1. As you are no doubt aware there are at the present time serving in the CC.RR. officers who are not really CC.RR. officers but Army officers who transferred to the CC.RR. service. Many of these have been serving with the CC.RR. for years. During this time they have become thoroughly familiar with the organization and administration of the CC.RR. They did in fact pass special examinations before assuming service.

2. Many have received promotion during their service with the CC.RR. It has now been laid down that if these officers wish to continue in the CC.RR. as a career they must return to the grade of 'sotto-tenente' (2nd Lt.).

3. This they are not prepared to do and they are leaving the CC.RR. service and entering the Public Security service. Here they retain their present rank. This is not to their liking but they are forced to consider their livelihood before sentiment. This is resulting in the loss to the CC.RR. service of very valuable trained officers, and it is urgently requested that the matter be discussed at a high level to see whether officers who are recommended for their efficiency, cannot be retained at their present rank.

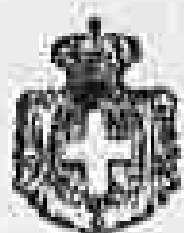
