1. RESCISSIONS

a. Operations Memorandum No 3 dated 22 February, 1946 and amendments thereto are rescinded.

2. REFERENCES

a. MAPS: Italy 1/100,000 Sheets 143, 144, 149, 150 & 158, Town Plan of Rome 1/12,000 NORTH and SOUTH Sheets, Sketch Map Rome 1/12,000, 25 March 1946.

3. PURPOSE

a. To establish a Standard Operating Procedure for the troops of this command in event of Civil Disturbance or other Emergency.

b. The protection of the Command Headquarters, Installations and Material in the event of such disturbance or emergency.

c. To keep open the Route to Ciampino Airport (Route 7) and supplement the security of Ciampino Airport when required and requested by CO 1419th AAF BU.

d. The Security of the Signal Installations in the Headquarters Building.

4. THE GENERAL PLAN

a. Determination of Disturbance or Emergency.

1. Any American or British Officer on receipt of information that a disturbance or emergency is imminent or in process will immediately notify either of the following:

Provost Marshal (Amer)
Provost Marshal (Br)

2. a. If either of the two officers listed above determines that a disturbance or emergency is serious enough to threaten the Security of the Headquarters and Installations on page 3 he will immediately notify both the following:

Chief of Staff (Amer)
DAA & JMC (Br)

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b. After an Emergency or disturbance has been determined:

1. If either of the above listed officers determine that a disturbance or emergency exists he will:

Chief of Staff (A) DAA & QMB (Br)	a. Direct the Adjutant General to inform all unit commanders of all United States and British Units to report to a point to be designated. The code word for this will be "Fireball". List of all personnel to be informed is attached, marked Appendix A. b. Direct the Adjutant General to inform all Allied Personnel on leave or day pass in Rome to report immediately to their rest camp or hotel.
Commanding Officer: 281st M.P. Co. US Army Rest Center. 56 Rest Camp. 150th T. C. Truck Co. 1419th AAF BU Quartermaster Supply Depot Motor Pool	a. Direct an immediate formation of all troops, including restees and German SEP's, in their respective installations, and await further orders. b. Uniform US Troops Combat light packs. British, Battle Order. (Also respirators, AG/Masks gas, Service, Field Dressings, full water bottles/Canteens) c. Rifles and Pistols ONLY, plus ammunition, will be issued and kept within easy reach of personnel. d. Automatic weapons (including TMC (TMG) and Bren Guns) and Grenades will <u>NOT</u> be carried or used by Allied Troops. e. Tear Gas Grenades will be issued to US and British Military Police only when specifically ordered by CO RAAC. f. Rations. 48 hours hard rations will be issued to all troops. g. Direct a Liaison Officer to Hq RAAC or point designated.

c. Transportation for Reserve Force: Transportation Officer will reserve six (6) trucks and five (5) jeeps for use of Reserve only.

6. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

a. Under supervision of Signal Officer, RAAC, Military Police Radio Jeeps will be dispatched as follows:

- One (1) to Headquarters, RAAC.
- One (1) to JO US Army Rest Center (Major Cowing).
- One (1) to GO 56 Rest Camp.
- One (1) to Rome Area Supply Depot.
- One (1) to Highway 7 to patrol from Rome to Ciampino Airport

and return.

b. Troops designated for protective duties will move to the scene of disturbance with weapons UNLOADED.

c. Command and Control Point: Office of CO, RAAC, Piazza Venezia (F 7466) Telephone 66506.

d. Fire Control

(1) Weapons will be loaded only on the direct order of an Officer.

(2) Firing will NEVER be opened during Civil Disturbance unless on the direct order of an OFFICER, and then, on the orders of the SENIOR Officer present.

(3) Indiscriminate firing will NOT be resorted to. Firing will be CONTROLLED at all times.

(4) Special instructions as to the circumstances in which Officers are justified to give the order to fire are as follows:

(a) If firearms are used the following procedure will be adopted except in the case of the gravest emergency:

1. The intention that firing is about to take place will if possible be made clear to the rioters. A line of leveled rifles is the clearest possible indication. If possible some announcement should be made that unless the crowd disperse within a stated period they will be fired on.

2. The actual firing will be done by a comparatively small number of soldiers selected for their training and marksmanship.

3. A limited number of rounds will be fired from each rifle and that number clearly stated before the order to fire is given. 3756

4. The soldiers detailed to fire will if possible concentrate their aim on the ringleaders or apparent ringleaders and will not fire indiscriminately into the crowd.

5. Shots will not be fired over the heads of the crowd, nor will blank rounds be fired.

6. Automatic weapons (including TWG (Br), TWG (US), and Grenades will not be used in any circumstances.

7. All precautions will be taken to prevent the shooting of women and children.

8. Firing will cease as soon as it becomes effective.

e. Use of Tear Gas Smoke Grenades

(1) In any instance where Allied troops are employed under Allied Command to quell civil disturbances, tear gas and/or smoke grenades, but not white phosphorus smoke grenades, may be employed subject to the following restrictions:

(a) Every security precaution will be employed to ensure that stocks of these grenades do not fall into unauthorized hands.

(b) No grenades will be issued to troops or used by troops except on command of an officer. In exceptional cases the responsibility for issuing such orders may be delegated to a NCO. These grenades will be employed only when it is considered that use of force is necessary and that the object will be achieved with fewer casualties by the use of tear gas and/or smoke, than by opening fire.

f. Communications

(1) Signal Section, Rome Area Allied Command, will be in readiness to man emergency radio station located in Headquarters RAAC, to provide communications with AFM. Radio will report into not immediately upon failure of military a/o Civil land-lines.

(2) Telephone as long as possible.

(3) Radio where established.

(4) Mobile Messengers with unit escorts.

(5) Messengers (US))

Runners (Br)) if necessary, with unit escorts.

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g. Reports

Reports will be made to this Headquarters as necessary. Reports will also include those of Casualties.

S E C R E Th. Medical

First Aid Stations (Main). All US and British Hospitals will act in the capacity of First Aid Stations.

i. Prisoners

(1) Protective Troops and Allied Military Police will hand over prisoners to the nearest US/Br Unit for safe custody.

(2) Prisoners will be disposed of in accordance with instructions to be issued by this Headquarters.

(3) Units receiving prisoners will notify Rome Area Allied Command immediately by the quickest available means, together with total held.

j. "Stand Down"

(1) (a) Orders for Allied Protective Forces to be withdrawn in toto or in part, together with degree of restrictions and measures to be taken or maintained by units will be given in clear by this Headquarters.

(b) Orders to this effect will be preceded by "EMERGENCY ENDS" followed by orders.

(2) Units will acknowledge receipt of these orders.

SUBJECT: Military Arsenals.

TO : Land Forces Sub-Commission,
M.M.I.A.

1. Attached is an extract from Rome Area Allied Command Summary No. 30. This deals with arms held in military arsenals belonging to the Italian Army. It is alleged that the arsenals at PESCHIERA, MANTUA, PIACENZA and VENICE are completely in the hands of civilian employees and that these employees are 100% members of the Communist Party.

2. May investigations be made to determine the truth or otherwise of these allegations concerning the Communist Party, and may information be given as to the type and number of arms that are in fact held in these arsenals and whether the local Communist Party would be able to gain access to the arms if they so desired it.

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Extract from Rome Area Allied Command Security Summary No 30

TAILPIECE

In the past, numerous reports of hidden arms, to be used in revolutionary acts, have been reported to all police and Intelligence agencies. Of these reports only a small number have been of any value. In the hidden arms question, the Allies have neglected one of the dangers concerning arms. In Italy there exist today military arsenals in all the Army Corps headquarters in which the arms left by the Germans, Republican Fascists, Partisans and arms confiscated in public raids have been stored.

It has been brought to the attention of this office that the military arsenals, at PESCHIERA, MANTUA, PIACENZA, and VENICE are completely in the hands of civilian employees. These employees are 100% members of the Communist Party and unless they are members, no position is given to them by the local labor unions. If army officers interfere, the local communist cells refer the individual to Rome, who in turn refer to the Ministry of War and the officer is transferred.

It has also been reported that the arms in these arsenals are in perfect working condition and well kept.

These arms are very weakly guarded and are a potential danger to the Allies and to the Italian State. Lawless elements could very easily assault these arsenals and have at their disposal all the heavy weapons needed for any insurrection.

This material is all captured enemy material and really belongs to the Allies. Beside the small amount needed by the Italian Army, the rest should be destroyed.

The Chief of Police of Italy stated that these arms could be demobilized in a week by the simple method of removing the springs in each weapon.

The Chief of Police is very much in favor of such an action and has taken it up with the government. This office will also submit a detailed report to AFHQ for action, to remedy a dangerous situation.
