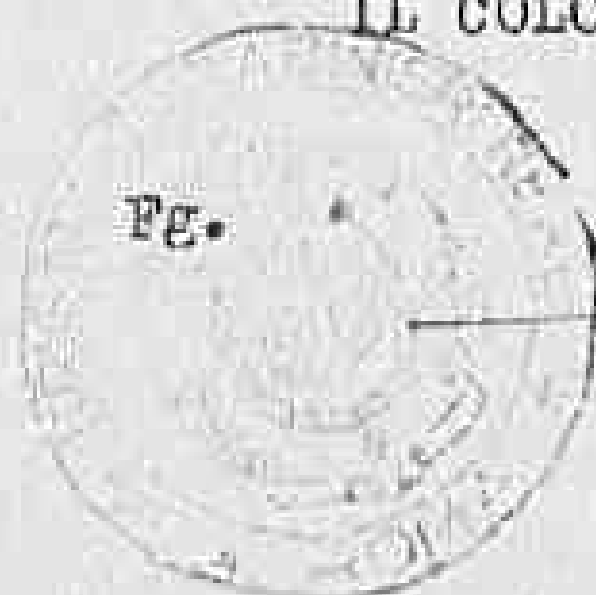

When taking up the matter of indenting for kitchen equipment and accommodation stores, these questions were asked :- Does GHQ know of this proposal ? Are any expenses being incurred ? And are the objects if supplied on loan to be replaced if lost or damaged.

The CCRR prefer that the Contractors be forced to observe the conditions of their contract, it is therefore requested that such information held at HQ on this matter be forwarded to this office in order that the position with regard to the contracts may be clarified, and if necessary indents made for stores.

- Maintenance of C.C.R.R. Barracks

General conditions for providing and upkeeping office and Barrack furniture, upholstery, bedding, kitchen utensils and other material in use for C.C.R.R.

These general conditions refer to the upkeep of furniture, upholstery, bedding, kitchen and stable utensils, to lighting, washing of linen, varnishing of furniture, tinning copper, kitchen ware, disinfection required for the housing of C.C.R.R. The particular conditions are contained in the following articles and annexed schedules.

art. I.- The contracts are made per Province, the particular conditions of each contract being notified in the advertisements of intended contracts and also if necessary in the contract itself.

To be able to participate in contracts, the contractor must amongst other documents produce as proof of his technical and financial capacity a certificate of the "Consiglio dell'Economia Corporativa" of the Province in which he is domiciled.

In the case of large contracts (dealing with units superior to 400 men) the Administration may require a supplementary certificate of the General Direction of Public Security showing that the contractor has already carried on similar contracts with satisfactory results.

As long as contract conditions remain unvaried, no change of contract is admitted even if there should be change of name of Commands, Offices, Unit or variations in their formation, grouping or subdivision.

All legal expenses are charged to the Contractor.

Articles 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 deal with the responsibilities of the contractor - He may not cede to others the contract without the Ministry's permission - otherwise the contract will be annulled. He must have a legal domicile in the Chief town of the Province to which the contract refers. He must pay in a deposit equal to 2% of the total amount of the contract. Furthermore all the furniture, bedding, and other material in use in offices and Barracks remain bound up as further guarantee. For the first 3 years the deposit may never be reduced to less than 2/3 of the amount due otherwise it will be confiscated and the contract rescinded. After 3 years the deposit may at the contractor's request be provisionally returned to him on condition that until the end of the contract he pay 2 1/2% yearly on the amount of the deposit and the furniture etc in use in Offices and Barracks remain bound up as guarantee. The contractor may be reappointed at each contract.

In the case of large contracts (dealing with units superior to 400 men) the Administration may require a supplementary certificate of the General Direction of Public Security showing that the contractor has already carried on similar contracts with satisfactory results.

As long as contract conditions remain unvaried, no change of contract is admitted even if there should be change of name of Commands, Offices, Unit or variations in their formation, grouping or subdivision.

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Articles 9, 10, 11 deal with the contractor's responsibilities in case of increase, suppression or transfer of Stations, Offices etc. If during the contract period, it should be decided to set up other Offices, Commands or Stations, Nuclei or fixed Posts,

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or their transformation (foot, horse, or mixed) or to augment their organic force, the contractor will be obliged to provide etc all necessary furniture etc according to art. 8.- Should it however be decided to suppress a station after the furniture had been transported but before the Station has started to function, compensation will be paid.

Articles I2, I3 refer to a permanent supplementary dotation and other material in use of reinforcements lodged within CC.RR. Barracks. No obligation entails for reinforcements lodged outside such Barracks.

Article I4 deals with the lighting of CC.RR. barracks exclusive of Offices of Officer and Station Commands, warehouses and Legion workshops, which the Military Administration looks after. The number and distribution of lights in each barracks is fixed by the CC.RR. Commandant of the Province or by the higher Commands.

The contractor must provide, lamps, electric bulbs and the material necessary for the lighting and must care for their upkeep, with electric light where such form of lighting exists otherwise by gas or petroleum. Should a Commune improve its form of lighting to electricity, the contractor is under obligation of adopting the new form of lighting in the CC.RR. barracks. He must also assure the lighting of barracks in case of interruption or break down of the system in use. The quantity of electricity gas or petroleum due by contract to each Barracks are fixed in annexe 5. Twice yearly in June and December the contractor must notify General H.Q. the quantity of light consumed in the six months, so that the excess may be charged to who ever responsible.

Article I4.- Bedding and linen must always be in decent condition and in good state of use. Sheets must be changed twice a month from 1st April to end of October and once a month for the rest of the year; pillow cases during the same periods respectively every week and every 15 days; towels, tablecloths, napkins and kitchen cloths, once a week, the wool of mattresses and pillows must be beaten up every two years, bedcovers washed every six months; blankets, if necessary, must be disinfected once a year, the horse hair of mattresses must be replaced when wornout.

Articles I6 - I7 refer to the necessary revarnishing of iron or wooden objects, and returning of copper utensils whenever required.

Articles I8, I9 deal with lost or damaged material and the responsibility due to Contractor, unless such damage be due to force majeure. If for duly proved reasons...

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Article 14 deals with the lighting of CC.RR. barracks exclusive of Offices of Officer and Station Commands, warehouses and Legion workshops, which the Military Administration looks after. The number and distribution of lights in each barracks is fixed by the CC.RR. Commandant of the Province or by the higher Commands.

Articles 18, 19 deal with lost or damaged material and the ~~226th~~ ^{226th} nity due to Contractor, unless such damage be due to force majeure. If for duly proved sanitary reasons, it should be necessary to disinfect or destroy certain material the expenses will be charged to the contractor who will also be obliged to substitute such material without compensation.

Articles 20 and 21 determine the procedure for making requests to the Contractor, and the latter's position in case of contestation.

Articles 22, 23 deal with the fines due for non observance of obligations deriving from contract.

Articles 24 and 25 fix the compensation due to the Contractor according to the terms of the contract for use of material per head and per day and guarantee that the minimum of annual presences

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may not fall below a specified figure.

According to article 26 the daily allowance as fixed per contract may be reexamined every two years; in the exclusive interest of the administration however.

Articles 27 and 28 deal with accounts and how they shall be drawn up.

Articles 29 and 30 deal with the questions of inventory, its variations in case of change of consignee, and the transfer of materials in case of change of contractor.

Article 31 - refers to special obligations such as providing H.Q. offices with electric bells and their upkeep. Providing all CC.RM. Barracks with the National Flag and portraits of H.M. the King and H.E. the Head of the Government to all Officer and Station Commands.

According to article 32 the contractor, in the interest of goodness, uniformity and economy, may acquire iron bedsteads, blankets, wool, mattresses, linen etc from Penal Establishments.

In articles 33, 34, 35 and 36 the conditions for ceasing the contract on account of irregularities and the position of the contractor are examined, also the eventuality of his death.

Articles 37, 38, 39, 40 deal with special conditions such as consumption of water and other minor requirements.

2. The Carabinieri were in possession until August 44 when the Republican Fascist Prefect gave authority for the Caserma to be occupied by the Questura. At the time of liberation the partisans took possession.
3. Recently demands have been made locally to the Prefect and Questura for the vacation of the Caserma but without success. Our Carabinieri Liaison officer in the Imperia area reports that the CC.RR are in urgent need of proper barrack accomodation.
4. Forwarded for your information and such action as you may deem necessary with the Ministry of the Interior, with a view to the return of the Caserma to CC.RR control.
