of troops becoming involved in a purely civil disturbance troops will be recalled and confined to barracks for such time as will ensure that incidents will be avoided. A disturbance in which military personnel are involved is a military responsibility and will be dealt with by the appropriate military authority.

PRECAUTIONS IN USE OF ARMED FORCES

7. In any case where Allied or AMG troops are employed to quell civil disturbances, the following instructions will apply:-

- (a) Troops will be moved to the scene of the disturbance with weapons unloaded.
- (b) Weapons will be loaded only on command of an officer.
- (c) Only small arms will be borne by troops. Specifically prohibited are automatic weapons and grenades.
- (d) No smoke, tear gas, or chemicals of any kind will be employed.
- (e) No troops will open fire upon rioters except on the express order of an officer.
- (f) Shots will not be fired over the heads of the crowd and blank rounds will not be used.
- (g) If it is considered necessary for troops to fire, the minimum number of soldiers will be used and they will concentrate their aim on ringleaders or apparent ringleaders. No indiscriminate fire will take place. All fire will be strictly controlled by an officer. The number of rounds will be limited and firing will cease immediately it becomes ineffective.
- (h) Women and children will NOT be fired upon.

REPORTS

- 8. Immediate reports will be made to this HQ by teletype through normal channels in all cases of riots or civil disturbances, whether or not it has been necessary to employ Allied troops. These immediate reports will be followed by a detailed report at the earliest opportunity.

LIAISON

- 9. It is essential that closest possible liaison be maintained with Allied Commission officers on all questions affecting relations with Italian Civil Authorities.

3 DISTRICT OPERATION INSTRUCTION No 3

Disposal of unexploded bombs (UXB)

OBJECT

1. The object of this instruction is:-

- (a) To state the responsibilities of British Army Bomb Disposal Secs (ED Secs) for the disposal of UXB.
- (b) To standardise within 3 Dist the drill for the reporting and disposal of UXB.

RESPONSIBILITIES BETWEEN SERVICES

2. British Army ED Secs are responsible for the disposal of all UXB within 3 Dist except:-

(a) The Royal Navy is responsible for disposing of:-

- (i) UXB in ships or below high water mark.
- (ii) anti-ship mines and circling torpedoes
- (iii) any other purely naval devices which may be found ashore

(b) The Royal Air Force is responsible for disposing of:-

- (i) UXB on or near RAF occupied areas
- (ii) bombs on crashed aircraft

The RAF is also responsible for providing trained personnel to assist Army ED Secs to dispose of Allied bombs,

(c) United States Authorities concerned are responsible for disposing of UXB lying within their enclave or port areas.

RESPONSIBILITY OF UNITS

3. Units locating UXB are responsible for reporting their location forthwith to HQ Area/Sub Area concerned by "UXB Report" in the form of APPENDIX A, which will be enclosed in DULLIVAN.

RESPONSIBILITY OF AREA/SUB AREA

4. HQ's are responsible for advising the Area/Sub Area Commander to priorities for the disposal of UXB in accordance with information supplied in the UXB report, and from an appreciation of the site and its surroundings. Priorities will be allotted in accordance with table shown at Annex 'A'. When UXB's are concurrently given the same priority, the order of disposal will be clearly stated.

5. On receipt of UXB report the procedure by HQ's will be as follows:-

(a) Report will be given a sequential number

RESPONSIBILITIES BETWEEN SERVICES
2. British Army BD Secs are responsible for the disposal of all UXB within

3 Dist except:-

- (a) The Royal Navy is responsible for disposing of:-
 - (i) UXB in ships or below high water mark
 - (ii) anti-ship mines and circling torpedoes
 - (iii) any other purely naval devices which may be found ashore
- (b) The Royal Air Force is responsible for disposing of:-
 - (i) UXB on or near RAF occupied areas
 - (ii) bombs on crashed aircraft

The RAF is also responsible for providing trained personnel to assist Army ED Secs to dispose of Allied bombs.

- (c) United States Authorities concerned are responsible for disposing UXB lying within their enclave or res port areas.

RESPONSIBILITY OF UNITS

5. Units locating UXB are responsible for reporting their location ^{5/} forthwith to HQ Area/Sub Area concerned by "UXB Report" in the form of App 4/Normal shown at APPENDIX 1, which will be rendered in DUPLICATES.

RESPONSIBILITY OF AREA/SUB AREA

6. "C" are responsible for advising the Area/Sub Area Commander as to priorities for the disposal of UXB in accordance with information supplied in the UXB report, and from an appreciation of the site and its surroundings. Priorities will be allotted in accordance with table shown at APPENDIX B. When UXB's are concurrently given the same priority, the order of disposal will be clearly stated.

7. On receipt of UXB report the procedure by "C" will be as follows:-

- (a) Report will be given a serial number
- (b) Priority will be assessed and entered on Report (see provisions in paras 9 and 10).
- (c) Completed report will be forwarded to BD sec concerned for action, and unit concerned informed of priority allotted.
- (d) Duplicate copy of report will be placed in UXB Record File

8. Area/Sub Area are responsible that all units within their command are acquainted with the form of report at APPENDIX A and table of priorities at APPENDIX B.

7. Locations of UXB graded 'D' will be reported to the Allied Control Commission Authorities, and J Dist.

RESPONSIBILITY OF BOMB DISPOSAL SECTIONS

8. On receipt of UXB report ED secs are responsible for taking disposal action in accordance with the priority allotted.

9. ED secs are authorised to appeal to Area/Sub Area for UXB classified 'D' to be degraded to 'I' if certain technical considerations prevail, e.g., Allied bombs fitted with delay or anti-disturbance fuses. The decision of the Area/Sub Area Commander will, however, be final.

10. ED secs are authorised to advise Area/Sub Area that UXB classified 'C' be degraded to 'D', but the final decision will rest with Area/Sub Area.

11. On completion of disposal ED sec will complete the Clearance Certificate at the foot of their copy of the UXB report, detach it, and forward it to the Area/Sub Area concerned, retaining the remainder of the report for record.

RESPONSIBILITY OF BOMB DISPOSAL COMPANY COMMANDER

12. Apart from his normal comd, adm, and technical responsibilities OC, 27 ED Coy RE is responsible as follows:-

- (a) He is technical adviser to J Dist (inter alia) on all ED matters. He will keep 'G' J Dist and Area/Sub Area concerned fully informed as to any changes or proposed changes in the location and availability of ED secs
- (b) He will report direct to AFBHQ all information regarding new bombs and fuses found
- (c) He will be responsible for arranging for necessary bomb cemeteries in conjunction with 'Q' J Dist
- (d) He will be prepared to render assistance to RN, RAF and US AD authorities in an emergency, subject to the prior disposal of UXB for which the British Army are directly responsible.

GENERAL SAFETY PROVISIONS

13. General orders are contained in MTP No 45. Initially the Locating unit, and subsequently the Area/Sub Area, with the advice of the ED sec, is responsible for all necessary protective measures until disposal has been effected. Particular precautions will be taken on the actual explosion of a UXB in situ. The sites of UXB graded 'D' will remain marked.

3. In order to facilitate clearance and avoid unnecessary danger to personnel, 10 secs will normally blow W.E., except 'A 1's', in situ. Whether this is done or NOT is for the decision of TO secs based on technical considerations. Area/Sub Area may represent to TO secs that they would prefer the W.E.
