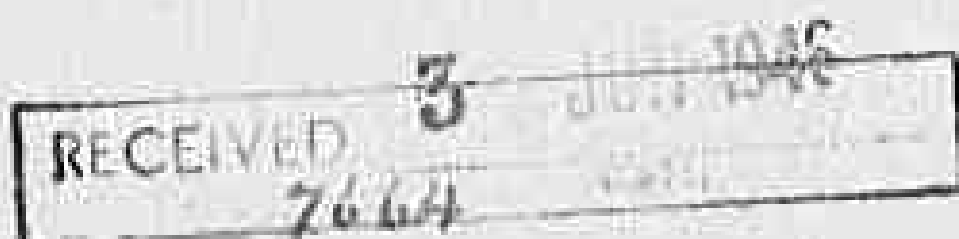

2. The contents and suggestions in this S.M.A.S. letter have been noted, and it is considered that the suggestion contained in paragraph 2 (a) of the S.M.A.S. letter should be adopted.
3. It is far more important for each of the 20 Legions to have efficient workshops than the 12 Mobile Battalions. The Legions are not yet up to strength in vehicles, but when they are, some Legions will have three times as many vehicles as a Mobile Battalion. The 20 Carabinieri Legions Police the whole of Italy, Sicily and Sardinia, so that their vehicles are spread out throughout the whole country. Some Legion HQs are not situated in towns where are Italian Army Territorial HQs.
4. On the other hand the 12 Mobile Battalions are stationed in large cities where there are already both Italian Army Territorial Workshops and Carabinieri Legion HQs. - (a) Each of the 20 Legion Workshops be supplied with a heavy break-down lorry, in addition to the heavy workshop trucks, so that broken down heavy lorries and Staghound Armoured cars can be brought into Legion Workshops. Mobile Battalions will not necessarily always remain in the same Legion area. The Lazio Mobile Battalion is at present at Ancona, whilst the Palermo Mobile Battalion is certain to operate all over Sicily, which consists of two Legion areas, namely, Palermo and Messina.
