POLITICAL SITUATION

This is very uncertain, especially in connection with the development of interior politics and relations between Demochristians and leftists.

Demochristians, however following their traditional programme, show a certain tendency to the "right" as they try to hinder left parties to come to the power. Nevertheless several among them are inclined to a friendly approach to the left.

Demochristian party decay is widely commented but it does not surprises the intellectual part of population who believe that it is due to the unclear policy of its leaders.

The socialists, who in a first time were inclined to follow Saragat, are now curving towards the opposit tendency.

The members of Uomo qualunque, in consideration of their recent success in administrative elections, appear sure of their final success, but many of them talk about the necessity to clean their ranks of persons compromised with the fascism.

The propaganda for the "Prestito Nazionale di Ricostruzione" is carried on, but it does not find many subscribers among the little proprietors who being mistrusted by the system of public debts, prefer to spare their money in saving books or ²⁴⁸ng real estates.

The public shows now a less interest in the peace conditions as the results of first touches between foreign ministers have been accepted with a sorrowful resignation.

ECONOMICAL POSITION

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ECONOMICAL POSITION

This is going worse on account of the first necessity items growing more and more expensive every day.

The people is worried by the lack of grain and by the expected reduction of the ration of pasta. News appeared in some papers that the Italian Government tries to buy grain abroad have roused a considerable interest.

The harvest of olives is going satisfactorily. It may be expected that the quantity agreed upon will be handed to the amassing centres, this due to a better organisation of control.

IMPRESSIONS AND COMMENTS OF THE CC.

The opinion is that the getting worse of the public order is not due not only to the difficulty of living but also to the fact that the prevention is inadequate and the lack of repression encourages the ill-intentioned who do not increase the troubles finding out always new reasons for these, however of no importance.

The Decree Nr 194 of 10 August 1944 that temporarily limits the cases in which an arrest may be made, a warrant for arrest issued or a person can be taken in preventive custody, has met with a general disapproval as in such a way possibility is given to the delinquency to act almost without any punishment.

COMMENTS OF THE PRESS ON CC ACTING.

These are generally good, but it is not so as far as the "left" press is concerned. Very often it raises accusation, groundless but only intended to propagandistic aim, saying the CC are favouring the farmers.

The inadequacy of the present lodging allowance and the suppression of 60 days transfer bonus for the men who are transferred with their families, are complained.

PUBLIC SECURITY - GENERAL.

Only in the province of Matera occurred riots so important to require intervention of considerable reinforcement. In Lecce province a carabinieri has been killed in a fight. In other provinces the conditions are almost normal.

POLITICAL SITUATION.

In this actual difficult moment, the public opinion appears to have no trust in Government, and considers it powerless on account of its inner perturbances, not only to solve the actual difficulties, but to mitigate them. All parties are still accused to carry on their particular interests without any consideration for the interests of the Nation. Continuous public disturbances, strikes and ill-intended activities hinder any attempt for the National recovery. Very often the actual grave situation is not considered as a problem to be solved, but as a condition to exploit and to turn more keen and so to draw masses towards issues that they ignore but which they were told, are very attractive.

The definite conditions of our peace, as they were established during the last meeting of "Pours" in New York, found Italian opinion unsurprised.

The punitive peace so low it was conceived through a long work of various commissions, was perfectioned: Albany too, will cash a repair, Yugoslavia has the right to keep a military command in Italian Trieste. These are not but last details. No one had hoped that our indignation and our protests could change the destiny they choised for us.

Italians who have seen the sacred soil run up and down by two wars and so many mournings, pillages and ruins, find once again that all these availed nothing but a cold application of the "law for vanquished" in all its range and expression. The rest of it, the "conditions for development of friendly reports among peoples" are not but vain words that hides the most pitiless selfishness.

Territorial mutilations, sacrifice of the Fleet, Army and Aviation, prohibition to fortify our boundaries, loss of colonies conceived before the Decision, impossible repairs - all this is

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Territorial mutilations, sacrifice of the Fleet, demeritization, prohibition to fortify our boundaries, loss of colonies conquered before the Fascism, impossible repairs - all this is a cruel reality. And no improvement is expected, however they talk of direct touches with the nations concerned.

ECONOMICAL POSITION.

This is very serious.

The cost of living still goes on its dreadful and unjustified increase so implying a desperate condition only for honest workers. Persons who live only on their pay or wages are condemned to ~~long~~ the starvation they cannot endure any more.

./.

And yet the endless avidity of the "new riches" makes the life more difficult, as they continually raise prices for food and clothing. On the other hand, there is no sure sign of recovery of industry and exchange, and consequently no possibility to give work to the jobless whose number increases every day.

Such are the condition from which, apparently, takes origin the general three days strike in the city of Naples, ordered by the Chamber of Labour in Naples.

But, whatever might be the measures that the Government has the intention to take with the aim to fight the high cost of first necessities or of the life in general, ~~that~~ the opinion is that only a prompt beginning of public works announced by the Government since so long time but never put into practice, can improve this common plague, which keeps spirits in a continuous fermentations, especially unemployed and veterans, and makes them always ready for trouble and violence.

The grain campaign is almost over; but only little quantity of grain has been given this month to the grain-stores, so that the result is not much different now than before. The question of amassing or non amassing of grain is still largely discussed by the farmers.

We are at sowing time and farmers, already alarmed by the recent searches and by more or less hidden menaces that they receives very often, would know many things: if the next year the amassing law will still exist; what would be the price for the grain, if their opinion will be asked for when prices will be fixed, if this year they will have manure at low prices, etc.

They are thinking about whether they have to sow and so to accept all the troubles of check and compulsory surrender of grain or it is more convenient to them to cultivate uncontrolled products. None could say that farmers would not take this last resolution, reducing to the minimum land cultivated to grain and amplifying other lands. And then, one could see but ~~2004~~ late that forecast for the next year harvest was to optimistic one. Such is the condition of spirit ~~in~~ among farmers, and if no initiative will be taken from the highest circles to assure with the implicit guarantee these people, it could be difficult to preserve the same area of sowed land next year.

But they are under impression, however, that their silent and constant daily effort will give no fruits whether measures able to remove the cause of moral and material difficulties will not be taken.

The news so unopportunately spread by newspapers that the reserve of grain is not enough but for few days, should be explained by organisations concerned, and this to quiet the public.

3. COMMENTS OF THE PRESS ON CC ACTIVITY.

The local press, putting in due light the recent operations in the areas where delinquency was more dangerous, so brought to the knowledge of the population the difficult and self sacrificing work of ~~the~~ our men, who are so energetically fighting any outcast of delinquency.

In the same way, the public is admiring CC for their traditions and impartiality.

The very new authorities ~~never~~ never take to show their absolute trust to our institution that they wish to be more powerful in means and more free in action so to assure ~~view~~ quiet to the country in a better way.

8. MORALE OF CARABINIERI.

This is still high and stout. However, insufficiency of personnel and of rapid transport is complained, especially by those detachments where the most dangerous armed gangs are operating.

Complaints are being received that the ration of food is scarce, and it really it is not sufficient if we consider the fatigue imposed to our men. /.

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The recent increase of pay is non adequate to the increase of the cost of living, and men also complain the high cost of clothing and boots and a big difference between the pay of married and unmarried men.

9. PUBLIC SECURITY - GENERAL.

Conditions of public security are the same that the last month. Carabinieri equipped with lorries, are rounding up large areas infested with brigands. Motorization is widely employed also to spare personnel so scarce in small stations. Many men are without pistols and ~~as~~ this has a bad influence upon their moral and their efficiency.

1. PUBLIC OPINION.

Economical: A serious crisis is feared for the months of January and February if supplies of grain will not come from abroad.

The constant "crescendo" of prices has a very bad impression upon the population. They realize that the continuous infractions of the "wages agreement" do not but turn the things worse. On this subject the opinion is that the Italian Economy at its actual condition cannot endure other increases of pays, or otherwise this will lead to a dead point where there will be no production and the Lira will fall to zero. Obviously, this is not in the interest of the worker. The real increase of pay may be obtained only by the increase of production.

The price of foreign value and gold shows plainly at what critical point are the Italian economical and social life, and that the country can come out of this difficult position only whether its productiveness increases, and this might be obtained only by a real "truce of wages".

However, they hope in a good success of the "Recovery Bond". Subscriptions are going satisfactory and it is believed that the results will be good and that the Bond will stop the raising of prices and will bring them back to a reasonable level.

They still are doubts concerning the possibility of a change of money, so that people is running to buy values and precious metals so causing very high prices on this market too. Political: The public opinion is puzzled by a strenuous struggle between parties and inside them, that particularly affects socialists, demochristians and liberals.

It is believed that such a crisis of parties might make more clear the political situation of the country and lead to a union of all political and economical democratic forces.

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2. IMPRESSIONS AND COMMENTS OF CG.

However the Carabiniere is outside and above political struggle, he understands them perfectly. He believes that through the struggle of parties one day democratic freedom will be conquered, and that such a freedom is necessary for the political, economical and social recovery of the Country.

1. PUBLIC OPINION.

Political Situation.

The public shows lack of interest in internal politics. People are waiting for the Christian Democratic Party to make a decision concerning its connections with the other Right Wing Parties, particularly where communal administration of big towns is concerned.

There is a general feeling of tiredness and lack of confidence, owing to the political confusion, the exaggerate limits put to private initiative, the difficulty of making a living by the people, and the fact that party leaders are after their own interests and clearly show it.

The public is disappointed by the result of the political elections of 2nd June, and disgusted by the intrigues of the political parties and their inability to govern. The public appears to have given up and be fatalistically waiting for future events.

The news on the polemics between Tagliatti and De Gasperi have arisen much interest in the public. People would like an agreement to be reached between Italy and Jugoslavia, but they criticise the Communist leader for having tries to do this without the knowledge of the Government. They fear that the withdrawal of Anglo-American troops from Trieste would encourage the Jugoslavs to occupy the town; such being the case, Italy would be unable to react in any way, divided - as she is - by so many political and internal disagreements and owing to her lack of armament.

People feel optimistic on the result of the new Reconstruction Loan. It is free from any kind of taxes, and they think that this is a good way of investing money for those who have made so much while employees and middle class people were losing theirs.

People think that the new extraordinary patrimonial tax will be applied at the very time when the currency is changed. This worries them, as they think that it would be better if the change of currency took place first. They are also worried and uneasy on the modalities of payment of the tax. According to the draft reported by the newspapers, great land owners would not feel it deeply, while it would certainly and deeply affect owners of buildings and middle class people who would be compelled to borrow the money and - within a short time - to put their property into the hands of the new-rich, or to spend all their money in taxes.

Agricultural trade is good, chiefly consisting of export to England and America.

Works and manufactures are practically still, with the exception of ILVA which have started a new furnace, producing 25 tons of unpurified cast iron per day.

There is a general complaint on the lack of electric power and coal.

Work in the manufactures is often interrupted by strikes and demonstrations.

No de-requisition of works or manufacture by the Allies has taken place.

Unemployment is increasing: there are 5,124 more unemployed than last month.

IMPRESSIONS AND COMMENTS OF THE CORPS.

The personnel serving in the stations is insufficient to carry on public order duties, and to satisfy all the requests of informations they get. 234

Food rations are hardly sufficient.

The meat which is being distributed is bad.

The cigarettes are ~~also~~ worse than they used to be.

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The cigarettes are ~~more~~ worse than they used to be.

The bread is badly made and baked, and soon becomes very hard.

Margarine - which they get instead of oil - not only gives no flavour to the soup, but makes its taste disgusting, so that many CC do not eat it.

9. PUBLIC SAFETY CONDITIONS.

CC are working hard to detect and prevent crime. Crime is still committed, but the fact that the most dangerous criminals ~~were~~ ^{were} arrested, makes the population feel more safe, and improves public safety conditions.

CC of Grottaminarda (Avellino Prov.) - after 3... 4/...

after difficult enquiries, arrested the persons responsible for the murder of a whole family - including a little boy of six, and a babe six month old.

CC of Gesualdo (Avellino) - with the help of the anti-brigand squad and the Carabinieri of Friganto Station, found the members of a dangerous gang. 4 - out of the 7 men - were arrested, and part of the stolen goods and money recovered.

On 28 Oct - the anniversary of the foundation of fascism - there were a few demonstrations, staged by a so-called "new-fascist" organisation. Its members distributed handbills, and placed fascist flags and bombs in several places. The population did not show any alarm, and only thought that they were fanatics. They were arrested, by the local Questura.

1. PUBLIC OPINION.

Economic Situation: The public is asking for more discipline in the distribution of food stuff. Provincial authorities of the places of production often make this distribution more difficult, by not allowing the export of the goods to other provinces which are in worse need.

The public is also asking for more discipline in the prices of clothing and of food stuff. Only a small part of the population can pay the prices of these goods, and they are the people who get the money out of the sacrifices of the other classes.

The increase in prices causes dissatisfaction and is liable to bring to trouble.

The devaluation of the lira is the cause of deep concern, particularly because most people do not think that the Reconstruction Loan is going to prove as successful as hoped. Such lack of confidence in the loan is chiefly caused by the lack of confidence in the Government. The public is waiting for the change of currency with great anxiety, and there are disagreements in the public opinion, on this matter.

Political Situation: The public thinks that the peace terms are imposed on Italy as a revenge.

The journey of Togliatti to Belgrade, and the news reported by UNITA' on the matter caused a bad impression in the Italians. They accused the Government of carelessness for letting a private citizen make diplomatic approaches without knowing that this was going on. It is clear, by their activities, that the Communists are only after the interests of a super-international, imperialistic foreign organization.)

The local administrative elections took place on Sunday 20th, and, like those held in the province, were marked by the presence of a very small number of voters. This shows that the public feels tired and cynical, and has a complete lack of interest in politics.

The authority of the Government has never been through such a difficult period as this, and it is clear that the public cannot see the solution of the most difficult problems, such as cost of living, house-shortage, the devaluation of the lira, and unemployment.

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The local administrative elections took place on Sunday 30th, and, like those held in the province, were marked by the presence of a very small number of voters. This shows that the public feels tired and cynical, and has a complete lack of interest in politics.

The authority of the Government has never been through such a difficult period as this, and it is clear that the public cannot see the solution of the most difficult problems, such as cost of living, house-shortage, the devaluation of the lira, and unemployment.

At this stage, it is easy to understand the lack of confidence of the public, who is fatalistically waiting for better, or worse, times, and is quite resigned.

The good intention of few people whose aim is to unite the strength of the "order" parties, are wasted against this complete general indifference. This is also owing to the fact that the representatives of some so-called Right Wing Parties are only looking after their own interests, and - instead of working for the good of the nation.

2. IMPRESSIONS AND COMMENTS OF THE CORPS.

Carabinieri are keeping quite apolitical but, even then, they cannot fail to see that most troubles are caused by the so-called popular parties, whose members are in possession of arms and ammunition. To bring the situation to normality, there should be a general discharge of the civilian personnel employed by

military offices, and the Government should order all arms to be surrendered, have searches for arms, and punish - with serious penalties - the breaches of this order.

CC also comment on the insufficiency of the means at their disposal to fight common and political crimes.

3. COMMENTS OF THE PRESS ON CARABINIERI WORK.

The comments of the press on the work of Carabinieri are almost always good. In spite of their lack of means, CC are apolitical, they stop party quarrels and serious troubles, and do their best to normalise public order.

During the month the local press has commented and praised the action of CC who killed in a fight the very dangerous bandit Catalisano Giuseppe. The man was responsible for many crimes, among which the murder of two Carabinieri.

- (d) the fact that the "strength-deficiency allowance" is no longer being paid. This is particularly felt in smaller stations which are often left with one, unmarried Carabinieri, owing to the frequency of temporary services.

9. PUBLIC SAFETY

There are still some armed gangs in the province of Catanzaro;

CC are working to capture them.
In the Crotona zone the situation is still uncertain, though the riots have stopped. In Catanzaro Province: The dangerous bandit CATALISANO Giuseppe was killed by CC in a fight, and three members of his gang were arrested. CAIO Francesco, also wanted by the Police, was killed in a fight with CC. P.S. condition have improved since.

MONTHLY REPORT

TO : Vth BDE HQ, NAPLES.

POLITICAL SITUATION

The policy of the Government is bitterly criticised by the people, whose confidence in a possible energetic action by the Government to re-establish prestige and public order is gradually decreasing.

The increase in prices is also affecting and depressing public feelings. The increase in the salaries has proved to be of no use, as it causes prices to go up. Therefore it will turn out to make worse, instead of improving, the conditions of the public, particularly the employees.

The administrative elections are taking place. Up to now the result shows that: the Socialists and Communists are holding their position, the "Uomo Qualunque" is making great progress, and the Christian Democrats are having much less success than they did in the political elections.

ECONOMIC SITUATION

Getting worse. Prices are going up, and this is in connection with the great quantity of money now in circulation, and with the increasing difficulty in finding goods. The lack of confidence in the lira is bringing people to withdraw money from banks and invest it in other ways.

The Left Wing Parties are clearly showing their intention of controlling production, which they would do by using Party Squads.

The agricultural season work is finished, and unemployment is increasing. Land owners were deeply affected by the high prices they had to pay to their workers, and are now unwilling to employ more unemployed persons.

The Public-Works Plan of the Government has not been started yet, and this causes dissatisfaction in the public.

It is difficult to say what the result of the new Reconstruction Plan is going to be, but there is a feeling of dissatisfaction and lack of confidence against it. This could be overcome by good propaganda and by the united action of all Parties in a better administration of public funds.

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IMPRESSIONS AND COMMENTS BY THE CORPS

Carabinieri comment on the fact that, in spite of all the promises made of a quick and sure reorganisation, of the police forces, the strength of CC is not yet adequate to the needs. Quick means of transport are needed by CC Commands and by stations of lower formations, and also an increase in the supply of automatic arms.

There are insistent talks on a probable unification of the Police Forces.

This would be contrary to the ideals of Carabinieri, who wish their Corps to keep its autonomy and traditions.

The news on the new republican oath has caused no deep impression and no comments in the Carabinieri. They are now used to the new state of things, and accept it as a manifestation of the will of the Italian people. Those who - before the 2nd June - were keen on the Monarchy, have grown used to the situation created by the national Referendum and, even without taking the oath, they have made up their minds to respect the laws of the new State, and to make the others respect them, as well.

COMMENTS ON THE PRESS ON THE WORK OF THE CORPS.

These are very good when they comment on successful operations. Left Wing papers criticize bitterly CC, and call them fascists, when they arrest members of their Parties.

I°)- OPINIONE PUBBLICA

Nel campo economico: s'invoca la disciplina dei rifornimenti alimentari molte volte ostacolati dalle resistenze delle autorità locali di alcune province produttive impedendo così l'approvvigionamento alle province alle quali il prodotto è destinato.

S'invoca, altresì, la disciplina dei prezzi sui generi commestibili e su quelli d'abbigliamento, punto fondamentale che determina il grave disagio di intere popolazioni a vantaggio di una ristrettissima cerchia di persone che, dalle condizioni eccezionali in cui si vive per conseguenza della guerra, cerca di trarre il massimo beneficio e vantaggio arricchendosi smoderatamente sui sacrifici e sui disagi della maggioranza.

Il continuo rialzo dei prezzi provoca vivissimo malumore^{21,6} che potrebbe degenerare in gravi fatti ove si accentuasse il rincaro del costo della vita.

La svalutazione della moneta è motivo di grave preoccupazione anche perchè si ritiene dalla maggioranza del popolo che il prestito testè lanciato non avrà i risultati sperati, principalmente a causa della sfiducia verso le attuali classi dirigenti, le quali vengono accusate di non saper restituire al Paese l'ordine e la disciplina.

Viva attesa vi è per il cambio della moneta sulla cui attuazione e sulle cui conseguenze l'opinione pubblica è discorde e non molto orientata.

Nel campo politico: è convinzione che le condizioni di pace imposte all'Italia sono frutto dello spirito punitivo che ha animato grandi e piccole potenze nei nostri riguardi. In quanto concerne il confine orientale non buona impressione ha prodotto il viaggio dell'On. TOLLATI a Belgrado e le notizie comparse al riguardo sull'"UNITA'".

Si è rilevata, ancora una volta, la carenza del Governo, che a quanto si afferma, consente ad un privato cittadino di intavolare e di condurre, a sua insaputa, approcci diplomatici d'importanza eccezionale. La gravità dell'insidiosa manovra slavo-comunista è apparsa chiara ed evidente a tutti, come è apparso lampante che l'attività dei comunisti risponde unicamente agli interessi ed agli ordini di un organismo supranazionale che si identifica in un imperialismo straniero.

L'attenzione dell'opinione pubblica si è soffermata anche sul risultato delle elezioni amministrative di domenica 10 corrente, le quali, è opinione diffusa, hanno confermato l'astensione alle urne, già verificatasi nelle elezioni amministrative dei piccoli comuni, astensione determinata dalla sfiducia, scetticismo, stanchezza profonda della politica.

In complesso, si rileva che il cittadino è stanco della politica, che la situazione economica ed alimentare va sempre peggiorando, che mai l'autorità dello Stato ha attraversato una crisi così grave e profonda, che non si vede un principio di soluzione concreta dei problemi fondamentali come il caro-vita, la mancanza di case, la svalutazione della lira, la disoccupazione.

In tali circostanze, con un quadro così pessimistico, comprensibile è la sfiducia delle popolazioni, che attendono tempi migliori o peggiori con fatalistica rassegnazione.

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Di fronte a tale abulia, l'azione di molti ben pensanti che vorrebbero riunire le sparse forze di tutti i partiti d'ordine per farne un fronte unico allo scopo di fronteggiare la marea sovietica incalzante, rimane sterile anche perchè taluni esponenti dei partiti, così detti di destra, non sanno frenare le loro ambizioni ed aspirazioni e non riescono ad anteporre l'interesse personale a quello che è l'interesse generale del Paese.

2°)- IMPRESSIONI E COMMENTI DELL'ARMA

L'Arma, pur mantenendosi nella più rigida apoliticità, non può non constatare che i sintomi sempre più frequenti di ribellione al Governo e di insofferenza alle leggi partano quasi sempre dai così detti partiti di massa, provvisti di armi e munizioni.

A normalizzare la situazione sarebbe necessaria la smobilitazione generale dei civili, come misura preventiva di sicurezza. Occorrerebbe che il Governo ordinasse la consegna di tutte le armi e perquisizioni su vasta scala, decretando pene severe per i trasgressori.

Si commenta, infine, la inadeguatezza dei mezzi per combattere efficacemente la delinquenza a sfondo politico e comune.

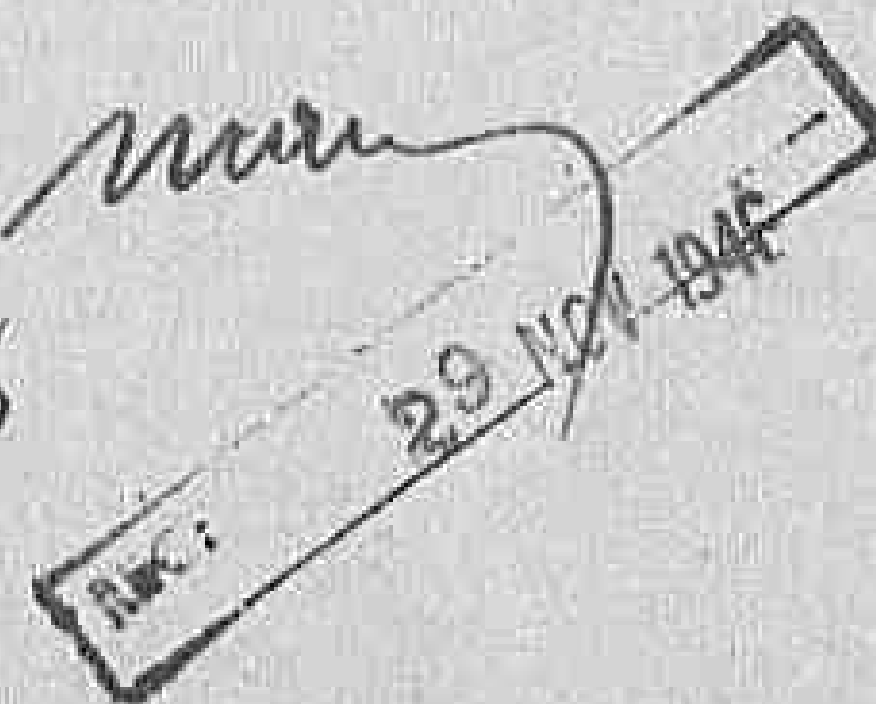

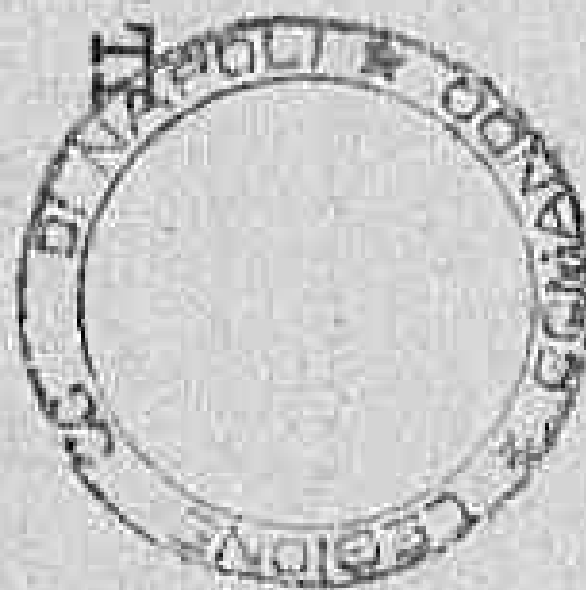
